Waiting for the next salary before one can survive is an indication that all is not well financially. Giving is a way to breaking the backbone of Poverty in this regard.

First fruit is an advanced level in Christian giving. God loves a cheerful giver not a FEARFUL giver. Be encouraged therefore to TEST the Lord with your first fruit, this is scriptural and Godly – Mal. 3.10. You are also permitted to TASTE the Lord in matters like this – Ps. 34:8. This is not a scheme to enrich the church but a teaching to enlarge your coast financially and in all human endeavours to God's glory. It is an uncommon offering which attracts uncommon blessings. Like many other offerings as well, with faith it can terminate sufferings.

BIBLE TEACHING OUTLINE FIRST FRUIT

Lev. 23:10-11, Gal. 6:16, Ex. 34:26.

1. INTRODUCTION

The place of divine revelation knowledge under the auspices of the Holy Spirit in this end time dispensation can never be over emphasised.

Quite a number of issue or Bible based doctrines which were hitherto unknown to us are coming into limelight – Dan. 12:4. Such doctrines as the use of anointing oil, the possibility of prosperity for the righteous divine healing etc.

It is a matter of fact that about three or four decades ago, the offering of TITHE was completely alien to the Anglican Communion, at least in this part of the world. It was indeed treated like a sacrilege or an abomination. Today however testimonies abound as touching the unprecedented blessings which tithing alongside other forms of Christian giving have brought into the adherents of such Bible based doctrine and practice.

2. FIRST FRUIT

First fruit is unarguably another aspect of Christian giving which is coming into limelight by revelation knowledge with attendant testimonies –Eph. 1:15-19. While thanking God therefore for past efforts in same regard in recent time, it would amount to a pastoral disservice; if

- (1) We are not reminded about first fruit -2 Peter 3:1
- (2) We are not sensitized about first fruit
- (3) We are not encouraged about first fruit

These are the aims of this teaching.

- (4) Since most of us all of us are not farmers today, put in perspective we have the labours of our hands which we constantly seek the blessing of God on.

SUNDAY, 10TH FEBRUARY, 2019

THEME: GOD'S WRATH AGAINST UNRIGHTEOUSNESS

READINGS: II SAMUEL 12:1-10; PSALM 69:9-20; ROMANS 1:18-26; JOHN 2:13-22.

What is God's wrath?

It is the natural and necessary expression of God's holiness against sin, the perfect response of His perfect Being to wickedness. Because He is infinitely holy He cannot love what is good without hating what is evil and moving against it. And when He makes His move, the Bible views that response as His *wrath*. God's wrath simply indicates that He is against sin and cannot tolerate it. It is therefore God's steady, unrelenting, unremitting, uncompromising antagonism to evil in all its forms and manifestations

In Romans 1:18-20, Paul says-

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities — his eternal power and divine nature — have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse. Rom 1:18-20 NIV

Looking at the above passage, there are two objects of God's wrath: --"all ungodliness and unrighteousness". What are they?

Ungodliness refers to wrong attitudes about God—-ignoring Him, disregarding Him, living as though He doesn't exist. We call it "secularism."

Unrighteousness refers to wrong actions against God and others. Wrong attitudes about God inevitably lead to wrong actions—--sinful actions. And all sin is an attack on the truth about God. It suppresses the truth. That's what it says there: "Who suppress the truth in"—or by—"their unrighteousness."

As peace is a truth widely loved, wrath is a truth widely loathed. Many in the history of the church have been embarrassed by God's wrath and have wanted to revise this biblical truth.

Yet, this theme of the wrath (or anger) of God toward sin and sinners is clearly and widely taught in the Bible. This truth is so interwoven with the hope of our peace with one another and with God that if we lose our grasp on the one, we lose our hope of the other.

Six Things we Need to Know About God's Wrath

1. The anger of God is not like our anger.

When we speak about the wrath of God, remember that it is the wrath of God. So everything we know about God—he is just, he is love, and he is good—needs to be poured into our understanding of his wrath.

The words "anger" and "wrath" make us think about our experience. You may have suffered because of someone who is habitually angry, loses his temper, or flies into a rage. Our anger can often be unpredictable, petty, and disproportionate. Although these things are often true of human anger, none of them are true of the anger of God. God's wrath is the just and measured response of his holiness toward evil.

2. God's wrath is provoked.

The anger of God is not something that resides in Him by nature; it is a response to evil. It is provoked.

The Bible says, "God is love." That is his nature. God's love is not provoked. He does not love us because He sees some wisdom, beauty, or goodness in us. He loves you because He loves you, and you can never get beyond that (Deuteronomy 7:7).

But God's wrath is different, it is His holy response to the intrusion of evil into his world. If there was no sin in the world, there would be no wrath in God. So the Bible's teaching about the wrath of God is different from ancient mythologies, gods who run around frustrated and fuming. God's anger is His settled resolve that evil will not stand.

3. God is slow to anger.

Why does God allow evil to continue in the world? Why does he not wipe it out?

God holds out the offer of grace and forgiveness in Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:9). People are coming to Him in faith and repentance every day, and God patiently holds open the door of grace. The day of God's wrath will come, but God is not in a hurry to bring it because then the door of grace will be closed.

4. God's wrath is revealed now.

How does God reveal his wrath when sinners suppress the truth about him, exchange the truth for a lie, and worship created things rather than the Creator? God gives them up (Romans 1):

- Therefore, God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts to impurity (1:24).
- For this reason God gave them up to dishonourable passions (1:26).
- God gave them up to a debased mind (1:28).

One writer states, "Paul is not teaching that one day God will punish Roman civilization for its vice and decadence. On the contrary, the vice and decadence are themselves God's punishment...Their punishment was their greed, envy, strife, deceit, violence and faithlessness." When we see the moral fabric of our culture being torn, then as Christian believers we should cry to God for mercy.

5. God's wrath is stored up.

The whole Bible story leads to a day when God will deal with all evil fully, finally, and forever. This will be the day of wrath, when God will recompense every evil and bring to judgment every sin.

God will do this in perfect justice. The punishment for every sin will match the crime. When the judgment is done, every mouth will be stopped because everyone will know that God has judged in righteousness and justice. Then God will usher in a new heaven and a new earth, which will be the home of righteousness. Rev 21.

6. God's wrath is on sinners.

In John 3:36, Jesus does not say, "The wrath of God will come on [the disobedient]." He says, "Whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him." It is already there. Why is it already there? By nature, we are children of wrath (Ephesians 2:3). It is the state in which we were born.

Points to note.

- 2. Sins attract God's wrath
- 3. The wrath of God is fulfilled in Jesus, thus, accepting Jesus is escaping God's wrath.
- 4. God desires that all be saved but He does not force anyone into salvation
- 5. Accepting Jesus as Lord is the only way to salvation.

- 3. Walk in obedience- James 1:23-25;
