5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 29TH APRIL, 2018 THEME: YOUR GRIEF WILL TRUN TO JOY READINGS: Proverbs 4:10-19; Psalm 1;

1 Corinthians 4:4-14-5:1-5; John 16:5-22.

Very truly I tell you, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy. John 6:19, 20(NIV).

The Longman contemporary English dictionary describes Grief as extreme sadness, especially because someone you loved died.

Lots of pain and agony are obvious features of grief. Recently while visiting a close relation in a Teaching Hospital, I got a feeling of people in grief.

Not less than three different incidences that caught my attention. Temper flared as both young and old responded to the failing health of their relations and sometime the death of a loved one. I remembered vividly one particular case of a young lady who was completely disillusioned when the report of her mother's demise was announced. I saw real grief expressed! She wailed and lamented, "They have killed her o!, they have killed her! while still trying to figure out within myself the question who has killed her, she cried out the more in Yoruba Language – "The doctors and nurses killed my mother - God will judge them!. The sorrow and pain varied, to some people it is lack of money to buy drugs for their patients, and for others, it may be spiritual problem.

I realized that it is difficult for anyone to understand the pain or emotion of a sufferer. Technically a counselor needs to pass through the school of suffering before he/she can effectively help a victim of grief because of the individual difference and disposition.

Jesus saw the anxiety of His disciples, evidently the Holy Spirit informed Him of that which they were whispering among themselves – "A little while, and you shall not see me and again, a little while, and you shall see me?". The master needs and helped them.

What are the challenges of a person in grief:

1. The lost of a loved one. Jesus' disciple refused to accept the reality of life that no relationship here on earth is permanent, one day there shall be separation; whether on a temporary or permanent bases.

- 2. In life, it is said that no condition is permanent. The times of grief and joy are with us. To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the Heaven. A time to weep, and w time to laugh; a time to mourn and a time to dance (Eccl. 3:1,4)
- 3. The world and its leaders may have the first laugh but true believers will have the last laugh. "You will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy". Persecution or trials should not derail you as a believer, your time of joy will come.

Jesus taught His disciples to learn from the Spirit of God

– He informed His disciples that The Holy Spirit, the spirit of truth will comfort them.

In times of trouble, the spirit of comfort will help to conquer fear and deliver them from hopelessness and helplessness. Jesus said it is expedient for you that I go away. For if I go not away, the comforter will not come unto you (Jn.16:7). It is the Spirit helps the disciple to encourage one another. In 2Cor.1:3,4.

Paul said, "Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord. Jesus Christ who comforts us in all our tribulation that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.

It is not easy to comfort others when you have not gone through the school of suffering or grief. You don't have to necessarily have the same experience but the Holy Spirit will help you do the work. Philip Yancey, the writer of "where is God when it hurts," wrote: "The only people who can teach us about suffering - both for the sake of our preparations and our attempts to comfort others – are the sufferers themselves" what Yencey want his readers to knows was that, until the comforter, comforts you concerning the sufferer or the man in grief, vou cannot help him. Believers are to comfort one another. The believers should look forward to the joy of the Lord. The joy is likened to a woman after travail of a child delivery, who remembers no more the pain and anguish of delivery. The joy is known as "Christ's joy" – It wipes away all the former sorrow.

How can you enjoy this inexplicable joy?

Seek the spirit of truth. Make the Holy Spirit your partner. God will be glorified in you. As we gradually move from the season of Resurrection to Pentecost, I pray that you begin to experience joy unspeakable and divine elevation in Jesus name.
