Just because we fast or pray, we cannot obligate God and make Him our servant.

We should never engage in fasting as a means of obtaining direct blessing; the value of fasting is indirect and not direct.

Why, then, should a Christian fast? Because he feels impelled to do so for some spiritual reason or reasons.

Fasting should never be routine or mechanical; it should be prompted by the Holy Spirit and engaged in at His command for the duration that He dictates.

IV. RIGHT FASTING (Isa. 58:6-9)

Correct fasting would demonstrate itself in a life of practical daily holiness:

- 1. To loose the bands of wickedness verse 6.
- 2. To undo the heavy burdens verse 6.
- 3. To let the oppressed go free verse 6.
- 4. To break every yoke verse 6.
- 5. To give bread to the hungry verse 7.
- 6. To restore the poor, from thy house verse 7.
- 7. To clothe the naked verse 7.
- 8. To reveal yourself to your relatives verse 7.

These eight things could be summarised in the words of James 1:27.

V. <u>JESUS AND FASTING</u>

- He was not legalistic with regard to fasts but likely kept the main Jewish fast.
- 2. He fasted forty days and forty nights just prior to the great temptations Matt.4:2.
- 3. He warned against the abuse of fasting -Matt. 6:16.
- He taught that His disciples would fast after His departure -Mark 2:20.
- 5. He gave some instructions regarding proper fasting Matt.6:17,18.
- 6. He associated prayer with fasting Mark 9:29.
- 7. He said that certain demons could only be cast out by prayer and fasting Matt. 17:21.

VI. FASTING IN THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH

- 1. The Apostle Paul fasted (II Cor.6:5; II Cor.11:27).
- The Church fasted before prayer in Acts 13:3, before separating Paul and Barnabas for the ministry as missionaries in the regions beyond.
- 3. The Church fasted before appointing elders in Acts 14:23.
- 4. In Acts 10:30, Cornelius fasted for four days.
- 5. In 1Cor. 7:5, fasting seems to include not only abstinence from food but from legitimate, normal love relations between husbands and wives by mutual consent.

VII. VALUE OF FASTING TODAY

Speaking from the medical or physical point of view, it is excellent for the body; most of us eat far too much, and to rest the digestive system periodically is good.

People who are overweight or obese would be well advised to fast in order to reduce weight. One American doctor has written, "After you feast, you should fast."

Students who face strenuous examinations find it highly desirable to fast in order to increase the blood in the brain area; it gives more clarity of thought.

Some who fast for extended periods say that the first three or four days are the hardest; but after that the mind becomes unusually clear.

Christians seeking the will of God could profitably spend time in prayer and fasting; with the mind clearer they would be able to think more logically and evaluate the various circumstances and interacting factors.

Furthermore, fasting demonstrates to the Lord the depth of our sincerity; that we are willing to be importunate (Luke 11:18), knocking ceaselessly till light comes.

Praying Hyde of India is a classic example of prayer and fasting; he would leave his bed and the food untouched simply because, unconsciously, he was so engrossed in intercession that he just forgot to eat and sleep.

Matthew 6:17,18 (the Sermon on the Mount by the Lord Jesus Himself) infers that we are to fast secretly, surreptitiously, without any tell-tale facial signs.

The basic meaning of fasting is abstinence from food for spiritual purpose. There is a distinction between fasting and discipline;

FASTING

At many Christian conferences, from time to time questions like this appear: "Should we spend more time fasting?" "Is fasting the forgotten grace in the New Testament Church?" "Do you fast? How often? Why?". This lesson is an attempt to answer some of these basic questions. Fasting is not found in the Pentateuch but often in the historical books. Probably the first recorded fast is in Judges 20:26, about 1400 B.C. Because Roman Catholics and Mohammedans fast frequently, Protestants have gone to the opposite extreme and seldom or never fast.

In passages like Lev. 16:29-31, Lev. 3:27-32, we read of "afflicting the soul"; and in the light of passages like Psa. 35:13, this is interpreted as fasting: "I humbled my soul with fasting." The book of Nehemiah (7:7,3-9:38) records a general fast.

