- 6. Stay on the Lord's side, only be moved by God's word. Let God have the final say Josh. 1:8.
- 7. Be determined and be courageous in faith and action.

CONCLUSION

Faith is the opposite of fear. Fear has torment. The Church of God is a faith movement. To possess our possession we must constantly meditate on our portions in the Lord as contained in the Bible and not the prevailing fearful conditions, for **WITH GOD ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE** and **WE ARE ABLE** – Num. 13:30-end. Psalm 27 vs 1-End as linked to David in the time of his trouble is instructive and applicable to Church leaders in the face of fear.

Fear is described as **FALSE EVIDENCE APPEARING REAL**. It has been established that the word **FEAR NOT** appears 365 times in the Bible. By inference,

NOT appears 365 times in the Bible. By inference, given 365 days in a calendar year, to every true child of God including those saddled with leadership responsibilities, the word of God is fear not for each day in a year – Is. 43:1-3.

Leadership is quiet exciting. It is a platform to transform people and situations through quality service. It is an opportunity to impact lives through the impartation of inspiration and encouragement. But as rewarding as leadership is, leaders at all levels, secular and spiritual are sometimes assailed by fears.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 8TH JULY, 2018

THEME: GOD'S COMPASSION SUB-THEME: MERCY IN TIME OF WRATH READINGS: Psalm 119:33-48; Hosea 11:1-9; 1 John 2:8-17; Mark 12:28-34.

David said in Psalm 86: 15-16 "But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth. O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give thy strength unto thy servant, and save the son of thine handmaid"

1. Introduction

Compassion is God's blessing to us. He is a compassionate God. If he marks iniquity, none can stand. Blessed be God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places. The LORD'S loving-kindnesses indeed never ceases, for His compassion never fails. (Lam. 3:22). If God's compassion fails, man is doomed! The story of Gomer and Hosea tells us a lot about how treacherous we are to God, yet he shows mercy instead of condemning us (Hosea 11:9). The Father of the Prodigal son in Luke 15:20 is typical "His father saw him and felt compassion, and ran and embraced him and kissed him." That verse is very significant because it shows us that compassion is more than just a feeling. A major reason mankind is still in existence is because of God's compassion.

It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not (Lamentation 3:22)

2. Revelation of God

God declares Himself as compassionate, merciful, loving and gracious. It is God's nature to be compassionate and merciful.

Exodus 33:19. And He said, "I Myself will make all My goodness pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show compassion on whom I will show compassion."

Exodus 34:5-6 "Then the Lord came down in the cloud and stood there with him and proclaimed his name, the Lord. And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness". Should we avail ourselves of this? Yes. When we err, we can seek God's help to return to him. He can help us walk aright. He can take pains away and bring succor. Should we be thankful for this? Yes. We should be extremely thankful for who can face the wrath of God? Who could have helped us when we erred or needed help? Should we abuse this? No. God's compassion is not a weakness but a massive strength; his very nature.

3. God Is Full Of Compassion

God's compassion cannot be quantified or measured. He is just full of it. He has it in abundance. God can empathize or sympathize beyond human imagination. He has declared that he is "merciful and gracious, long suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin" (Exodus 34:6, 7)

The New Testament asserts that our God is "full of compassion" (James 5:11). God has revealed Himself as "compassionate". The Scripture testifies to this again and again. This has massive implications for our relating to God. We often rebel against God, violate His commands, and disregard His love. We pursue false gods, idols, little treasures in our heart that we think will serve us better than Him. We doubt His goodness or sovereignty. We take advantage of His grace and we prioritize our agendas over His. We are wicked and the Bible says that God in His justice should condemn us all. But, as the passages above indicate, God is compassionate. He offers mercy and grace to us. He knows our weaknesses, infirmities, temptations, and proclivities, and while He never excuses our sins, He is "slow to anger." This is an invitation for sinners to come to God. God invites us to Him, He has mercy on us and does not condemn us immediately for our rebellion but desires that we would all come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9). He is compassionate even to sinners in that He delights to take their sin away from them (Micah 7:19; Ps. 103:3-4).

4. God's heart, not Jonah's heart — Jonah 4:2

God expects us to have his heart, not Jonahs.

- God chose to reach the Ninevites despite their sinfulness and Jonah's reluctance.
- Jonah knows this and complains about God's redeeming nature toward Jonah's enemies in his own prayer.
- While Jonah was worried about his temporary comfort under the shade of a plant, God was concerned for the 120,000 souls
- God's heart in three facets: Caring Forgiving Redeeming. This is what we should be.
- We need to move from **Pity to Compassion**. Pity reveals an arrogance that simply says it is sad that your life is a mess, but I can't be seen with you.
- Pity shakes its head in sympathy. Compassion takes on the challenge in empathy. Compassion is desire for redemption in such measure that we are compelled to go and care for those in need of light.
- Who would we be if God simply left us to ourselves and stopped running after us?
- Jonah's heart turns us into selfish, inwardly-focused, judgmental, religious hacks.
- For those outside the faith, they would be left without hope to eternally perish in their sin. God's compassion saved Nineveh.

5. Compassion and Redemption

"For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are-yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need" (Heb 4:15-16). It is so convenient to agree that God saw how helpless mankind was in returning to Him. He had to do something about that. Jesus had to come the human way to empathize with mankind. One will love Hebrews 2:17-18, "For this reason he had to be made like them, fully human in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might

make atonement for the sins of the people. Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted". Man needed more than Prophets, Judges and Angels. Man's case required the very presence of God in their midst. When God moves with compassion, he is saving, healing, breaking yokes and delivering.

6. Compassion Driven Jesus

We could see compassion preceding virtually all the miracles Jesus performed. **Jesus compassion always leads to action**, whether healing, feeding, providing, or calling others to serve!

- a. The account of the leper in Mark 1:40-41 is touching. Nobody touches a leper but Jesus touched him! Jesus was moved with compassion when he saw the state of the man. He was in a deplorable and painful situation. He needed a quick help
- b. Matthew 14:14 tells us that Jesus had compassion on the great crowd following him so he healed the sick and then fed the 5000.
- c. Matthew 15:32 says that Jesus felt the same compassion on another crowd and so fed the 4000.
- d. Matthew 20:34 tells us that when Jesus saw the two blind men of Jericho, he was filled with compassion and healed them on the spot.
- e. John 5:6 tells us that Jesus knew that the man had had infirmity for 38years and he had no one to help him get into the water. He healed him on the spot.
- f. Mark 1:40-41 offers the most telling example of what compassion meant to our Lord Jesus. A leper came to him, imploring him, and kneeling said to him, "If you will, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand and touched him and said to him, "I will; be clean."

Conclusion

God hasn't and can't run out of being compassionate and merciful but he chooses who to show it to. He chose to have mercy on Nineveh in spite of Jonah's resentment of the idea. He chose to pardon Saul and turned him to Paul. He chose to forgive the woman caught in adultery. It is his prerogative but you know what? We can access our beautiful father and ask for compassion and mercy? He is good and his mercy endures forever. Hallelujah
