5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 31ST MARCH, 2019 THEME: THE WIFE OF NOBLE CHARACTER READINGS: 1 SAMUEL 25:23-35, PSALM 128; 1 CORINTHIANS 7:1-16; LUKE 1:5-24.

Introduction: Here in Nigeria (from researches done), the typical Congregation draws an adult crowd of 61% female and 39% male. Almost 25 percent of married, churchgoing women do worship without their husbands. Midweek activities often draw 70 to 80 percent female participants. Churches overseas report gender gaps of up to 9 women for every adult man in attendance. Without women, how many men would come to church by themselves? Without women there would be no church! The life in the Christian church cannot continue without women, without their labour, prayers, and love. To all Women, wives, mothers and Ladies, Happy Mothers' Day celebration. Mother's day is traditionally the day when children give something back to their mothers for all they have done, the day wives are rewarded for washing all those sheets in the middle of the night. God made men and women different. If God made you a woman, celebrate that. If you are a wife or a mother, it's worth celebrating. Motherhood and being a Wife is a sure sign that there is a Creator. Ladies, whether or not you are a mother, God has a special place for you in His heart. And He has a job for you because you have an impact on the rest of us. There is the need for women of godly character, whether married or single. We need women who reflect love for God and His creation. There are noble characteristics in women that make them outstanding and magnanimous. We all need to learn from them - whether they are in position of being mother, wife or daughter!

The meaning of the word "Noble" Biblically is translated as: army, man of valour, host, forces, valiant, strength, riches, wealth, power, substance, might, strong. So the wife/mother of noble /virtuous character means a wife that is capable, courageous, commanding or conquering. With her husband the woman has a confident (v 11) or trusting (KJV) relationship. She is very responsible, resourceful, resilient, reliable, respected, tough and trustworthy no matter what, with things, people or herself.

ATTRIBUTES

She has a sound mind: She selects good materials for her work, gets a good value for her money, sets about her work vigorously, sees that her trade is profitable as she makes wise decisions, looks for opportunities, and tries to take advantage of them; watches over the affairs of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness. She shows compassion to her family and others gets up early to provide food for her family and servants; opens her arms to the poor and extends her hands to the needy.

She shows compassion to her family: God has gifted women with an extra measure of compassion. They sense people's needs better than men, generally. *Hope our women measure up to theses sterling characters?*

She emphasizes her relationship with God: She speaks with wisdom, and faithful instruction is on her tongue. This is a direct result of her gaining maturity in her relationship with God. A woman of character speaks with wisdom and faithful instruction based on the Word of God. She is clothed with strength and dignity. She is not easily swayed and can hold her own in most situations. In public, she carries herself well, with the posture that says she is confident in God and in her abilities. A wife of noble character fears the Lord to tell others that she could not do it by herself. Her strength, success and significance are in and from the Lord. Her wisdom is from the Lord, her work is for the Lord and her walk is in the Lord. How is your relationship with God? Do you have time for Him?

She gains respect from her family: Her husband has full confidence in her because he is respected. This brings to mind the old saying that behind every successful man is a good woman. Her children bless her, and her husband praises her. Wives have their husbands or children and family to care of, and this is worthy of honor. She is a living legacy. The younger ones (those below her) call her "blessed." Her children blessed her, her husband praised her but she gave credit to the Lord (her superior). Are you a wife/ woman that is respected by her family?

Being tender and transparent: What set her apart is not her appearance and abilities outside, but the attitude and attractiveness inside. Some of these attributes of inner beauty in the life of a noble wife are: strength, boldness, dignity, goodly, glory, honour, excellent spirit. She is tough and tender; gracious, godly and genuine.

In Conclusion, we are all responsible for our family, and we are to love our wives as Christ loves the Church, giving Himself up for her. We must recognize and even reward women for their involvement, industry, intelligence, influence and individuality. How are you helping your wife to gain respect for herself? I encourage all men again to do all that can be done to help the women/wives in our lives to be women of Godly character. To all men: Have you cherished the ladies in your life – mother, wife or daughter? Have you told them how special they are to you? How they are God's gift to you?

Ladies, are you becoming the woman God intends for you to be? Are you growing in godliness, grace and generosity? Are you an example and an encouragement to others? Let me encourage you ladies, whether or not you are a mother, by paraphrasing a passage of Scripture. 1 Corinthians 15:58. "Therefore, my dear ladies, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain". Whatever your work is, do it in view of the fact that you are working for the Lord. And do it in the confidence that your labor is not for nothing, and that God will honor you for it.