During the captivity. Israel added four fasts in addition to the one for

During the captivity, Israel added four fasts in addition to the one for the Day of Atonement - Zech 7:3-5; 8:19.

- A fast to commemorate the capture of Jerusalem the 17th day of the 4th month.
- A fast to commemorate the burning of the Temple the 9th day of the 5th month.
- A fast to commemorate the murder of Gedaliah the 10th day of the 7th month.
- A fast to commemorate the siege of Jerusalem the 10th month.

In the New Testament, the Pharisees kept two weekly fasts (Monday and Thursday) - Luke 18:11-12.

The present Jewish calendar permits 22 fasts plus the Day of Atonement.

I. THE OLD TESTAMENT STANDARD OF FASTING

It is characterised by the following six things:

- 1. Strict abstinence from food.
- 2. Humble confession of sins to God.
- Earnest seeking of God's face this often included sackcloth and ashes (Dan.9:3).
- 4. True intercession for themselves and others.
- 5. Giving of alms to the poor.
- 6. Living as one prayed and vowed.

II. OLD TESTAMENT REASONS FOR FASTING

- 1. To express deep mourning 1 Sam.31:13 fasting seven days for Saul.
- 2. To avert Divine wrath II Sam. 12:16-17 fasting to keep the baby alive.
- 3. To express repentance and sorrow for sin Jonah 3:7 the city of Nineveh.

III. THE WRONG KIND OF FASTING

It is possible to take a perfectly good thing and abuse it; to cause it to degenerate to a mere external form without sincere heart meaning. In Isa. 58:3-5, God reveals the sin of the mere form of outward fasting:

- 1. As a display for God to see verse 3.
- 2. Merely afflicting their souls verse 3, abstaining from food.
- 3. For personal pleasure verse 3, something to boast about Luke 18:12.
- 4. To exact full labour (oppress employees to get full daily output of goods verse 3)
- 5. For strife or debate verse 4.
- 6. To smite with a wicked fist verse 4.
- 7. To make God hear their voices verse 4: to obligate God to hear their prayers.
- 8. To bow the head as a bulrush verse 5.
- To sit in sackcloth and ashes verse 5: an outward show of fasting.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 17TH MARCH, 2019

THEME: GOD'S WILL FOR THE LOST READINGS: ISAIAH 53:1-12, PSALM 33:17-21; 1 JOHN 3:1-10; LUKE 15:1-10.

A. Introduction

God's will for the lost is clearly seen from the Gospel we read today. It is fascinating to realize that the thinking of God is filled with love which is what he is. It appears the way God sees the lost is not the way we see them. Otherwise, we'll probably leave everything else and focus on getting them in. Seeking the lost has been described by many preachers as the heartbeat of God. Someone said God spends 80% of his time seeking out the lost and 20% with the found. The humbling truth is every saint was once a sinner. Every saint seated here this morning was a sinner who embraced the Grace of God. So, we can sing amazing Grace, how sweet the sound that saved a wretched like me. I once was lost but now am found; 'was blind but now i see.

B. Reflection

Luke Chapter 15 contains three successive parables on loss. It began with the parable of the lost sheep, vs 1-7; then the parable of the lost coin, vs 8-10 and parable of the lost son, vs 11-32. The sheep, coin and prodigal son are symbolic of a sinner –one who severs relationship with God; the one who for some reasons had missteps and goes missing, either voluntarily or snatched as we know the devil to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10a). The Lost could also be seen as those who have not been found by God –those in the fold but *self-estranged* – those who live in heresy – those who live in disbelief – those who have sold their conscience to the devil – those who are in active partnership with devil and demons – those who have not been born into the Kingdom of God.

