- 7. We must be guided by the inherent benefits in our actions.
- 8. We must set deadliness (Developmental plans)

- 10. The greatest gap in the world is that gap between WHAT WE KNOW and WHAT WE DO knowledge that does not produce action is worthless. When you activate your knowledge you give your life a lift. (John Maxwell)

We need to reactivate the sense of URGENCY in the running of AVMCC.

A church blessed with a conglomeration of expertise, professionals highly connected, highly influential divinely endowed men and women, must be seen as doing better that what we are doing now. AVMCC in glory must not become a BYWARD, A PROVERB or a DESOLATE. LET US BE URGENT, LET US BE MORE BUSINESS LIKE in all our endeavours. Living everyday and every year just as it comes is not the purpose of God for His church. We are to OCCUPY TILL HE COMES.

THE POWER OF URGENCY - TEXT: DAN. 3:22

(A) **DEFINITION OF TERM(S):**

URGENT: Very important and needing immediate attention showing that something is very important and needs immediate attention.

This is synonymous with such words as PRESSING, BURNING, COMPELLING, IMPERATIVE, INSTANT.

(B) **INTRODUCTION:**

The background to our text has to do with refusal of the three Hebrew men to bow down to the golden image made by King Nebuchadnezzar.

God was with them because they stood their ground for the Most High God. They refused to **BOW** yet they were not **BURNT.**

Our focus however bothers on the URGENCY of the directives of the King. Today we as privileged members of the standing committee in AVMCC must carry out the instruction of **THE KING OF KINGS** with the **URGENCY** it requires vs 22.

C. POINTS TO NOTE

- 1. More often than not, the difference between organisation that THRIVE and those that STRUGGLE is the sense of URGENCY they bring into their operations.
- Holding meetings endlessly to generate IDEAS without a commensurate level of EXECUTION amounts to lack of URGENCY which leads to STAGNATION.
- 3. The effectiveness of any meeting is determined by the action generated. One either MEETS or WORKS. Both are not realistic at the same time.
- 4. Urgency is the activation of action and acceleration of process. Urgency is factoring time into actions and operations of organisations. It has to do with being conscious of time in delivering on targets.
- 5. Great ideas occur from time to time. The ones that profit from such ideas are the ones that activate same and do not spend more time than necessary discussing them. It is action taken on the IDEAS generated that brings about positive changes in the life of an organisation.
- Goals are achieved by those who waste no time in acting while those who keep discussing the ideas stay on the same spot.

SOME DANGERS OF NOT BEING URGENT (CASE STUDY NIGERIA CIVIL SERVICE)

- (1) Corruption is imminent where a sense of urgency is lacking.
- (2) Resources are mishandled, misapplied and eventually misappropriated.
- (3) Time is wasted. What could be done in five minutes takes five days, months, years or more
- (4) Resources are squandered
- (5) Stagnation sets in

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6TH MAY, 2018

THEME: HOLDING ON TO THINGS ETERNAL SUB-THEME: HARVEST OF DIVINE COVENANT READINGS: Psalm 68:14-20; Ezekiel 38:8-13; Colossians 3:1-11; John 16:23-33.

The theme of our meditation today is **Holding on to Eternal Things.** One cannot but wonder why this theme on a Rogation Sunday when we should be talking about blessings of the Earth, basking in the joy of the expected abundance of Harvest. **The logic and message of the theme in the context of Rogation is very simple – As we set to reap and enjoy the blessings of Harvest, let us set our focus and gaze on Eternal Things, preparing our souls daily for the Heavenly Harvest.**

Today's theme, **Holding on to Eternal Things**, bothers on the most important essence of the Christian faith – HEAVEN i.e. Eternal Life.

Life everlasting (after death)in the eternal kingdom of God is one universal doctrine of the Church, anchored on belief in the resurrection of the dead as a direct consequence of Christ's resurrection. In John 14:2-3, Jesus told his disciples and all believers, by extension, that he was going to prepare a place for us and come back to take us to that place. And that place is heaven. In His sovereignty, God made the Earth and all that is in it to be temporal and the heaven He designed to be eternal. Concerning this heaven God told us through John's revelation; "There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign forever and ever" (Rev. 22:5).

Heaven is the final destination of the Christian. It is the eternity in view. Our preparation for this eternity in view is the focus of our theme for today. Paul's admonition in Col.3:1-4 serves as the anchor for our meditation:

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. 3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory (NKJV).

Facts to Note:

- We, Christians, have the privilege of insight into the will of God concerning our life. We know that the life we live is a gift from God, meant to be lived to His praise and pleasure (Rev.4:11).
- Because this life is borrowed from God, and it is not our permanent possession, He defines the purpose and rules of our life.
- In being raised with Christ, we have been given vast power for godly living (3:1)
- What we do in the body (the way we live) does concern God (Col.3:17) because everything we say and do reflects on the God we claim to know and love.
- Heaven is reserved for those who live according to God's will and purpose on earth. Apostle Paul makes this clear in 2 Cor. 5:10 – "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad." (NKJV"

How do we hold on to Eternal things?

1. Be sure (3:1)

Paul says in 1 Cor.9:26, "I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air" (KJV). God's everlasting kingdom is prepared for those who are in Christ; hoping to enter into this kingdom of God outside Christ is like beating the air, an exercise in futility. Church and society or ministry membership does not guarantee a place in heaven. Having Jesus and holding on to Him in spirit and in truth is a sine-qua-none requirement you must be sure to fulfill.

2. Watch your affection (3:1-4)

The place of your affection: Heaven, not earth The person of your affection: Jesus, and Jesus alone. There's no clearer explanation of this than the phrase "Jesus, and Jesus alone".

3. Manage your spiritual wardrobe effectively (3:5-17)

Put off: Immorality and idolatry (v.5); anger, malice, slander, and filthy language (v.8); lying (v.9). Why? Because God's anger comes on those who practice them (irrespective of where they are found, be it in the Church pews or chancel). God is no respecter of persons.

Put on: A new nature (vv.10-11); compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience (3:12); forgiveness and love (vv.13-14); God's peace and thankfulness (v.15); the words of Christ (vv.16-17)
