  You become an exception to the prevailing evil and negative trends Ruth 2:9.
- 5. Whatever the prevailing economic weather, things do not wither for you when you are in the right location.
- 6. You see the reward for your labour. No labouring in vain Ruth 2:11.
- 7. You enjoy but a full reward and not a partial one Ruth 2:12.
- 8. You are comfortable Ruth 2:13.
- 9. You have more than enough Ruth 2:14.
- 10. You are above reproach Ruth 2:15.
- 11. You are blessed by the Lord and men.
- 12. You become a channel of blessing to others Ruth 2:18.

# **CONCLUSION**

Ruth had all of these testimonies in one outing, all because God was with her and she believed in the true God of Israel. God actually set aside the long standing covenant which was against the lineage of Ruth a Moabite as contained in Deut. 23:3 to favour her exceedingly.

The law of place does not apply only to labour, it is an all round life related issue. What we have of Ruth is equally not exhaustive in relation to what God is able and ever willing to do for all those who live the decision to him as far as the law of places is concerned.

Isaac stayed in Gerar and was blessed unto the point of envy by his enemy in a land and year where and when famine lasted – Gen. 26:12-14.

# THE LAW OF PLACE AND THE LABOURS OF OUR HANDS: A CASE STUDY OF RUTH

It is a statement of fact that quite a number of people are in the wrong profession today, the attendant effect is the fact that they have nothing to show for their seemingly long years of hard labour.

In the same vein, it is certain that location to a large extent is a major prerequisite to allocation as far as divine matters are concerned.

The story of Naomi, Elimelech and Ruth is instructive as we briefly address the law of place in relation to our labours and the expected and ideal blessings.

Naomi and Elimelech left Bethlehem Judah on account of famine and went to Moab. For ten years they had nothing to show for it. Counting her loss in human and material forms, she departed bitter and empty handed. Parodoxically however the unfortunate young widow Ruth who insisted on serving the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob left in faith with her bitter mother in law. Just one outing in Bethlehem Judah and in one day she returned with far more than the mother in law could boast of in ten years.

What was the difference? The law of place. The ordained place of prosperity. Many are in Lagos or outside Nigeria today for greener pastures. It would however only favour those whom God has ordained Lagos for as their place of divine encounter for favour. This explains the validity of the statement that our help comes from ABOVE and not necessarily from ABROAD.

There are today the following in Lagos:

- 1. Those who come before their time.
- 2. Those who have stayed longer than their time in Lagos
- 3. Those who are outrightly not expected to be in Lagos
- 4. Those ordained to be in Lagos

# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 16<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2018

THEME: THE FORERUNNER

READINGS: ISAIAH 40:1-11; PSALM 146:5-10; I CORINTHIANS 4:1-5; JOHN 1:19-28.

The theme for our meditation this week is "The Forerunner"

"John replied in the words of the prophet Isaiah: "I am a voice shouting in the wilderness, 'Clear the way for the Lord's coming!" (John 1: 23)

John the Baptist had the privilege to be appointed and sent to the world by God ahead of Jesus to be a fore runner. As a fore runner it was his duty to prepare the way for the first coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Prophet Isaiah in Isa. 40: 3-4, gave a good analogy to drive home the point explaining the ministry of the fore runner. In the Ancient Near East roads were usually poorly maintained, they were bumpy and very rough, for this reason therefore whenever the king planned to take a trip he would send someone ahead to ensure that the roads were adequately prepared for his arrival. This of course demands that the roads along which the king will travel is properly leveled and made smooth to allow the king a pleasant journey. From this analogy it is clear that the responsibility of the fore runner includes clearing out of the way all obstacles that will hinder the smooth passage of the King (i.e Jesus Christ). The fore runner therefore is a messenger sent ahead of the King to proclaim to the people the imminent arrival of the King and to prepare them spiritually for His coming.

John the Baptist performed his task as the fore runner to Jesus by doing two things:

He Preached Repentance to the people – In an attempt to get the people ready for the coming of the Lord John the Baptist went about preaching repentance from dead works as a basis for the people to receive forgiveness of sins. His message to the people was not sugar coated, he boldly declared to all what they needed to do. Hear him:

"You brood of snakes! Who warned you to flee God's coming wrath? Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God. Don't just say to each other, 'We're safe, for we are descendants of Abraham.' That means nothing, for I tell you, God can create children of Abraham from these very stones. Even now the ax of God's judgment is poised, ready to sever the roots of the trees. Yes, every tree that does not produce good fruit will be chopped down and thrown into the fire." (Luke 3: 7-9)

This most certainly would have been an offensive message! But it was a message that the people needed to hear. The Lord, Jesus Himself, was on his way and the people needed to get ready. They thought that because they were the descendants of Abraham they deserved the favor of God, but because of their sin this just was not true. They needed to repent. They needed to realize how wrong they were and be sorry for their sins. They also need to turn away from their sins and change their lives. This is what repentance is. It is turning away from sin and turning to God.

He baptized the people as evidence of repentance and forgiveness of sins. This would have been a very unique ministry during John's day because the Jews at this time did not practice baptism like we do today. The only baptism that the Jews practiced was proselyte baptism. In other words, if a Gentile wanted to practice the Jewish religion they had to undergo this type of baptism as a sign of cleansing. This, along with several other steps, was the only way that a Gentile could participate in Jewish worship. It is therefore very courageous that John was telling the Jews that they needed to be baptized like a Gentile.

As we prepare for the second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ believers of today are the forerunners of today saddled with the responsibility of getting men and women of this generation ready for the second coming of the Lord.

Like John the Baptist our major responsibility is to proclaim the good news of salvation to all who are still leaving outside Christ both within and outside the church. We cannot take it for granted that all those who are in the church are true Christians, truth of the matter is that there are some in the church, who may even occupy positions in the church but are enemies of the cross, attempts must be made by all who genuinely know the Lord to reach such people with the message of salvation in order to get them ready for the coming of the Lord.

Finally be mindful of the warning in I Cor. 10: 12 "Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall"

Never take your salvation for granted, strive to be a faithful manager of this charge that God has committed into your hands, understand that the Eternal Judge when He returns will judge all and expose everything done in secret (I Cor. 4: 2, 5)

I pray for you that when tried you will come forth as gold in Jesus name. Have a great week.
