Each time a new version of anything is introduced, it comes with a promise to be an improvement on the old.

Since we are talking about the "New Life", the first implication is that there is an old life and the second implication is that there is a problem with this "old life" else there will be no reason for the new (Heb. 8: 7).

To define it simply, the "old life" is the life without Christ, the life that does not know or that is not submissive to the reign of Christ and the "New Life" is the life that acknowledges Christ as Lord, the life where Christ reigns as Lord and Savior.

The characteristics of the old life include the following:

1. It is a life committed to worldly pleasure and that is engaged in all kinds of ungodly practices (Eph. 4: 19)
2. It is a life that is corrupted by deception and lust (Eph. 4: 22)
3. It is a life filled with bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior (Eph. 4: 31)
4. It is a life that manifests the following traits - sexual immorality, impurity, greed, obscene communication, foolish talk, and coarse jokes, worshiping the things of this world (idolatry), worldliness (Eph. 5: 3-5).
5. It is a life that attracts the wrath of God (Eph. 5: 6)

It is very clear from the points listed above that all who are still living the old life are walking the path of God's anger and damnation in hell. All those who are yet to accept the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are presently living the old life, because this new life originates from him and him alone (John 10: 10). It does not matter the position they occupy in the church, or the activities they carry out in the church. It also does not matter how rich or how poor they are – no worldly currency is valuable enough to purchase this new life for man.

Benefits of the new life - The benefits of the new life include the following:

1. It rightly positions a man to please God and to find favor with God (Col. 1: 10)
2. The New life is the access to the incorruptible inheritance reserved in heaven (1 Pet. 1: 4)
3. The New life is the gateway to living in the supernatural, whoever has the New life becomes a carrier of God's power (1 Cor. 2: 4)
4. The New life is the doorway to eternal life, without the New life, eternal life is not possible (John 10: 27-28)
5. The New life is the only means by which the old life and its work can be terminated (2 Cor. 5: 17)
6. The New life guarantees total deliverance from the dominion and control of principalities and powers and all the powers of darkness (Eph. 6: 12-13)

How do we jettison the old life and embrace the new life?

1. Throw off your old life by openly acknowledging before God your sins, renounce and repent of them and accept the Lord Jesus as Lord and Savior – this is the point at which the new life begins (Eph. 4: 22)
2. Release yourself fully to the Holy Spirit and allow him to renew your thoughts and your character (Eph. 4: 23) - this is achieved by spending time in meditation upon the word of God and in prayer
3. Put on the new nature in Christ (Eph. 4: 24) – this is achieved by deliberately living a life of total obedience to God's word as it is revealed to you in the place of study, meditation and prayer (Jos. 1: 8)

The New life is the ticket to a fulfilled life and a totally rewarding life. You cannot superimpose the new life on the old life, because like Jesus said, no man sews a new garment on an old garment, no one puts a new wine into an old wineskin (Luke 5: 36-37).

May the Almighty God fill you with strong desire to receive this new life and to walk in it the rest of your life in Jesus name. Amen.
