SUNDAY – 7TH MAY, 2016

THEME: LIFE AFTER LIFE

TEXT: 1 Cor. 15:1-11, John 11:17-27

Introduction: There is life after this life. **1 Corinthians 15:19** tells us that "if in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable". We should have a faith that takes us beyond the grave. Sometimes death has to occur for new life to begin.

Thousands of years ago the patriarch Job asked the question we ask ourselves: "If a man dies, shall he live again?" (**Job 14:14**). Because of Christ's victory for us, God assures us in His Word that this separation is not permanent for believers in Christ. For one day there will be a reuniting of believing loved ones in heaven, never to be separated again. If we do what is right during our lives, we will prepare ourselves to live forever with our Father in Heaven. Death is never a pleasant topic, but for the believer, it is a positive event leading to eternal life in the presence of the Lord.

4. Those who did not trust Christ in this life will be separated from God and enter a reality completely devoid of His common grace. **Luke 16:22-26**
5. Scripture speaks often of the painful reality that awaits those who do not place their faith in Christ to be rescued from sin. **Matthew 13:30**
6. We see from all these things that death is not the end of our existence. **Matthew 19:28**
7. Life after this earthly life ushers us directly into the realities of either heaven or hell. **Matthew 13:43**

8. There is life after this life. **1 Corinthians 15:19** tells us that if in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.
9. We should have a faith that takes us beyond the grave. **John 11:25**. What happens after you die depends on what happens before you die. The only time to prepare for then is now.
10. Because life exists after death, the choice you make in this world determines your final place of residence in the next life. **John 14:1-6**
