What was the difference? The law of place. The ordained place of prosperity. Many are in Lagos or outside Nigeria today for greener pastures. It would however only favour those whom God has ordained Lagos for as their place of divine encounter for favour. This explains the validity of the statement that our help comes from ABOVE and not necessarily from ABROAD.

There are today the following in Lagos:

- 1. Those who come before their time.
- 2. Those who have stayed longer than their time in Lagos
- 3. Those who are outrightly not expected to be in Lagos
- 4. Those ordained to be in Lagos

Each individual must take time off to settle this with God. It is a lifetime and a worthwhile endeavour to avoid years of wasted labour.

The pertinent question then is **HOW DO I KNOW MY PLACE OF BLESSING?**

Using Ruth as a case study, the following are the tell tale signs among many others.

- 1. Grace will abound i.e. God will be evident in the race Ruth 2:2.
- 2. You will be noticed, you will stand out in your place and your God ordained profession Ruth 2:5.
- 3. You will enjoy FAVOUR. What others labour to get sweating, you are bound to get easily Ruth 2:8.
- 4. You enjoy divine protection.
 - You are untouchable, meaning what is adversely affecting other people's business shall not befall you.
 - You become an exception to the prevailing evil and negative trends Ruth 2:9.
- 5. Whatever the prevailing economic weather, things do not wither for you when you are in the right location.
- 6. You see the reward for your labour. No labouring in vain Ruth 2:11.
- 7. You enjoy but a full reward and not a partial one Ruth 2:12.
- 8. You are comfortable Ruth 2:13.
- 9. You have more than enough Ruth 2:14.
- 10. You are above reproach Ruth 2:15.
- 11. You are blessed by the Lord and men.
- 12. You become a channel of blessing to others Ruth 2:18.

CONCLUSION

Ruth had all of this testimonies in one outing, all because God was with her and she believed in the true God of Israel. God actually set aside the long standing covenant which was against the lineage of Ruth a Moabite as contained in Deut. 23:3 to favour her exceedingly.

The law of place does not apply only to labour, it is an all round life related issue. What we have of Ruth is equally not exhaustive in relation to what God is able and ever willing to do for all those who live the decision to him as far as the law of places is concerned.

THE LAW OF PLACE AND THE LABOURS OF OUR HAND: A CASE STUDY OF RUTH

It is a statement of fact that quite a number of people are in the wrong profession today, the attendant effect is the fact that they have nothing to show for their seemingly long years of hard labour.

In the same vein, it is certain that location to a large extent is a major prerequisite to allocation as far as divine matters are concerned.

Furthermore, life is guided by laws, rules, and principles. One of such is the LAW OF PLACE. As we mark our annual professional harvest today trusting God to bless and prosper the work of our hands to the end that we might live an enviable and not a pitiable life, we need to ponder and ascertain of we are in the place ordained by God for our blessing.

The story of Naomi, Elimelech and Ruth is instructive as we briefly address the law of place in relation to our labours and the expected and ideal blessings.

Naomi and Elimelech left Bethlehem Judah on account of famine and went to Moab. For ten years they had nothing to show for it. Counting her loss in human and material forms, she departed bitter and empty handed. Parodoxically however the unfortunate young widow Ruth who insisted on serving the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob left in faith with her bitter mother in law. Just one outing in Bethlehem Judah and in one day she returned with far more than the mother in law could boast of in ten years.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 25TH NOVEMBER, 2018 THEME: THE COMING OF THE LORD

THEME: THE COMING OF THE LORD READINGS: AMOS 5:18-24; PSALM 146; HEBREW 9:24-28; JOHN 10:7-18.

Texts: Amos 5: 18-20 & Hebrews 9:26 & 28

"Alas for you who desire the day of the Lord! Why do you want the day of the Lord? It is darkness, not light; as if someone fled from a lion, and was met by a bear; or went into the house and rested a hand against the wall, and was bitten by a snake. Is not the day of the Lord darkness, not light, and gloom with no brightness in it?" (Amos 5: 18-20 NRSV).

".... for then he would have had to suffer again and again since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of the age to remove sin by the sacrifice of himself.... so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin, but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him. (Hebrews 9:26 & 28 NRSV).

Introduction: 'The Day of the Lord' is a phrase that has been in usage from the Old Testament times by the Israelites. The expression of Prophet Amos (about the Day of the Lord) to Israelites became the earliest recorded use of the expression in the Scriptures. It would occur many more times in the Old Testament prophets and in the New Testament but clearly it was already by this time a well-known religious figure of speech. The phrase is very relevant in our contemporary days. The Day of the Lord shall appear! The theme specified that the Day is still coming and being either expected/awaited or not reckoned with by people! However, our indifference or expectation can neither fast-track its coming nor delay it. As we prepare for the Advent Season which will usher us into expecting the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus, the Theme becomes very relevant and instructive. As Anglican faithful, Are we preparing for the coming Day of the Lord?

