Fear is described as FALSE EVIDENCE APPEARING **REAL**. It has been established that the word **FEAR NOT** appears 365 times in the Bible. By inference, given 365 days in a calendar year, to every true child of God including those saddled with leadership responsibilities, the word of God is fear not for each day in a year – Is. 43:1-3.

Leadership is quiet exciting. It is a platform to transform people and situations through quality service. It is an opportunity to impact lives through the impartation of inspiration and encouragement. But as rewarding as leadership is, leaders at all levels, secular and spiritual are sometimes assailed by fears.

#### **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK** 5. SUNDAY, 24<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2018 THEME: MAKING HEAVEN IN THE END **READINGS:** Psalm 119:57-64; Exodus 20:1-17; Ephesians 5:1-10; Matthew 19:16-26.

It is in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ, that we welcome you to Church and this forum this day of the Lord. We congratulate and felicitate with members of the Band of Glory Society as they celebrate their society's anniversary today, and pray that all of us that approach the throne of grace today shall have a refreshing time in His presence. The theme of today's service, Making Heaven in the End, shall double as topic of this writeup, with **HEAVEN** being the thematic focus.

# A Glimpse into Heaven as a Reality

The framing of the topic in view suggests that Heaven is an end, a destination being aspired and probably worked for, by a people, albeit the Christians, in the context of our discourse. It is not a means to an end; it is an end, the ultimate goal of the Christian faith. Theologian J.I. Packer says, "Heaven is shorthand for the Christian's final hope". Heaven is not a synonym for death, as many Christians seem to have been made to erroneously believe, judging by the fact that it is almost only in death situations like service of songs, wake-keep, funeral service and the likes that they hear about heaven. Heaven is the dwelling place of God, and of the angels, and of all the redeemed. It is the place of eternal and abundant life. It is a place, and not a state of being. If you ask where heaven is located, the answer is simple – ABOVE. Every biblical reference to heaven makes this clear. Heaven is not a myth or mirage as atheists and doubters would opine. It is a reality revealed by God through His word, The Bible. Jesus said "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

The Christian doctrine and hope of eternity is anchored on resurrection from the dead unto life; a new life with Jesus Christ in heaven. After the resurrection of Christ, He ascended into Heaven where He sits at the right hand of the Father. And, before His death and resurrection, He told His disciples "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also." John 14:2-3. 7.

# What exactly will heaven be like?

The Apostle Paul says in 1 Cor.2:9 (quoting Isa.64:4) "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." (NKJV).To say more than this is impossible since, as Louis Jacobs observed in one of his writings, *For human beings in this world to try to grasp the nature of the hereafter is like a man born blind trying to grasp the nature of color*.

However, glimpses into Scriptural teachings and revelations about heaven make us to know, among other things, that in heaven:

- We will have new, perfected, imperishable bodies, free from disease and decay (1 Cor.15:35—53)
- We will be in fellowship with the Triune God, serving Him day and night, and with the people of God. Rev.7:15
- We will live in a kingdom where God himself dwells, the New Jerusalem, akin to this earth, but a new and transformed earth.
- We shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike us, nor any heat; for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne (of God) will shepherd us and lead us to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from our eyes – No more sorrow. Rev 7:16-17

Herein lies the crux of our discourse; those aspiring unto making heaven at the end of their earthly pilgrimage must run the race by its rules. We cannot make heaven by chance or by accident. We shall make it by the special grace of God that appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ (Titus 2:12-13, NKJV)

Isaiah peeped into the configuration of heaven when he wrote;

There will be a highway called the Holy Road. No one rude or rebellious is permitted on this road. It's for God's people exclusively impossible to get lost on this road. Not even fools can get lost on it. No lions on this road, no dangerous wild animals — Nothing and no one dangerous or threatening. Only the redeemed will walk on it. The people God has ransomed will come back on this road. They'll sing as they make their way home to Zion... (Isa 35:8-10a, THE MESSAGE)

Today's lections concertedly teach us not to leave our desire for heaven to chances. There is need for deliberate efforts on our part to tread the path of holiness that leads to heaven.

The Psalmist teaches us to make the Lord our portion by keeping His words and remain ever guided by His commandments.

Exodus 20:1-17 outline the Ten Commandments, being the foundational laws of God which are not grievous and so till today, have not been abolished. They still point attention to God and guide heaven-bound pilgrims in their earthly journey.

The Epistle from Eph.5:1-10 admonishes as many of us as are heavenly focused to:

- Be imitators of God, patterning our lives after His acceptable standards
- Live sober and thankful life, avoiding talkativeness that leads to sin
- Shun the evils of sinful pleasures that come from adultery, fornication covetousness, idolatry etc.
- Live as children of light in all goodness, righteousness and truth.

The Gospel, Matt.19:16-26, warns us against partial commitment to making heaven, thinking we can make up the areas of our willful deficiency with rhetorical confessions and prayers. God needs the whole of our heart, mind and soul; bringing all in subjection to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

In today's Gospel reading, we can see Jesus' disciples expressing despair that nobody probably can make heaven, given their perception of the stake as being too high. Jesus however told them "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."Matt 19:26. It is this note of possibility that we will leave and implore you to see heaven as a project within your reach with the help of God. You can make it, go ahead and live for Jesus every day, and you will be surprised how close to heaven you are.
