CONCLUSION

Faith is the opposite of fear. Fear has torment. The Church of God is a faith movement. To possess our possession we must constantly meditate on our portions in the Lord as contained in the Bible and not the prevailing fearful conditions, for **WITH GOD ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE** and **WE ARE ABLE** – Num. 13:30-end. Psalm 27 vs 1-End as linked to David in the time of his trouble is instructive and applicable to Church leaders in the face of fear.

JUDGES 7:1,7, JOSHUA 1:5-9.

INTRODUCTION:

Fear is described as **FALSE EVIDENCE APPEARING REAL.** It has been established that the word **FEAR NOT** appears 365 times in the Bible. By inference, given 365 days in a calendar year, to every true child of God including those saddled with leadership responsibilities, the word of God is fear not for each day in a year – Is. 43:1-3.

Leadership is quiet exciting. It is a platform to transform people and situations through quality service. It is an opportunity to impact lives through the impartation of inspiration and encouragement. But as rewarding as leadership is, leaders at all levels, secular and spiritual are sometimes assailed by fears.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 17TH JUNE, 2018

THEME: GOD'S CHILDREN – THROUGH FAITH

READINGS: Psalm 63:1-11; Deuteronomy 7:6-11; Galatians 3:23-4:1-7; Matthew 6:24-34.

Today is **FATHER'S DAY**, a day specially dedicated to celebrating fathers and promoting their commitment to proper understanding and effective discharge of their roles as heads of their respective families in an atmosphere of mutual love and attendant unity. May this be accomplished in our midst today in Jesus' name. Amen.

Today's sermons, in consonance with our Diocesan theme for the year, shall undoubtedly focus on **The Role of Fathers in Securing Help From Above** (Ps.121:2). The appositeness of this beautifully crafted sub-theme notwithstanding, this write-up seeks to take a slightly different route towards same goal by looking at the topic - **Unboxing the Father.** Let it be admitted from the onset that no father can of his own ability raise a godly generation or fulfill any of his God-assigned responsibilities without help from above.

Our diocese, The Diocese of Lagos West, has just held the second edition of her (now to be) annual fathers' conference which is a convocation of representatives of the Christian men in the diocese for the purpose of unboxing their full godly potentials and encouraging them to deploy same towards building successive godly generations without which the general desire or aspiration for a godly society will ever be a mirage. The decision to make the conference an annual event cannot be unconnected with its obvious desirability in view of the emergent facts of failed and/or failing family life that has ostensibly produced for us a peace-starved, tension-soaked world to live in and manage, and not necessarily to enjoy. The Church of God cannot afford to sit on the fence in times like this. While thanking the Diocesan Authority for such a great initiative, which undeniably complements the consistent efforts of the Mothers' Union over the years towards building a godly family for the overall good of our society, it will be more appreciated if effort is made to ensure that the gains of the conference reaches every father, even in the remotest part of the diocese.

We have heard it said severally and in diverse quarters that the world we live in is men's world, a statement that bothers on perceived gender inequality and discrimination. The privilege of men's domination, whether right or wrong, has inadvertently consigned men over the years into a lethargic box that shields them from carrying out their God-assigned responsibilities to the family.

Many men behave as if they exist to "help" their wives get children that are soon to be abandoned to them for whatever kind of training and upbringing they can or care to give; they behave as if good child upbringing comes ex-nihilo, needing no fatherly input. Because this attitude falls short of divine plan and expectations, it has only produced for us an anomic society with attendant breakdown of standards and values. The primal antidote to social anomie is discovery, or should we say, re-discovery and embrace of standards and values. And there are no standards and values that can repair our badly damaged world than godly standards and values as enunciated in the Bible. However, the attainment of these standards and values, as a matter of necessity, involves men as fathers and family Heads.

So, if successive generations of godly people are needed for a godly and better society of our desire, the lethargic box that insulates men from their responsibilities must be broken and men unboxed to deploy the full potentials of their God-given abilities and authority for godly child upbringing and building of good homes and society that God approves for a peaceful world to indwell and enjoy. The recurring reference at the Men's Conference earlier mentioned was God's boasting about Abraham's commitment to godly family upbringing;

Yes, I've settled on him as the one to train his children and future family to observe God's way of life, live kindly and generously and fairly, so that God can complete in Abraham what he promised him. (Gen 18:19, THE MESSAGE).

And Apostle Paul's admonition in Eph.6:4 says "And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord." (NKJV).

There is nowhere in the Bible where fathers are instructed or encouraged to abandon family responsibilities to their wives. Worthy of note in the above Bible references is the fact that children are to be brought up in the way of the LORD, not of the WORLD. It then follows that acceptable fatherhood is the one that is embedded in Christ, since a man cannot give what he does not have. It takes godly parents to raise a godly generation. The starting point for unboxed fathers is to examine themselves to see if they are in the Lord (Lam.3:40) and go back to the drawing board as far as their relationship with God is concerned. It is faith in God through Christ Jesus that makes one a child of God – “For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus” (Gal 3:26-27; NKJV). A father that will build a godly home towards a godly society must first be a man of faith so that he can build his family on faith foundation through the instrumentality of the Scripture. Such a father does not subscribe to worldly standards and values at the expense of God’s own standards and values. He holds tenaciously to biblical standards and values, even in the face of collapsing social and moral values of our present world. Such fathers are produced in Bible Study classes and prayer meetings. They are devoted worshippers that place premium value on the word of God; such fathers are of the genre that entrench their children’s feet on the path of salvation and follow up on their spiritual growth unto Christian maturity. Such are the fathers needed to drive God’s agenda against the boisterous winds that are threatening to sink our world in the sea of violence and global conspiracy against the elect of God.
