5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY - 3RD SEPTEMBER, 2017

Persecution is part of what every true Christian must have to contend with in his or her lifetime. We must however ensure that our persecution are for righteousness sake because that is the only basis we are divinely assured of blessings and justifications. Matt. 5:11-12.

It is a pity that many of us Christians today do not want to endure persecution at all. The lot of the Apostles as itemized below should be of concern and a challenge to us all.

HOW THE APOSTLES DIED

1. MATTHEW:

This Apostle suffered martyrdom in Ethopia, killed by a sword died as a result of sustained wound.

MARK:

Died in Alexandra, Egypt, after being dragged by Horses through the streets until he was dead.

3. LUKE

Was hanged in Greece as a result of his tremendous preaching to the lost.

4. JOHN

Faced martyrdom when he was boiled in huge Basin of boiling oil during a wave of persecution in Rome. However, he was miraculously delivered from death. John was then sentenced to the mines on the prision Island of Patmos. He wrote his prophetic Book of Revelation at Patmos. The Apostle John was later freed and returned to serve as Bishop of Edessa in modern Turkey. He died as an old man, the only Apostle to die peacefully.

5. PETER

He was crucified upside down on an x-shaped cross. According to church tradition it was because he told his tormentors that he felt unworthy to die in the same way that Jesus Christ had died.

6. JAMES

The leader of the church in Jerusalem was thrown over a hundred feet down from the southeast pinnacle of the temple when he refused to deny his faith in Christ. When they discovered that he survived the fall, his enemies beat James to death with a fuller's club.

7. JAMES THE SON OF ZEBEDEE

Was a fisherman by trade when Jesus called him to a lifetime of ministry. As a strong leader of the church, James was beheaded at Jerusalem. The Roman Officer who guarded James watched amazed as James defendend his faith at his trial. Later, the officer walked beside James to the place of execution. Overcome by conviction, he declared his new faith to the judge and melt beside James to beheading as a Christian.

8. BARTHOLOMEW

Also known as Nathaniel was a missionary to Asia. He witnessed for our Lord in present day Turkey. Bartholomew was matyred for his preaching in Armenia where he was flayed to death by a whip.

9. ANDREW

Was crucified on an x-shaped cross in Patras, Greece. After being whipped severally by seven soldiers they tied his body to the cross with cords to prolong his agony. His followers reported that, when he was led towards the cross, Andrew saluted it in these words "I have long desired and expected this happy hour. The cross has been consecrated by the body of Christ hanging on it". He continued to preach to his tormentors for two days until he expired.

10. THOMAS

Was stabbed with a spear in India during one of his missionary trips to establish the church in sub-continent.

11. JUDE

Was killed with arrows when he refused to deny his faith in Christ.

12. MATTHIAS

The Apostle chosen to replace the traitor Judas Iscariot, was stoned and then beheaded.

13. PAUL

Was tortured and then beheaded by the evil Emperor Nero at Rome in A.D. 67. Paul endured a lengthy imprisonment, which allowed him to write his many epistles to the churches he had formed throughout the Roman Empire. These letters, which taught many of the foundational doctrines of Christianity, form a large portion of the New Testament.

Perhaps this is a reminder to us that out sufferings here are indeed minor compared to the intense persecution and cold cruelty faced by the Apostles and disciples during their times for the sake of faith. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. But he that endureth to the end shall be saved.
