CONCLUSION

Faith is the opposite of fear. Fear has torment. The Church of God is a faith movement. To possess our possession we must constantly meditate on our portions in the Lord as contained in the Bible and not the prevailing fearful conditions, for **WITH GOD ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE** and **WE ARE ABLE** – Num. 13:30-end. Psalm 27 vs 1-End as linked to David in the time of his trouble is instructive and applicable to Church leaders in the face of fear.

Fear is described as **FALSE EVIDENCE APPEARING REAL**. It has been established that the word **FEAR NOT** appears 365 times in the Bible. By inference, given 365 days in a calendar year, to every true child of God including those saddled with leadership responsibilities, the word of God is fear not for each day in a year – Is. 43:1-3.

Leadership is quiet exciting. It is a platform to transform people and situations through quality service. It is an opportunity to impact lives through the impartation of inspiration and encouragement. But as rewarding as leadership is, leaders at all levels, secular and spiritual are sometimes assailed by fears.

The first charge God gave Joshua after assuming leadership role further to the home call of Moses was to be courageous and fearless Josh. 1:5-9. Like Joshua in his days, leaders today are bedeviled with (A) Fear of Failure (B) Fear of making wrong decisions (c) Fear of criticism (d) Fear of being misunderstood (E) Fear of Persecution (F) Fear of rejection (G) Fear of the unknown (I) Fear of displeasing people (J) Fear of stepping on toes etc

DANGER

Many leaders on account of **FEAR**

- (a) Abandon their dreams and God given visions
- (b) Put a bar of limitation upon their potential
- (c) Get crippled in enthusiasm and allow irrational thinking sets in.
- (d) Terminate their journey to destiny and divine destination.

THE GIDEON STORY-Judges 7:1-7; 2 Kings 6:16

The fearful were excluded from the divine assignment given to Gideon to avoid defeat and disappointment. They were not part of the testimony of the wining TEAM.

- 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 20TH MAY, 2018

THEME: THE GIFT OF THE SPIRIT SYNOD THEME: THE SOVEREIGN LORD HELPS ME READINGS: Psalm 130; Joel 2:28-32; Acts 2:1-21; John 20:19-31; Isaiah 50:7-9; John 15:1-15

John 20:22. "And when He had said this. He breathed on them, and said to them, Receive the Holy spirit.

Acts 2:4. "And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave utterance.

For meditation this week, the Theme simply put may be summarise thus; **Gift of the Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongue.** The gifts of the Holy Spirit was the promise of the Father that Jesus instructed His disciples to receive, and be commissioned with power. Believers need to realised that without the gift of the spirit in our midst, we can do nothing and destiny can never be fulfilled.

The two texts above are two different and distinct experiences that all new believers must seek to experience; an Apostolic pattern for believers. The first experience happened on resurrection Sunday, Jesus appeared to His apostles in a group for the first time after His resurrection and breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit'. That was the Regeneration experience; the new birth experience. At this point of the salvation experience, a measure of the spirit is given to all believers at birth. How did the apostle attain this experience of the new birth? The answer is found in Rom. 10: 9, 'If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved'. It was a known fact that prior to resurrection Sunday the apostles had already confessed Jesus as Lord. In Matt. 16: 15,16, Jesus asked His disciples "But who do you say I am" Simon Peter on behalf of other answered Him, "You are Christ, the Son of the living God". Now therefore, for the first time they believed that God raised Him from the dead. Thus their salvation experience was completed. (Read the following passages: John 1:12; 3:3,16)

To be born again is to enter into a new life because the righteousness of Christ's death and resurrection is imputed to those who believe. (Rom.8:10) It's a new kind of life that had been imparted,-eternal life that all should desire, which had triumphed over sin and Satan, over death and the grave.

There was a second experience 50days later on Pentecost Sunday. Jesus had commanded His disciples, just before ascension, to wait for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit; to be endued with Power from on high for effective witness and service. (Read Luke 24:49; Acts 1:5, 8; 2:4).

Derek prince in his book foundations for righteous living summarised the two great Sundays and the experiences thus:-

On Resurrection Sunday (Easter) it was

- The Resurrected Christ
- The Inbreathed Spirit
- The Result Life

On Pentecost Sunday. It was:

- The Ascended Christ
- The Outpoured Spirit
- The Result Power

The importance of these two experiences cannot be over emphasised. All true believer in Christ must have these two experiences before they can fulfil God's purpose for their lives.

Some of us (in the Anglican Church) denied ourselves of the privilege of the promise of God – the gift of the Holy Spirit. The word of God says my people for lack of knowledge. Some claimed that speaking in tongue is not for everybody, because it is a gift of God and He distributes accordingly. Yes it is a gift of grace that is freely given just like the gift of salvation.

There are other groups who quipped, that speaking in tongues is a deceit of the pentecostal churches, they say "we are Anglicans and so we do not believe". The truth is that we were first pentecostal before we chose to be Anglicans. We cannot be true Anglicans if we don't have the power of the Holy Spirit.

Friends, you need the second salvation experience, the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Let's search the scripture for more facts.

- 1. All the 120 people in the upper room received the gift of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongue. All of them, no one was left without the experience Acts 2:4.
- 2. In Samaria, we find the two experiences in Acts 8:14-17. First they received salvation though the ministry of Philips and baptism of the Holy Spirit through the ministry of Peter and John by the laying of hands. In the same vain Paul ministry in Ephesus. Acts 19, 5,6).
- 3. Peter's testimony of the baptism with the Holy Spirit upon all members of the household of Cornelius. ALL spoke in tongues (Acts 10:34-48; 11:15-17)

On final note, it is pertinent to sat at this juncture that, without the above mentioned experiences, the nine gifts or manifestation of the spirit mention in 1 Cor. 12:7-10 cannot function. To stir up the nine gifts you need the initial gift of the spirit – Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Do not deny yourself of this supernatural experience with the evidence of speaking in tongue.
