SUNDAY – 25TH JUNE, 2017

TODAY'S TOPIC: LOVE: GOD'S WONDROUS GIFT TO MAN

BIBLE READINGS: PSALM 71:16-24; ROMANS 6:3-11; JOHN 15:5-11.

All praise and thanks to the Almighty God for the privilege to be in His presence again this Sunday morning, which happens to be the very last Sunday in the month of June. We give thanks to God who has safely seen us through the first half of this year and as we enter the second half of the year 2017, may the same grace of God that saw us through the first half of the year abound with us more and more in Jesus' name. Congratulations to members of the Band of Light Society as they celebrate their society anniversary today, may the light of God continue to light their path always causing them to permanently remain in God's will all the days of their lives in the name of Jesus. Amen.

Our theme for meditation this week is - "**Love: God's wondrous gift to man**" and the anchor passage is John 5: 9-14, "***I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. 10 When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love. 11 I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow! 12 This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. 13 There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command.***"

- ✓ Love is not passive but active
- ✓ Love is not in the saying but in the doing
- ✓ Love is not in taking, but it is in giving, and love gives without expecting anything in return
- ✓ Love is not selfish but selfless

The above describes the God kind of love, which is a far cry from the love practiced or understood by the world. God's kind of love is elusive to the world because it can only be given by God, and only those who genuinely receive it can derive maximum benefits from it.

God is love personified and in demonstration of his love for us, He sent His only begotten Son into the world, to suffer, to die and to resurrect, so that through His death and resurrection He will be able to break the power of sin over man thereby solving the sin question once and for all. The giving of His only begotten Son therefore is the best gift that mankind can ever receive in life, we describe it here as a

wondrous gift, unfortunately however the scriptures testifies that not all of mankind received this gift, as many as received the gift however receives also with it the power to become sons and daughters of God (John 1: 10-12), the yoke of sin is totally broken over their lives and they are totally set free (Rom. 6: 10a).

Having done all that He did to prove to us His love and the Love of His Father for us, we see from our anchor passage the demand of Jesus regarding what our response should be if we choose to reciprocate His love –

1. We are to remain under the canopy of His love, because this is the only way by which we are protected from all satanic exploits to return us to the path of damnation and eternal destruction. We remain in His love first by accepting his sacrifice on our behalf, through the surrender of our lives to him and accepting Him as Lord and Savior and secondly by living a life of total dedication and obedience to His word, Jesus himself declares that the test of our love for Him is in keeping His commandment (John 15: 9-10). When we stray away from his word, we are straying outside the protective covering of His love and that is very dangerous both for our physical and spiritual wellbeing.
2. The second way we positively respond to His love is for us to love others as He has loved us. We are to love not only fellow members of the household of faith (i.e fellow believers), but we are to love the unsaved (unbelievers) as well. We prove our genuine love for the unsaved by showing concern for their sinful state. When we are really concerned about their sinful state, we will fast and pray for their salvation, we will preach to them the message of God's saving grace, we will invite them and zealously follow up with them to attend evangelistic programs where they will hear salvation messages that will save their souls. No one can claim to genuinely love someone, when he or she is not doing anything to help the person discover Christ and surrender to Him.

Love is God's wondrous gift to a dying world, that love has saved and transformed so many lives, putting them on the sure path that leads to heaven, apart from its many benefits in this world, if you are a beneficiary of this love treasure it and eternally demonstrate your appreciation to God for His gift by vigorously and zealously following the steps listed above. May God give you grace to embrace his love and to remain in His love in Jesus' name. Amen.

DELAY

WHAT CAN BE LEARNT FROM DELAYS?

BIBLE READING: JOSHUA 18:1-10

KEY BIBLE VERSE: Then Joshua asked them, "How long are you going to wait before taking possession of the remaining land the LORD, the God of your ancestors, has given to you? (Joshua 18:3).

PROCRASTINATION CAN BE DISOBEDIENCE

Joshua asked why some of the tribes were putting off the job of possessing the land. Often we delay doing jobs that seem large, difficult, boring, or disagreeable.

To continue putting them off shows lack of discipline, poor stewardship of time, and in some cases disobedience to God. Jobs we don't enjoy require concentration, teamwork, twice as much time, lots of encouragement and accountability. Remember this when you are tempted to procrastinate.

BIBLE READING: 1 Samuel 13:1-15.

KEY BIBLE VERSE: Saul waited there seven days for Samuel, as Samuel had instructed him earlier, but Samuel still didn't come. Saul realized that his troops were rapidly slipping away. So he demanded, "Bring me the burnt offering and the peace offerings!" And Saul sacrificed the burnt offering himself. (1 Samuel 13:8-9).

DELAYS BEYOND OUR CONTROL TEST OUR PATIENCE AND OBEDIENCE

It is difficult to trust God when you feel your resources slipping away, when Saul felt that time was running out, he became impatient with God's timing. In thinking that the ritual was all he needed, he substituted the ritual for faith in God. When faced with a difficult decision, don't allow impatience to drive you to disobey God. When you know what God wants, follow his plan regardless of the consequences. God often uses delays to test our obedience and patience.

BEWARE

"Beware, in everybody, there is a piece of flesh, if it is healthy, the whole body is healthy and if it is sick, the whole body is sick.

"The signs of the hypocrite are three:

When he speaks, he lies,

When he promises, he breaks it

And when any trust is kept with him, He misuses it,

Are you are one of them? If yes; BEWARE.

BE STILL

Whenever problems arise, Be still

If Satan trembles, Be still!