Background: Prophet Amos declared God's messages to the Northern Kingdom of Israel and his purpose was to pronounce God's imminent judgment upon Samaria, Bethel and environs for their complacency, idolatry/syncretism and oppression of the poor! Their worship has blind folded them to the extent that they no longer fear the Lord! The Israelites were thinking that the day of the Lord would bring happiness and triumph to them. They were calling for the day, thinking that it would bring an end to all their troubles; when in fact, it will bring disaster. Israel had this view due to her intimate relationship with the Lord as a separated Nation for the Lord. However, Israel as a Nation dwelt in sins and the hope of the Day of the Lord became her mistake for which she would soon pay dearly. The people of Samaria expected the phrase to mean one thing; but Amos argued that it meant something very different it means DAY OF DESTRUCTION from the hands of the Assyrians! If the Day of the Lord was imminent then because of those sins mentioned above which were committed by Israelites and outlined by Amos, then the LORD'S DAY is fast approaching in our own time now!

As members of AVMCC; after professing our loyalty to the Lord at the Sanctuary, don't we dishonour Him by living in open disregard of his commandments just as Israelites did Thousands of years ago? Don't we leave the place of worship to treat others unjustly, to oppress the poor for the sake of financial gain; to bribe and so on? The Lord requires godliness; faith and obedience first; before He requires worship. Worship without godliness was and is still an offense to Him! The Lord spoke through Amos that He wouldn't accept Israel's sacrifices and praises and that it brought Him no pleasure. How are we sure that He accepts our own Sacrifice of Praise today. The truth is that: God is not impressed with religious activities per se, even if such conform outwardly to biblical instructions. God wants the heart, the faith, the love, and the obedience of anyone who is a genuine believer. Just as Israelites were content with their profession of faith and unconcerned that their lives lacked the evidence to make that profession of faith credible; so we are!!! Just as Israelites prospered and refused to believe that God was angry with them even after Amos' prophesy, so we are!!! Meaning of the Day of the Lord to us in this Age

A. It is a day, a specific time, when the Lord himself intervenes in human affairs. It is the Lord's personal intervention that makes this coming day so powerful and so definitive in its outcome. (Isaiah 34:8; 13:13; Ezekiel 33:33; Jer. 27:22).

- **B.** The Day of the Lord is a day of judgment. Judgment and the punishment of sin is a constant feature of the Day of the Lord prophecies. Synonyms for the phrase "day of the Lord" include: "day of doom" (Ezek. 7:7), "day of reckoning, when disaster comes from afar" (Isa. 10:3), "day of vengeance" (Isa. 63:4), and so on. God will judge every wickedness and unrighteousness.
- C. The Day of the Lord brings deliverance and salvation for God's true and faithful people. Take the famous: "Day of the Lord" passage in Joel 2 and 3, from which Peter quotes in his Pentecost sermon that promises a pouring out of the Spirit. Everywhere in the texts that speak of the Day of the Lord, we find this double expectation: punishment for the wicked and deliverance for the faithful people of God. Which one do you think that you sincerely and actually merit, Punishment or Deliverance? THE DAY IS COMING NEARER THAN BEFORE!
- **D.** The Day of the Lord in the New Testament is used exclusively for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ. We find the term in a variety of forms: the day of the Lord (1 Thess. 5:2), the Day of the Lord Jesus (2 Cor. 5:5), the day of the Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 1:8); the Day of Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:6); the day of Christ (Phil. 2:16), and that day (2 Thess. 1:10). This is the ultimate, final, cosmic day of the Lord.
- E. The Day of the Lord can be temporary and later, final. This becomes possible when we consider Amos and other prophets' proclamation where Amos first spoke of his expectation of National and local visitations/interventions of the Lord. In Israel, this biblical pattern of temporal days of the Lord anticipated the ultimate, cosmic day of the Lord. The Day of the Lord in the time of Amos was pointing to other times of judgment in distant time. For example, Amos' prediction came to pass in Israel's destruction at the hand of Assyria in 721 B.C., destruction he refers to as "the day of the Lord". In other words, the prophets saw the temporal days of the Lord, his days of judgment in their own lifetimes or shortly thereafter, as a preparation of the final day of the divine wrath. The former is more local and national (specific days of the Lord) and the latter, once for all, Day of the Lord. So, cases of Tsunami, Monsoon wind, National disasters, devastations are foretaste of the second coming of Christ. They are temporary/specific days of the Lord that precede the final 'Day of the Lord'. For the enemies of God, the second coming of Christ will be like that, only worse and carrying with it a terrible finality.

Conclusion: Just as Amos warned Israel, we are warning. I hope we are not used to our way of thinking and of our disinterest in what God's Word says and requires? I hope that this short exhortation would not fall on the same deaf ears and create the same amusement as it did when Amos preached it? My passion is to help you reckon and reconcile with the Almighty God to be prepared for the coming day of the Lord and to carry the reality of that future day back into our daily present. We must believe the day of the Lord! That is why there have been and are still so many days of the Lord in human history and without them we would forget altogether the final Day of the Lord and we may lose touch altogether with the meaning of life.

If our religion does not get us through to God, then it is worthless. If our worship does not connect us with the living God as he is and always; then such religion is useless because it creates a false impression of God and of our relationship to God. Amos didn't preach the day of the Lord to take his revenge on an unresponsive audience. He preached the day of the Lord in hope that some in Israel would lift their eyes to see the true and living God, would trust Him, love Him, and serve Him. WE CAN NEVER TRULY LOVE AND SERVE A GOD THAT WE DO NOT FEAR. The true and living God is a God to be feared and it is precisely for that reason that he is a God to be loved. In the Epistle for today, the good news for faithful believers is that: Jesus Christ will appear at the end of the Age to remove the power of sin and to SAVE those who are EARGERLY waiting for Him.
