HEARING FROM GOD - 1 Samuel 3:1-7; John 10:27.

A. **AIM:** To avoid becoming spiritual slave of prophets.

To desire to hear God speak to us in a clear accent
To attain spiritual independence and progress.

B. INTRODUCTION

There is no doubt about the fact that God still speaks to His children in audible voice and in many other ways just like He did of old especially in the Bible age as evident in our text for this teaching. Sometimes it is strange to some people when they hear others saying THE LORD TOLD ME; or THE LORD SAYS. This teaching is intended to bring all of us to the level whereby we know that God speaks, to discern when He speaks and to hear from Him as our God.

C. WHY DO WE NEED TO HEAR FROM GOD

- 1. For guidance Jer. 29:11-13.
- 2. To ascertain His will in all situations.
- 3. To avoid becoming a victim of satanic agenda. Jh 10:10
- 4. To know His mind, plan, purpose at every given point in time.
- Fellowship entails dialogue and communication. God talks we listen. We talk He listens. Progress begins when we can hear from God.
- 6. God wants everyone to hear His voice.
- It is one of the best thing that can happen to a Christian who wants a life devoid of errors who wants to move from ZERO to HERO level, from NOBODY to SOMEBODY from minimum to maximum.

D. THE CASE STUDY OF SAMUEL

Spiritual maturity is one of the major prerequisite to HEARING from God. According to our text as at the time God chose to speak to Samuel "SAMUEL DID NOT YET KNOW THE LORD" 1 Sam. 3:7. Like Samuel in Shiloh, sleeping, waking, working, learning under Prophet Eli, many are regular in the Church today but are yet to know the Lord nor how to hear from Him.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 20TH MAY, 2018

THEME: THE TRINITY

READINGS: Psalm 29; Proverbs 8:22-29; **Ephesians 1:3-14; John 14:8-17**

The doctrine of Trinity is foundational to the Christian faith. It is crucial for proper understanding of what God is like, how he relates to us, and how we should relate to him. But it also raises many difficult questions. How can God be both one and three? Is the Trinity a contradiction? If Jesus is God, why do the Gospel record instances where he prayed to God? The doctrine of the Trinity means that there is one God who eternally exists as three distinct Persons — the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Stated differently, God is one in essence and three in person. These definitions express three crucial truths: (1) the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons, (2) each Person is fully God, (3) there is only one God.

The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons. The Bible speaks of the Father as God (Philippians 1:2), Jesus as God (Titus 2:13), and the Holy Spirit as God (Acts 5:3–4). Are these just three different ways of looking at God, or simply ways of referring to three different roles that God plays? The answer must be no, because the Bible also indicates that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons.

For example, since the Father sent the Son into the world (John 3:16), He cannot be the same person as the Son. Likewise, after the Son returned to the Father (John 16:10), the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit into the world (John 14:26; Acts 2:33). Therefore, the Holy Spirit must be distinct from the Father and the Son.

During the baptism of Jesus, we see the Father speaking from heaven and the Spirit descending from heaven in the form of a dove as Jesus comes out of the water (Mark 1:10–11). John 1:1 affirms that Jesus is God and, at the same time, that he was "with God," thereby indicating that Jesus is a distinct Person from God the Father (see also John 1:18). And in John 16:13–15, we see that although there is a close unity between the three persons, the Holy Spirit is also distinct from the Father and the Son.

The fact that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons means, in other words, that the Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit is not the Father. Jesus is God, but He is not the Father or the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is God, but he is not the Son or the Father. They are different Persons, not three different ways of looking at God.

The personhood of each member of the Trinity means that each Person has a distinct center of consciousness. Thus, they relate to each other personally — the Father regards himself as "I" while He regards the Son and Holy Spirit as "you." Likewise, the Son regards himself as "I," but the Father and the Holy Spirit as "you."

Often it is objected, "If Jesus is God, then He must have prayed to himself while He was on earth." But the answer to this objection lies in simply applying what we have already seen. While Jesus and the Father are both God, they are different Persons. Thus, Jesus prayed to God the Father without praying to himself. In fact, it is precisely the continuing dialogue between the Father and the Son (Matthew 3:17; 17:5; John 5:19; 11:41–42; 17:1ff) that furnishes the best evidence that they are distinct Persons with distinct centers of consciousness.

Sometimes the Personhood of the Father and Son is appreciated, but the Personhood of the Holy Spirit is neglected. Sometimes the Spirit is treated more like a "force" than a Person. But the Holy Spirit is not an "it," but a "he" (see John 14:26; 16:7–15; Acts 8:16). The fact that the Holy Spirit is a Person, not an impersonal force (like gravity), is also shown by the fact that he speaks (Hebrews 3:7), reasons (Acts 15:28), thinks and understands (1 Corinthians 2:10–11), wills (1 Corinthians 12:11), feels (Ephesians 4:30), and gives personal fellowship (2 Corinthians 13:14). These are all qualities of personhood.

In addition to these texts, the others we mentioned above make clear that the Personhood of the Holy Spirit is distinct from the Personhood of the Son and the Father. They are three real persons, not three roles God plays. Another serious error people have made is to think that the Father became the Son, who then became the Holy Spirit. Contrary to this, the passages we have seen imply that God always was and always will be three Persons. There was never a time when one of the Persons of the Godhead did not exist. They are all eternal.

While the three members of the Trinity are distinct, this does not mean that any is inferior to the other. Instead, they are all identical in attributes. They are equal in power, love, mercy, justice, holiness, knowledge, and all other qualities.

Each Person is fully God. If God is three Persons, does this mean that each Person is "one third" of God? Does the Trinity mean that God is divided into three parts? The doctrine of the Trinity does not divide God into three parts. The Bible is clear that all three Persons are each one-hundred-percent God. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are each fully God. For example, Colossians 2:9 says of Christ, "in him all the fullness of deity dwells in bodily form." We should not think of God as a "pie" cut into three pieces, each piece representing a Person. This would make each Person less than fully God and thus not God at all. Rather, "the being of each Person is equal to the whole being of God" (Grudem, Systematic Theology, 1994, page 255). The divine essence is not something that is divided between the three persons, but is fully in all three persons without being divided into "parts."

Thus, the Son is not one-third of the being of God; he is all of the being of God. The Father is not one-third of the being of God; he is all of the being of God. And likewise with the Holy Spirit. Thus, as Wayne Grudem writes, "When we speak of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit together we are not speaking of any greater being than when we speak of the Father alone, the Son alone, or the Holy Spirit alone".

There is only one God. If each Person of the Trinity is distinct and yet fully God, then should we conclude that there is more than one God? Obviously we cannot, for Scripture is clear that there is only one God: "There is no other God besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides me. Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other" (Isaiah 45:21–22; see also Isaiah 44:6–8; Exodus 15:11; Deuteronomy 4:35; 6:4–5; 32:39; 1 Samuel 2:2; 1 Kings 8:60).

As you go in the consciousness of this knowledge, know that Christians are not serving three Gods but One God in three persons. Let us therefore put all our hope on this Triune God who is eternally great to meet our need. May the Lord bless our understanding.
