5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH JANUARY, 2019 THEME: RESPONDING TO GOD'S CALL READINGS: I SAMUEL 3:1-10; PSALM 19; 1 CORINTHIANS 6:11B-20; JOHN 2:1-11.

God formed us all and before He formed us He knew us and His purpose for us (Jer.1:5) and within that plan, He continually seek for us to respond to His call, hence God's continual call for those He desires- (Rm.8:30), those that will faithfully, patiently and hopefully take up the cross without counting the cost. God's call is to bring us back to His own specific purpose and grace (2Tim.1:9) for us at whatever age and station we could be in life.

In the Old Testament, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Joshua, Samuel, David, Jonah and other prophets did not only respond to God's call but faithfully submitted to Him and His will in the face of death, they sacrificed and gave all for God's call. They were convinced that God who called them and gave them all deserved all from them.

The apostles in the New Testament recognized the cost and understood the hope of their calling in line with the disposition of Jesus Christ, who responded to His heavenly Father's call in total submission and obedience during His earthly ministry, even onto death on the cross.

To us Christian, it is a rare privilege to be desired and called by God into a new relationship (1Pt.2:9) that changes and enriches life in the present and leads to eternity.

Today as of old (Heb.13:8) God still calls every person He desires (Mk.3:13; Jhn.6:44, 65) and His call demands not just recognition and response (1Sam.3:7-10; Is.6:8) but:

- 9. Sacrifice- Rm.12:1
- 10. Faithfulness- 1Cor.4:2; Rev.2:10
- 11. Dependence on God-Jhn.15:5; Phil.4:13
- 12. Accept responsibility laid by God's call- Mk.16:15; 1Cor.9:16
- 13. Show forth love- Jhn.13:34,35
- 14. Praise and worship God and fellowship with believers- Is.43:21; 1Cor.1:9; Heb.10:25
- 15. Forsaking and leaving all for God's call- Gen.12:1,4; Lk.5:10,11

We that are called are empowered to do exploits on the field of His kingdom and we must know that the call is not just feelings or religious experience but a call to truth that sets free (Jhn.8:32), and true to the call, we must maintain right attitude and an understanding of the importance of the call- to produce spiritual and godly fruit (Jhn.15:16). Therefore, we must allow God to run our affairs while we are being led by God's Holy Spirit.

As God's call through His word and as His call rings in our mind and conscience every day, let us like our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, men and apostles of old (Heb.3:5,6), respond and be obedient and remain submissive to God, faithful to the call of God and remain in relationship with God.
