- 3. Perception of issues from a jaundiced view. Leadership organizational success has a lot to do with perspective, perspective speaks of outlook and the outlook determines the outcome.
- 4. Inability to take proper action.
- 5. Inability to reinforce and enforce what is RIGHT.
- 6. Inability to correct what is WRONG.
- 7. The leader is disrobe of sensibility.
- 8. Ineptitude sets in (Lack of skill or ability)
- 9. Inability to make serious and appreciable impact.
- 10. The personality and interest of leadership in decision making more often than not impact negatively, reason medical practitioners are not allowed to treat their relations.
- 11. Sentiments affect our judgement, beclouding it.
- 12. Sentiment poses a challenge to our professionalism.

LEADERSHIP AND SENTIMENT: A CURSE OR A BLESSING

A

- 1. Sentiment is a thought which is influenced by emotion. Sentiment has to do also with an attitude or opinion. It is a feeling of love, sympathy, kindness etc. It is an attitude, thought or judgement prompted by feeling.
- 2. In our text, the replacement of Judas Iscariot was administratively expedient and prophetically desirable.
- 3. However there appeared to have been a little bit of sentiment in the emergence of a worthy replacement. (A) They chose two based on the condition stipulated by themselves not necessarily put in place by God. (B) They ask God to pick from between the two (C) They cast lot and Mathias emerged (Compare this with the commissioning of Saul and Barnabas in Acts 13:1-3)
- 4. A comparative analysis of the emergence of Apostle Paul and that of Mathias by way of inference might imply that God actually intended Paul to replace Judas among the 12 Apostle. Paul never satisfied the conditions put forward by Peter yet God chooses the despised and weak things of this world to shame the wise. 1 Cor. 1:26-28.

THEME: LEARNING THE ART OF

LEADERSHIP FROM CHILDREN

READINGS: Psalm 119:81-96; 1 Peter 5:1-11;

Matthew 18:1-16.

INTRODUCTION

The Anglo-Saxon etymological origin of the words lead, leader, and leadership is lead, which stands for "path" or "road." The verb leaden means "to travel." Thus a leader is one who shows fellow travelers the way by walking ahead. This metaphor of the leader as helmsman is still very much on the mark. Unfortunately, the clarity of leadership's etymology is rarely matched with clarity of meaning. Papers, books, and articles claiming to delineate leadership proliferate, yet their conclusions can be confusing and even conflicting. Indeed, one of the major scholars of leadership has observed that "there are almost as many definitions of leadership as there are persons who have attempted to define the concept" (Bass, 1990, p. 11). What is Leadership? A simple definition is that leadership is the art of motivating a group of people to act towards achieving a common goal. According to Koontz, H. and C. O'Donnell in Management: A System of Contingency Analysis of Managerial Functions (1976) "influencing people so that they will strive willingly towards the achievement of group goals"

This leadership definition captures the essentials of being able to inspire others and being prepared to do so. Effective leadership is based upon ideas (whether original or borrowed), but won't happen unless those ideas can be communicated to others in a way that engages them enough to act as the leader wants them to act.

An effective leader possess the following characteristics: self-confidence, strong communication and management skills, creative and <u>innovative</u> thinking, perseverance in the face of failure, willingness to take <u>risks</u>, openness to change, and levelheadedness and reactiveness in times of <u>crisis</u>.

The Concept of Servant Leadership

The very notion of a servant as leader, or "servant-leadership" as it has come to be known, is purposefully oxymoronic and arresting in nature. The theory's originator, Robert K. Greenleaf, intentionally sought a descriptor that would give people pause for thought, and challenge any long-standing assumptions that might be held about the relationship between leaders and followers in an organization. By combining two seemingly contradictory terms, Greenleaf asks us to reconsider the very nature of leadership.

Larry Spears, Executive Director of the Robert K. Greenleaf Center for Servant-Leadership, succinctly defines servant-leadership as:

A new kind of leadership model – a model which puts serving others as the number one priority. Servant-leadership emphasizes increased service to others; a holistic approach to work; promoting a sense of community; and the sharing of power in decision-making.

