Though the disciples prayed before his emergence, they appeared not to have fully trusted God for divine direction given their recourse to the superstitious practice of casting lots. No record of Mathias' evangelical exploit after his election, though tradition has it that he went to Ethiopia, laboured there and was martyred there.
- 6. The emergence of King Saul in Israel could also be described as based on sentiment, a desire to be like neighbouring nations thus neglecting and rejecting the Most High God. 1 Sam. 8:4-22.
- 7. Leaders must learn to see issues the way they really are for a wrong perception of an issue subject the issue to wrong diagnosis, wrong solution and wrong results.
- 8. The interference of our personal interest in any given situation amounts to being controlled by sentiment. A state of absolute disinterestedness is highly desirable to make headway in leadership.

B. DANGERS OF SENTIMENT IN LEADERSHIP DECISION.

- Surrendering to emotion which sometimes beclouds reasoning because it distorts the reality.
- 2. Loss of the power of objectivity.
- 3. Perception of issues from a jaundiced view. Leadership organizational success has a lot to do with perspective, perspective speaks of outlook and the outlook determines the outcome.
- 4. Inability to take proper action.
- 5. Inability to reinforce and enforce what is RIGHT.
- 6. Inability to correct what is WRONG.
- 7. The leader is disrobe of sensibility.
- 8. Ineptitude sets in (Lack of skill or ability)
- 9. Inability to make serious and appreciable impact.
- The personality and interest of leadership in decision making more often than not impact negatively, reason medical practitioners are not allowed to treat their relations.
- 11. Sentiments affect our judgement, beclouding it.
- 12. Sentiment poses a challenge to our professionalism.

LEADERSHIP AND SENTIMENT: A CURSE OR A BLESSING

A.

- 1. Sentiment is a thought which is influenced by emotion. Sentiment has to do also with an attitude or opinion. It is a feeling of love, sympathy, kindness etc. It is an attitude, thought or judgement prompted by feeling.
- 2. In our text, the replacement of Judas Iscariot was administratively expedient and prophetically desirable.
- 3. However there appeared to have been a little bit of sentiment in the emergence of a worthy replacement. (A) They chose two based on the condition stipulated by themselves not necessarily put in place by God. (B) They ask God to pick from between the two (C) They cast lot and Mathias emerged (Compare this with the commissioning of Saul and Barnabas in Acts 13:1-3)
- 4. A comparative analysis of the emergence of Apostle Paul and that of Mathias by way of inference might imply that God actually intended Paul to replace Judas among the 12 Apostle. Paul never satisfied the conditions put forward by Peter yet God chooses the despised and weak things of this world to shame the wise. 1 Cor. 1:26-28.

SUNDAY, 5TH AUGUST, 2018

THEME: FELLOWSHIP AMONG BELIEVERS READINGS: Psalm 119:97-112; 1 Chronicles 29:1-9; Acts 2:41-47: Motthey 25:31-46

Acts 2:41-47; Matthew 25:31-46.

Introduction

The English word "fellowship" is derived from the Greek "koinonia", which involves communion and friendship with God. Fellowship connects a believer to other believers in the Spirit of God, and with God's blessings. It was a post-Pentecost relationship of Believers with God and with one another. How did God provide for His people to enjoy fellowship with Him?

- 1. God initiated fellowship with man from the beginning. He placed Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden to enjoy friendship and communion with Him, but this relationship was broken when Adam and Eve chose to assert themselves rather than live under the gracious care of God. As a result, they both lost the presence of the Lord having been sent out of the Garden (Gen.3:8). However, God immediately sought for other avenue to reveal his plan and purpose to restore sinners through the work of the Redeemed (Gen.3:15). Thus, God began to draw a special people into fellowship with Himself, at one point in time, toward the accomplishment of His redemptive work.
- 2. God made His permanent home in each believer's heart through Christ's work on the cross (John 14:23). Hence, the fellowship that is now available is nothing less than the spiritual union of the believers with Christ (John 14:20-21).
- •The nature of fellowship of believers in the early church
- a. The believers met together in house groups for teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, and prayer (Acts 2:42,46).
- b. Their sense of togetherness was so profound that they pooled their possessions together and distributed them to brothers and sisters in need (Acts 2:44-45; 4:32-35).
- c. They made LOVE their dominant characteristic (1Thess.4:9; 1Pet. 1:22).
- d. Being motivated by love, they organised a collection for poor believers in Jerusalem, and contributed to the ministry of the saints (Rom.15:26; Phil.1:5; 4:14-15).

- Images used to describe the spirit of togetherness of the early church
- 1. The house of God (Eph.2:19; 1Tim.3:15).
- 2. The household of faith (Gal.6:10).
- 3. The family of God on earth (Eph.3:15).
- 4. The one new man or the one body (Eph.2:15-16).

It should be noted that in spite of the great differences in the body, the Holy Spirit binds believers together into a single being (Eph. 4:4-6). Therefore, in this fellowship of love, no believer is unnecessary as each member has been specially gifted for the spiritual building up of the entire body.

• The basis of Christian fellowship

Jesus Christ is the source and fount of all spiritual communion. Only when rightly related to the Lord do we experience true fellowship with another Christian. Just as light and darkness are incompatible, so a believer can have no real fellowship with an unbelievable. In the same vein, the Christian cannot be in fellowship with one who walks contrary to the teaching of Christ(2John 1:9-11).

- Guidelines for enhancing the fellowship of believers
- 1. Love one another with the same compassion that Christ demonstrated to his own (John 13:34-35; 15:12). The Law of the fellowship should be the rule of love (Hebrews 13:1).
- 2. Cultivate that spirit of humility that seeks the other person's honour, not your own (Phil. 2:3-5).
- 3. Lighten fellow believers' loads by bearing one another's burdens (Gal.6:2).
- 4. Share your possessions with brothers and sisters in need (2Cor.9:13).
- 5. Tenderly correct a sinner while helping to find solutions to his or her problems (Gal.6:1).
- 6. Listen to a fellow believer in times of suffering (1Cor.12:26).
- 7. Pray for one another in the Spirit without ceasing (Eph. 6:18).

Conclusion

In the household of God, love and hospitality are to be the rule. The life of God's family is to be governed by love, tenderness, compassion and humility. We cannot do this unless we walk in the light of God, as the Scripture says, "If we walk in the light...we have fellowship with one another"(1John 1:7).
