5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14TH APRIL

THEME: BEYOND MAN'S PRIDE READINGS: ZECHARIAH 9:9-12, PSALM 24; PHIL. 2:5:11; MATTHEW 21:1-13.

Palm Sunday commemorates the day that Jesus Christ entered the city of Jerusalem. It is popularly known as Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. The day is called Palm Sunday, because the crowd spread palm branches in front of Jesus as he rode into the city on a donkey.

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the passion of our Lord, Jesus Christ. It was a week full of activities in which Jesus Christ was moving from one location to another in preparation for his death culminating in glorious Resurrection and Ascension. The week is otherwise known as Holy week or Great week, as the case may be.

The use of palm in ushering Jesus into Jerusalem signifies victory while the shout of Hossana. From liturgical perspective, the colour for Palm Sunday is Red symbolizing the power of Pentecost, and victory through the Blood of Jesus, the Lamb of God. All the Lections for the day, and the collect depict the importance of the great events that took place on the first Palm Sunday.

Jesus did not go to Jerusalem that people might praise him. Rather, he went there to fulfil the mandate of God as part of his assignment during his earthly ministry. Therefore, it was not an error for majority of the crowed not accord him praise, because while men refused to praise him the stones would raise their voice to praise him the Saviour of the world.

The Prophet Zechariah predicted the coming of Jesus into the earth firstly, to defeat his enemies; and secondly, to establish his kingdom. At his first advent, He rode on a humble donkey; but at His second advent, He will ride on a white horse and lead the armies of heaven(Rev.19:11-21)

Jesus' reign will be a reign of peace for He will proclaim peace, speaking with authority and things begin to happen (Ps.33:9). His word will go forth with power and there will be a general disarmament around the world. Chariots of horses of war will be demobilized, every weapon will be destroyed. Nation shall not learn war anymore (Isa.2:4; Mic.4:3).

Christ's attitude is a pattern for every believer. He did not come for the sake himself but for the sake of others. He came not his selfish interest but the interest of others. Moreover, Christ did not consider Himself equal with God. This is the kind of humility that Christians should emulate. God indeed suppresses the proud but gives grace to the humble. Covet the humility of Christ but beware of the pride of Satan. Christ's humility is a rebuke to Satan's pride.

The action of Jesus in the story recorded in St. Matthew's account of the gospel was:

- 1. A fulfilment of the prophecy recorded in Zech.9:9. It shows that Jesus Christ is the only One with credentials that prove Jesus Christ is the King of Israel.
- 2. To make the Jewish leaders to act as they saw the spontaneous demonstration of the people, they concluded that Jesus had to be destroyed (John 12:19). This demonstration of Christ's popularity speedily incited the rulers to act.

The people acclaimed Jesus as their king both by their words and their deeds. They shouted "Hossana" meaning, "Save now" (Ps. 118: 25-26).

In Psalm 24, five times God is called "the king of glory". This, it implies that Jesus, the Chief Shepherd will one day return in glory and give each faithful servant a crown of glory (1Pet. 5:1-4, 7; 4:11-14; 1Cor.2:8).

Jesus Christ is actually the King of Glory. On entering Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the whole city did not receive him and praise him due hatred and envy. Instead, the leaders at Jerusalem rejected their Saviour and sent Him to Golgotha to be crucified.

Therefore, as we celebrate Jesus this Palm Sunday, let us welcome Him into our lives and ask Him to intervene in the affairs of our nation and families.
