SUNDAY – 10th SEPTEMBER, 2017

TODAY'S TOPIC: THE PEOPLE OF GOD AT PRAYER

Prayer can simply be defined as an act of communication with God. It means "to ask earnestly or to beg or to entreat" and after all, there should be a response from God (note, Communication is a two way thing). The response can either be YES; No or WAIT. Prayers go beyond asking for various need of life from the Almighty, as most Christians do today. Our prayers are dominated with selfish asking; but indeed, it's an act of worship which entails our totality and entire relationship with God. Christian this days have taken several steps in ensuring that their prayers are answered by God but, forgetting that "... you ask and you did not receive because you asked amiss/wrongly" – **James 4vs 3.**
