Is World Mosquito Day 2017**

Although a few species of mosquitoes are harmless or even useful to humanity, most mosquitoes are a nuisance because they consume blood from living vertebrates, including humans. In feeding on blood, some of them transmit extremely harmful human and livestock diseases, such as malaria, yellow fever and filariasis.

Methods used to prevent the spread of disease, or to protect individuals in areas where disease is endemic, include:

- Vector control aimed at mosquito control or eradication;
- Disease prevention, using prophylactic drugs and developing vaccines
- Prevention of mosquito bites, with insecticides, nets, and repellents.

Practical Steps to Protect Our Homes and Families from Mosquitoes:

1. Get rid of stagnant water.
2. Use of Insecticide Treated Nets and put nets on all windows.
3. Make natural repellents as part of your landscape.
4. Apply mosquito repellents on exposed parts of the body, especially for kids.
5. Cover your feet if outdoors.

SUNDAY – 20TH AUGUST, 2017

TODAY'S TOPIC: THE FELLOWSHIP OF BELIEVERS

BIBLE READINGS: PSALM 119:97-112;

1 CHRONICLES 29:1-9; ACTS 2:41-47; ACTS 2:41-47; MATTHEW 25:31-46.

INTRODUCTION: The term fellowship generally connotes communion and fellowship with God and with other believers. It connects one believer "with other believers in the Spirit of God and with God's blessings." After the creation, Adam and Eve enjoyed maximum fellowship with God in the garden of Eden, and even after the fall, God still sought for a way of restoring them through the work of the Redeemer. Hence, God began to draw special people into fellowship with himself. Among them were Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Moses and David. Through his work on the cross coupled with the gospel message, Jesus Christ restores fellowship not only with God but also among believers. Therefore, talking about 'the fellowship of believers, the Christian fellowship exemplified by the early church is very instructive.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE EARLY CHURCH

The early church was noted for the following characteristics:

1. It was a learning church. v42: They devoted themselves to the apostles teaching... Let us take note of the following three points:
 - a. Not only that the believers received the Holy Spirit; they also met daily for instruction. v46: Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They gathered to hear from the apostles the stories of Jesus. This shows the importance of meeting with other Christians to hear more and more about Jesus.
 - b. The believers had some wonderful teachers. Those who taught in the church had earlier spent three years with Jesus. Thus, the ministry of the apostles was authenticated by many wonders and miraculous signs. Vs 4. This suggests to the church of the present generation that whosoever must teach or preach in the church must have been thoroughly polished through series of teaching and learning of the word of God.
 - c. The believers were always eager to learn more about Jesus. The more we learn about Jesus the more we know of him and the closer we are to him. Believers are meant to discover new things about God from time to time.

2. The early church was a loving church. v44: All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold their possessions and goods, and gave to anyone as he had need. There are lessons we should learn from here.

a. It is possible to make too much of the particular way the early Christians expressed their love for one another. However, it is wrong to generalise from special circumstances. Jesus gave up work as a carpenter to commence his teaching ministry and the disciples left their boats to follow him. For three years, they were dependent upon well-to-do women for financial support. Students still rely upon financial support to complete their studies. Eventually, though, we have to earn our living. Not many can find a rich woman to keep them! The period immediately following Pentecost was unusual and special. The whole church was together in Jerusalem. Many of its members were Jews who had travelled up to the Holy City for the Passover and Feast of Pentecost. They were due to return home when they were converted. It was vital they remained in Jerusalem and learned from the apostles. However, their money was running out and they needed hospitality. It may have been this that prompted, and made necessary, the policy of possessing everything in common. This practice is obviously unsustainable. Eventually there is nothing to sell if no one is working. It is not good for men and women to be idle for long. Paul makes quite clear what the norm should be. He wrote to the Thessalonians just as he writes to the Christian church today:

But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you—for this reason, brothers, in all our distress and affliction we have been comforted about you through your faith. For now we live, if you are standing fast in the Lord. For what thanksgiving can we return to God for you, for all the joy that we feel for your sake before our God, as we pray most earnestly night and day that we may see you face to face and supply what is lacking in your faith?

Now may our God and Father himself, and our Lord Jesus, direct our way to you, and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you, so that he may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his saints (2 Thess. 3: 6 - 13).

b. The truth about believers fellowship is that genuine Christians will make sacrifices for one another. They will go without, or do without, for the sake of the brethren. The most important thing in the lives of those early Christians was the fellowship of believers. It was a higher priority than possessions and goods. We should feel more at home being in the company of other other Christian believers.

3. The early church was a worshipping church. v42: They devoted themselves to.... the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe.. v46: Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts praising God.... The early church continued to meet formally in the Temple because it was the place of public prayer. Prayers were held at 6am, noon and 6pm. It remains crucial for Christians to meet regularly for prayer. The first Christians could not spend long enough together such was the tie that bound their hearts in sacred love. They met for meals in each other's homes. The meals would end by taking bread and wine and remembering the Lord's death with glad and sincere hearts.

4. The early church was a growing church. v47: And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved. The early church was a tremendous witness. About 3000 turned up to the Temple each day for prayer. All through the week you could find a jolly party to attend somewhere. These first Christian were very popular. People found them likeable and excellent company. They were enthusiastic, cheerful, joyful, hospitable and caring. The Lord added daily to the church in Jerusalem. The Lord is still adding daily to his church! Today there are approximately 2 billion who profess to be Christians. God has been so wonderful to the Christian church, including Archbishop Vining Memorial church Cathedral, all over the world. We can pray for, and support financially, missionary work in areas where the response to the gospel is positive. The fellowship of believers is a clarion call to 'come over to Macedonia and help us'

CONCLUSION: Believers are called into fellowship with God and with one another. The church is depicted as the family of God on earth (Eph. 3:15). God is the Father while believers are his faithful sons and daughters. The life expected of God's family is one governed by love, tenderness, compassion and humility (Phil. 2:1-4). Despite the differences in the body, the Holy Spirit binds believers together into a single being, implying that each member is gifted for the spiritual upbringing of the church - the Body of Christ.
