5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 14th OCTOBER, 2018

THEME: CHRISTIAN UNITY

READINGS: GENESIS 11:1-9; EPHESIANS 3:20-4:6; JOHN 11:17-27; JOB 4:1&5:1-6; PSALM 24; HEBREWS 10:19-END; LUKE 18:1-14

Any time there is open conflict in a Church, media houses rejoice. At least they have something that interests almost every other person on the street to talk and write about; of course not without attendant increase in their bank balances. Reason for this is not farfetched; every person out there expects perfect peace in the House of God. Their expectation is not misplaced; God created a very good world (Gen.1:31) *without trouble or war* (emphasis mine), Jesus prayed for unity of the Church (John 17:11,22). Unity anchored on love is the evidence that the believers are true disciples of Christ (John 13:35). Peace and conflict management experts however, posit that conflict is ubiquitous, i.e. conflict lives with us, it is present everywhere, including the Church. This probably stems from their theoretical premise that it is unavoidable; it can only be managed. Well, conflict to them is not a big deal; it is just any form of divergence in opinions. But, the divergence is the basis of quarrels and disunity in every human organization, including the Church. Love, unity and peace are divine. They are attributes that flow from God to man.

Unity among believers (Christians) is desired by God from those that claim to know and have Him as their Father. This is presumably the reason He created us in His own image, after His own likeness, which means that we are free to make choices: to love, to create, to reason, and to live in harmony with Him and with creation. When God’s own people now live in disharmony with one-another, it certainly becomes an issue that must be confronted and addressed in all truthfulness and sincerity, which one can guess, is the aim of today’s theme across the whole Church of Nigeria – Christian Unity.

As if eulogizing the unimaginable potential for great achievements derivable from the synergetic power of unity, which of course is evident in the Tower of Babel Project (Gen.11:1-9), David, in Psalm 133, extolled the virtues of blessed unity of the people of God. He described our (Christian) unity as good and pleasant and likened it to **two** precious things of spiritual value:

1. *It is like the precious (anointing) oil upon the head (v.2)* – The anointing of God upon every true believer **establishes** us so that we do not fall (2 Cor 1:21-22) and **enlightens** us so that we do not go astray (1 John 2:20,27). Every believer needs this strengthening and teaching ministry of God’s Spirit which thrives only in the atmosphere of unity, not of discord.

2. *It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion (v.3).* This talks about our spiritual refreshing. Those who have been involved in Church politics and in-fighting are better positioned to tell what it means to come back from Church service spiritually refreshed.

A Bible commentator wrote concerning this Psalm "The dew speaks of fruitfulness and the anointing oil speaks of fragrance, for the unity of God's people is both "good and pleasant." We however must not forget the conclusion of the Psalm – **For there (where the people of God dwell in unity) the Lord commanded the blessing.** So, there is blessing in unity; meaning that blessings of God are hindered in the atmosphere of quarrels, bitterness and disunity. Of course, why won't blessings flow in an atmosphere of unity, when God Himself testified that **impossibility has no chance there** - "Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them." Gen.11:6.

The church began in visible unity (Acts 2:1,44,46), but when you read Paul's epistles, you find a sad story of rivalry and division, and it is not much better today. Look where you will, you'll find the Church that is awash with quarrels, bitterness, politics, unhealthy rivalry and competition, and such things that divide us. This piece does not intend to celebrate this sad commentary on the Church, but to remind us that God desires our unity. Paul wrote in Rom.10:1-4 Rom 10:1-4:

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. 2 For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. 3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. 4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

The summary of all theories and postulations on the cause and effects of disunity among believers is that **Jesus Christ is professed but not enthroned in our hearts. If and when He is, all the ambitions and pride of earthly pursuits and achievements that drive and drift us away from God and one another shall cease.** Paul wrote in 1 Cor 3:3-4; "For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? 4 For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not carnal?" It is high time the Church moved away from carnality unto true spirituality because "the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." John 4:23-24.

May God give us understanding.