The critical element in the above definitions are service to others, holistic approach to work, promoting a sense of community and sharing power in decision making. Servant Leadership theory argues that the most effective leaders are servants of their people. Servant leaders get results for their organization through whole-hearted attention to their followers and followers' needs. Unlike many approaches to leadership, which offer suggestions on how toplevel leaders can influence and motivate those further down the hierarchy, servant leadership puts its emphasis collaboration, trust, empathy, and ethics. The leader should be a servant first, leading from a desire to better serve others and not to attain more power. The assumption is that if leaders focus on the needs and desires of followers, followers will reciprocate through increased teamwork, deeper engagement, and better performance.

Servant-leadership, therefore, emphasizes core personal characteristics and beliefs over any specific leadership techniques. This is seen throughout the writings of Robert K. Greenleaf, from his first, seminal essay on servant-leadership to his posthumously published writings. Behavioral theorists have identified 10 major leadership characteristics, or 'attributes' in Greenleaf's writings (Russell & Stone, 2002, p. 146):

- 1. Listening A critical communication tool
- Empathy The ability to mentally project one's own consciousness into that of another individual.
- Healing The servant-leader recognizes the shared human desire to find wholeness in one's self, and supports it in
- Awareness Without awareness, "we miss leadership opportunities"
- Persuasion The effective servant-leader builds group consensus through "gentle but clear and persistent persuasion, and does not exert group compliance through position power.
- Conceptualization The servant-leader can conceive solutions to problems that do not currently exist
- Foresight "Prescience, or foresight, is a better than average guess about what is going to happen when in the future".
- Stewardship Organizational stewards, or 'trustees' are concerned not only for the individual followers within the organization, but also the organization as a whole, and its impact on and relationship with all of society.
- Commitment to the growth of people A demonstrated appreciation and encouragement of others.
- Building community The rise of large institutions has eroded community, the social pact that unites individuals in society.

Russell and Stone (2002), in further clarifying the attributes proposed a list of 20 distinctive attributes observed in servantleaders, as derived from scholarly literature. They further categorized these 20 attributes into 9 'functional attributes' and 11 'accompanying attributes'. Functional attributes are defined as intrinsic characteristics of servant-leaders, accompanying attributes complement and enhance the functional attributes:

Functional Attributes

- 6. Modeling 7. Pioneering 8. Appreciation
- 9. Empowerment

Servant Leadership in the context of Matthew 18: 1-8 & 1 Peter 5: 1-10

In the text of Matthew 18, Christ made Childlikeness as key character of the Kingdom life. He confronts the tendency of humankind to associate authority with an exercise of dominance over others. The dominion or authority in kingdom life God wants to reinstate in us, is for victorious, fruitful living and for the overthrow of hellish powers, not for gaining control of others or for serving our own interests. The call to childlike humility and a servant-like heart (John 13: 1-7) establishes the spirit and style by which the authority of the believer is to be exercised as agent of God's kingdom power (See Matt 19: 14; Mark 10: 14, 15; Luke 18: 16, 17). The use of *tapeinoo* the Greek word translated humbles in the English translation of Matthew 18: 4 literally means 'to make low', used of mountain in Luke 3: 5. Metaphorically, the word means to debase, humble, and lower oneself. It describes a person who is devoid of all arrogance and self-exaltation – a person who is willingly submitted to God and His will.

This views are corroborated by the Apostle Peter in 1 Peter 5: 1-10 in addressing the leadership situation in the Church. Peter appealed to Church leaders to be reminded that they should lead in view of the fact that they are under-leaders and so should not be domineering over their sub-ordinates.

Qualities of Children for Leadership

- b. Readiness to learn or easily correctable
- c. Continual trust in parental leadership
- d. Emotional attachment to parents
- e. Transparent expression of feelings (joy, sadness, hunger, desires, acceptance, and rejection)—See g below for follow up
- f. Spontaneously forgiving countless times
- g. Like love,

Conclusion

This views in this texts of scripture Matthew 18: 1-18 and 1 Peter 5: 1-10 is in tandem with the concept of Servant leadership. The Selflessness, Childlikeness, Humility and Team Spirit expressed in the texts are essential requirements for influencing people towards achieving common desired end.
