CONCLUSION

First fruit is an advanced level in Christian giving. God loves a cheerful giver not a FEARFUL giver. Be encouraged therefore to TEST the Lord with your first fruit, this is scriptural and Godly – Mal. 3.10. You are also permitted to TASTE the Lord in matters like this – Ps. 34:8. This is not a scheme to enrich the church but a teaching to enlarge your coast financially and in all human endeavours to God's glory. It is an uncommon offering which attracts uncommon blessings. Like many other offerings as well, with faith it can terminate sufferings.

BIBLE TEACHING OUTLINE FIRST FRUIT

Lev. 23:10-11, Gal. 6:16, Ex. 34:26.

1. INTRODUCTION

The place of divine revelation knowledge under the auspices of the Holy Spirit in this end time dispensation can never be over emphasised.

Ouite a number of issue or Bible based doctrines which were hitherto unknown to us are coming into limelight - Dan. 12:4. Such doctrines as the use of anointing oil, the possibility of prosperity for the righteous divine healing etc.

It is a matter of fact that about three or four decades ago, the offering of TITHE was completely alien to the Anglican Communion, at least in this part of the world. It was indeed treated like a sacrilege or an abomination. Today however testimonies abound as touching the unprecedented blessings which tithing alongside other forms of Christian giving have brought into the adherents of such Bible based doctrine and practice.

FIRST FRUIT

First fruit is unarguably another aspect of Christian giving which is coming into limelight by revelation knowledge with attendant testimonies -Eph. 1:15-19. While thanking God therefore for past efforts in same regard in recent time, it would amount to a pastoral disservice; if

- (1) We are not reminded about first fruit 2 Peter 3:1
- (2) We are not sensitized about first fruit
- (3) We are not encouraged about first fruit

These are the aims of this teaching.

FACTS ABOUT FIRST FRUIT (C)

- We are the Israel of God Lev. 23:10-11. We are the (1) spiritual Israel – Gal. 6:16.
- `Entering into a new year or a new experience is (2) spiritually synonymous with entering into the land given to us by God i.e. 2017.
- All references to the first fruit are in connection to (3) farm products or the act of one's labour.
- Since most of us all of us are not farmers today, put in (4) perspective we have the labours of our hands which we constantly seek the blessing of God on.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 17TH FEBRUARY, 2019

FOOLS FOR CHRIST'S SAKE THEME: **READINGS: ISAIAH 30:18-21; PSALM 34:1-13; 1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-13; MATTHEW 5:1-12.** INTRODUCTION

Today is Septuagesima Sunday meaning seventy days before Easter. Septuagesima is the first of the three Sundays that precede Eater; others are Sexagesima and Quinquagesima respectively. By all indications, we are moving very closely to the annual season of Lent. IN this vein, we are looking at the kind of life which Christians are called to live – a life exemplified by Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Those who emulate Him are often regarded as fools according to the standard of men.

Apostle Paul is a typical example of those who are fools for Christ's sake. Had he remained a Jewish rabbi, he could have attained great heights in the Jewish religion (Gal. 1:14). Had he sided with the Jewish legalists in the Jerusalem Church and not ministered to the Gentiles, he could have avoided a great deal of persecution (Acts 15: 21:17ff). For denying himself of all the privileges, he became a fool according to the standards of men. However, the Corinthians were wise in their own eyes, but they were actually fools in the sight of God. depending on the wisdom and the standards of the world, they were acting like fools. Therefore, the way to be spiritually wise is to become a fool in the eves of the world (1 Cor. 3:18).

CHARACTERISTICS OF THOSE WHO ARE WISE IN THEIR OWN EYES BUT FOOLISH IN THE SIGHT OF GOD

- 1. They deny the existence of God (Ps. 14:1).
- 2. They believe they can live apart from God (Rom. 3:23; 10:9-11).
- 3. Their foolish behaviours has no lasting value (Prov. 9:1ff; Lk. 12:15-21).
- 4. They reject the Gospel, and Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 2:6-16)
- 5. They trust in their wealth and political power (Ps. 20:7-8)

WHY BELIEVERS ARE FOOLS FOR CHRIST'S SAKE

Paul draws a contrast between the Christians in Corinth and the apostles, suggesting that the life of a true believer is in contrast to the standards of the world, as often said that we are in the world but not of the world.

Apparently, there was problem at Corinth on account of those who prized the sophisticated rhetoric and displays of philosophical prowess that marked and characterized the orators of the day, who were trying to hybridize the wisdom of the world and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Every believer must be ready to be a fool in the eyes of men. To be a fool is to appear gullible to the things of this world so as to be wise to those things that have eternal value.

The Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1ff) contains a list of Divine blessings that await those who are fools in the eyes of the world. These are people who do not live according to the standard of the world but have heaven in focus.

As a result of this, we are ready to endure sufferings; bless even when cursed. We are not mindful of the way we are being treated and persecuted. By world standards, we should retaliate; but in the eyes of God, "the weapons of our warfare are not canal". We can endure every form of persecution, because the grace of God is always sufficient. So, in all things, we seek to respond in love. Therefore, like Paul and other Apostles were vindicated so also we will be vindicated and brought to the glory of God, as it is written: "The eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry (Ps. 34:15) cc (Isa. 30:18-21).

Conclusion

Those who believe in the Resurrection and put their faith in the Christ will know all they need to know to be saved.

However, this knowledge cannot be grasped by even the wisest people in the world unless they accept the message of God through Christ. Truly,

the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing.
