Once upon a time the king of evil spirits gathered his followers together to hear reports of their work.

"Now, my good spirit", began their master, "what have you done today to weaken the kingdom of God? We have been busy today making empty seats in churches" began one. "Nothing could please me better" Answered their king.

"I persuaded one man that he had headache. I kept him from hearing a sermon that might have changed his whole life" said one.

I induced one good man to slip to his store and fix his books, said another"

"Good" said the king. "He'll soon give up the church attendance altogether".

I worried a good sister about her old head tie and she decided to stay home until she got a new one, "spoke up the spirit called Pride" "And made several poor women stay home even though they were hungry for God's Word. I just told them they were too poor to wear fine clothes so why go where rich people will look down on them".

That is one of the best ways to cheat poor people out of the blessing of God, "answered the king with approval"

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 4TH NOVEMBER, 2018 THEME: PRAYER CHANGES SITUATION READINGS: II KINGS 20:1-17; PSALM 103:1-18; ACTS 9:32-35; JOHN 5:2-14.

He turned his face to the wall and prayed to the LORD, "Please LORD, Remember how I have served you faithfully and with whole hearted devotion, and how I have carried out your will". Then Hezekiah wept bitterly (2Kings 20:2,3).

There are men who served and sought the LORD with Tears, causing great revivals and havoc in the kingdom of hell. Men like David, Ezra, Nehemiah, Jeremiah, Paul and Jesus Christ, just to mention a few from the Bible. During reformation and medieval period God raised men who yearn for revival of souls of their people. John Knox prayed, "Lord, give me Scotland or I die". Oswald J. Smith wrote in his diary, "I must experience God's power no matter what it costs. Oh, that He would break me down and cause me to weep for the salvation of souls. Finney, in his memoirs repeatedly mention praying with tears. Any tear shed in sharing the heartbeat of God, any tear shed through Christ like loving empathy with our fellow men, any teat born out of compassion for bringing sick men back to wholeness.

When the great Prophet Isaiah visited King Hezekiah who was sick unto death (terminal illness) and said to him, "This is what the LORD says, Give your house hold instructions, for you are about to die; you will not get well". Hezekiah did not plead with the man of God to reverse his prophecy, the Bible says, "He turned his face to the wall and prayed to the LORD", with tears.

It is important we understand the antecedent of King Hezekiah, his root and how he found himself in this situation. Hezekiah came to the throne at one of the darkened moment in Judah's history. His father Ahaz was such a failure as a King, so wicked, and did so much evil that the people were fed up and God was not pleased with his reign because he "did not do what was right in the eyes of the LORD". Judah's pride was cut off and the nation reduced to disgrace, attacked on all sides by neighbouring nations. In the midst of all these Hezekiah was born. The very year Hezekiah was born God called Isaiah by a wonderful vision and made him His Prophet. Hezekiah would naturally followed in Ahaz's footsteps. It was believed that Isaiah was raised by God to mentor the young King Hezekiah for restoration of Judah. Surely Isaiah became the Counselor-Pastor to Hezekiah. They may as well talked and prayed together often about how Hezekiah could turn the nation back to God during his time as King. The result of the effort was the Revival and Reformation that took place in Judah.

In summary, Hezekiah's success was simply put, He did "what was good and right and faithful before the LORD his God. In everything that he undertook in the service of God's temple and in obedience to the law and the command's he sought his God and worked wholeheartedly. And so he prospered" (2 Chron. 31:20-21).

From the text, the steps to effective **PRAYER THAT CHANGES SITUATION:**

First, Turn away from your riches, status and grandeur. See yourself as undone, helpless, sinful by confessing all unconfessed sin, and totally depended on the mercy of God.

Second, Hezekiah prayed, "I beseech you, O LORD. To beseech is to beg someone for something: to ask in a serious and emotional what to do something. He attributes all glory and majesty to whom all adoration and honour was due. Hezekiah humbled himself in the presence of the Most High. Likewise, you are enjoined to seek God in humility and awe.

Finally, he continued, "remember now how I have walked before you in truth and perfect heart, and have done that which is good in your sight: Answered prayers belongs to the people closest to God.

Hezekiah wept sore, declaring in humility all that God used him to do, and perhaps all that was in the pipe-line. He must have told God why he deserved to live and be in good health to complete the work that was set before him. Hezekiah knew the will of God for his life, and beseeched Him for healing. Note the content of his Prayer: His walk with God was right, he served God in truth and with a perfect heart and was always desiring to do that which is good in God's sight. God ensure that Hezekiah's tears was not shed in vain.

Your tears will draw the attention of the TRIUNE GOD and great reward shall be your portion in Jesus name.

Listen to the LORD, "I have heard your prayer: I have seen your tears. Look, I will heal you..... I will shield this city for the sake of my reputation and because of my promise to David my Servant". Hezekiah's prayer model is good for you in times like this. The Church need to cry out unto God for change.

One of the greatest tools that is needed to secure our future is meaningful and fervent prayer. It is my prayer that effectual fervent prayer will unveil the mystery of godliness for you in Jesus name. The Lord will attend to your case speedily in Jesus name. Read Acts 12:1-12.
