5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY – 14TH MAY, 2016

THEME: THE GAINS OF HIS RETURNING TO THE FATHER

**TEXT: PSALM 1, PROVERBS 4:10-19;
1 COR. 4:14-5:1-5; JOHN 16:5-22.**

We give thanks to God for yet another privilege to appear in His presence to worship and to be blessed. May our worship of today be acceptable to Him in Jesus' name and may we really be blessed in the name of Jesus.

The theme for our meditation this week is: ***"The gains of His returning to the Father"*** and the text is John 16: 7 - ***"Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you."***

After spending three years with them, it is understandable that the disciples will not want Jesus to leave them. And so the announcement to them of his imminent departure, which he first told them earlier in John 13: 33 can only attract sadness and even sorrow on the part of the disciples (John 16: 6). His presence had positively transformed their lives in ways beyond their imagination, from nobody, he had made them somebody, they have grown in confidence and have become a force to reckon with among their people. They have enjoyed his protection, his care and his tutelage amongst other things. They had probably become so accustomed to being with him that they cannot imagine life without him.

Jesus also no doubt had enjoyed his time with them and probably would have loved to continue with them, but there is a greater good to be achieved by his departure and no sentiments whatsoever must be allowed to hinder this greater good from coming to manifestation. Unknown to the disciples at this time, the departure of Jesus as painful as it may be is for their own good and also for the good of others that will come to the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus says his departure will pave the way for the advent of Holy Spirit. The natural question will then be who is Holy Spirit and why is His advent as important as to justify the departure of our Lord Jesus Christ?

Jesus Christ himself in providing answer to this question described Holy Spirit as the Spirit of truth, who will guide the apostles and believers generally into all truths, He will show us and tell us of things to come and will glorify the Lord Jesus in our lives and before us (John 16: 13-14).

With the Holy Spirit actively at work in the life of the believer, the believer will never walk the path of error, the path of failure or the path of destruction, because He will guide believers in the way they should go. When you take the time to consider how many believers have walked the destructive path and destroyed their lives in the process, this important role of Holy Spirit will be more appreciated.

Beyond this, Holy Spirit is also the spirit that brings conviction of sin, and without conviction there will be no repentance. This role of Holy Spirit makes Him an indispensable ally in the business of evangelism. No matter the eloquence, oratory skill, understanding of scriptures or gift in preaching the word of God, no man can convict a sinner of sin, it is Holy Spirit that does that.

Holy Spirit is also the power of God personified and so to have Him in our life is to become a carrier of God's power (i.e a spiritual transformer). 1 Cor. 4: 20, says that the kingdom of God is not in word alone but in the manifestation of God's power. It is the act of God's power in us that produces evidences in our lives that cannot be ignored or denied. Do you lack power to overcome the oppression of the devil and his agents in your life? Do you lack power to live a Christian life that is holy unto the Lord? Do you lack power to break the yoke of barrenness, sickness and
