5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 11TH NOVEMBER, 2018

THEME: THE CALL TO FELLOWSHIP IN A CHANGING WORLD

READINGS: EXODUS 24:12-18; PSALM 68:1-13; HEBREWS 10:19-24; MATTHEW 18:18-20.

A. Introduction

The world is changing. Not just changing but changing very rapidly. It is alarming and disturbing. It is as if everything and everyone is in a hurry. Someone said it seems the earth is rotating faster in its orbit. Information generation, communication and genetic engineering are major areas of developments in recent decades. Today's world is very different from even a generation ago. It is hard to imagine the world that our children or grandchildren will inhabit. Generation Z is here. What happens afterwards? What was unacceptable before is now acceptable. Abnormality gets a nod of acceptance. I asked my friends the other day, to mention names of Nigerian Gospel Music Ministers, they could hardly mutter five. Those we know now are not too different from secular pop stars. We accept them - inclusivity?! Altar is changing to entertainment stage. Christian Programs are being called 'shows' and 'gigs'. Church has become so uneasily variegated. Fellowship is threatened by cyber innovations. Some don't want to come to Church. They prefer to watch services from home. People are giving Scriptures convenient meanings and interpretations.

The proliferation of Bible Versions is not helping. We know about the "population explosion" and the "explosion of scientific knowledge," but we are also in the middle of a "Bible translation explosion"-flood of new Bible translations, versions, revisions and paraphrases, all claiming to be the "most accurate," the "most readable" and the "most up-to-date."In 2 Corinthians 2:17, the Spirit of God warned against the "many which corrupt the word of God. Unfortunately, many people today fail to see that even greater corruptions of the Word of God are taking place before our eyes. However, we have comfort in Psalm 119:89: "Forever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven." How thankful we are that "the foundation of God stands sure" (2 Timothy 2:19).

One thing is sure; we have a never-changing gospel for an ever-changing world.

B. Christian Fellowship

In the early Church, people gathered together for worship. Soon after the crucifixion of Christ, His followers were gathered together on the Day of Pentecost: "When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place" (Acts 2:1). Notice they were not only gathered together, they were also of the same mind ("one accord"). Other accounts from the days of Paul's ministry show the practice of gathering together on the Sabbath day. For example, Luke records this about Paul's visit to Philippi: "And on the Sabbath day we went out of the city to the riverside, where prayer was customarily made; and we sat down and spoke to the women we met there" (Acts 16:13).

God commanded ancient Israel to keep the Sabbath not only by not working, but also by gathering together. This is shown in Leviticus 23:3: "Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; it is the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings."Implicit in the meaning of "convocation" is the gathering together and fellowshipping of God's people on His Sabbaths and holy days. Christian fellowship and holy convocations go hand in hand

C. The significance of fellowship - gathering together

The early Christians clearly emphasized the importance of fellowship. Acts 2:42 notes, "And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers." In the early church, "day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people" (Acts 2:46-47). Fellowship is important for the following reasons:

- 1. Fellowship is for mutual benefit. Hebrews 10:24-25
- 2. Fellowship breeds unity. The more we gather and interact, the more we think alike.
- 3. It helps express love to one another and it encourages good works.
- 4. It fosters strength. There is strength in number. United we stand, divided we fall. Together Everyone Achieves More (TEAM)
- 5. Its impact on unbelievers. Jesus told His disciples, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). The love Christians have for one another can influence others toward faith in Jesus Christ.
- 6. It fosters ability to pray together. Early believers were committed to prayer, both individually and in groups. In James 5:14-16, elders were called together to pray for the sick as well as for those who had sinned. This required being together.
- 7. Easier church decision-making. In both Acts 6 and Acts 15, the early church gathered together to make important decisions about the future direction of the church. These required community, prayer, and close discussion.

- Christian fellowship is required for communion, or the Lord's Supper. The Lord's Supper doesn't quite work the same for an online church. This ancient practice requires time together with other believers to remember and partake in the body and blood of Christ (fellowship of his suffering). We must be communicating.
- Essential for spiritual growth. Many aspects of our spiritual lives depend on being together with other believers to encourage, teach, serve, and share life together (Galatians 6:1; Ecclesiastes 4:9-12; Proverbs 27:17)
- 10. Fellowship is the indispensable means of accomplishing the God-given purpose of the church (Ephesians 4:7-11)
- 11. Fellowship helps to perpetuate the **Christian Culture**. The Church has a culture. It is about who we are, the way we are and how we do our things. Jesus is the progenitor and perfecter of our faith. (Hebrews 12:2). Ideally, our behavior should not be different. Our identity shouldn't be conflicting. Our dressings should agree. Virtues, holiness, generosity, forgiveness, kindness, love, joy, peace and the rest mark our our lifestyle.

D. Holding fast without wavering

The world is changing but let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful (Hebrews 10:23). From Ephesians 4:11-14, there are three threats we must watch out for;

- 1. Wind of doctrine
- 2. Trickery of men
- 3. The cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting

E. Conclusion

Like never before, this is the time to strengthen Fellowship. United we stand, divided we fall. Any change that is alien to the Gospel must be rejected with all sense of responsibility as custodians of the Faith. Positive changes that help to advance the course of the Gospel should be embraced. Be at meetings. The Brethren are encouraged when you come around. Make efforts to reach people you have not seen in Church for a long time. We cannot let it go with sheer indifference. God depends on us to keep the bond. Remember Jesus went after one sheep that left the fold. This is the call TODAY. May we be blessed as we heed in Jesus Name. Amen. Shallom.