For our consideration, emphasis shall be on (i) the pains of loss, (ii) the expedition of the owner and the (iii) the joy of redemption/restoration

i. The Pains of Loss (Luke 15: 4, 8, 32)

....if he loses one of them. In context, the owner here is referring to God and He is not careless. He can't lose us unless we choose to leave. – Unconditional love Rom 8:35

- 1. The lost is in no deeper pain than the owner the one in bigger pain is the owner of the treasure. He is the one who invested owner of 100sheep, 10 silver coins and 2 sons.
- 2. The owner has responsibility of protection Jesus said no man can pluck away his sheep John 10:27-28. God doesn't lose a child except one who chooses to go away. It was painful to God that man chose to disobey him and ate the forbidden fruit. It was painful that one of the sons he nurtured and cared for would choose to be prodigal.
- 3. God is unhappy when a child of His chooses to stray John 17:12; Heb 10:38-39. What happened to the fellowship God shared with Adam and Eve? Gen 3:8
- 4. The Suffering Lover a man of sorrow, a man of grief Isaiah 53: 1-5. How often we bring pains to God when we choose our own ways to His ways? We make poor decisions with dire consequences and place the burden of pain on people who care for us.

ii. The Expedition of the Owner (Luke 15: 4, 8, 20)

....won't he leave the ninety nine in the wilderness and go after that which is lost until he finds it?

....won't she light a candle, sweep the house and seek diligently till she finds it?

....but when he was a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion and ran....

All things being equal, nobody goes after anything useless. Nigerians in particular are too busy.

- 1. Like Treasure Nobody bothers about something they can do away with if they get missing.
- 2. The importance and love God places on a sinner made Jesus came looking for him. Matt 9:10-13; John 3:16.Till tomorrow, God is looking for those who are lost
- 3. The Seriousness of the Search He left 99 in the wilderness to look for just one. Does it matter to us if people drop off church and faith? Does it matter if we don't see some members of our societies again? There was conflict and someone chose out! Do we bother?
- 4. The Hope perhaps he can be saved. Perhaps, I will find the lost coin. Perhaps the prodigal will return home, the father was waiting he saw him from afar. Don't write anyone off.

iii. The Joy of Redemption/Restoration (Luke 15:6-7, 9-10, 22-24)

At recovery, the owner of the sheep called neighbors for rejoicing. Does one sheep found worth throwing a party for? Why kill the fatted cow and throw a party for a wasteful son? The value God places on human life beats our imagination. God can move systems to get a man saved. God can go extra mile to bring a straying son home. There is indeed joy in Heaven over a sinner who turns to God.

C. Implications – God's desire

- 1. God is all out to save sinners the lost. Don't stand in his way. He would move mountains and level valleys to save. How passionate are we about the unsaved and the straying?
- 2. The value God places on man suggests how He treats him Gen 1:26. **Don't treat people anyhow**
- 3. God is mindful of us Psalm 8:4-8. Our thoughts occupy him. His love for us is simply unimaginable. We must have the same attitude. We have to be concerned. We have to channel our resources towards missions and evangelism.
- 4. God would save anyone who turns to him. The prodigal son came to himself v17. He rose from his treachery, abasement and overwhelming sinfulness and repented. He made a true effort at restoration. Isaiah 1:18 God says he would forgive sins that as red as scarlet and crimson. God can forgive. He will if we let go of sins and let him.
- 5. God needs us to go look for the Lost Matthew 9:35-38. The Harvest is plenty. He said we should ask the Lord of harvest to send Labourers into the Harvest. How can we ask if we are one ourselves? Would you be one? Please be one. No matter your age, stage and weight, He is enlisting people every hour the 3rd, 6th, 9th and 11th (Matthew 20:1-16)
- 6. The Lost are waiting for help. Someone is being harassed out there by the devil. He holds him deep down in bondage and mocks him. Sin was sweet and pleasurable initially but he has realized it is the way of destruction. Would you help him?

E. Conclusion:

The will of God for the Lost is that they be saved and this will be our passion and mission. May God help us all in Jesus Name. Those who turn many to righteousness will shine like stars forever and ever (Daniel 12:3b)
