THEME: THE BLOOD OF CHRIST

READINGS: JEREMIAH 31:31-34, PSALM 22:23-29; HEBREW 9:11-14; JOHN 12:20-32.

The blood of animals was not sufficient to take away man's sins (**Hebrews 10:4**). For man to be cleansed from the power of sin, the son of man (Jesus Christ) died on the cross. Also, the animal sacrifices were impotent to take away sins; God released His begotten son to atone for man's sins on the cross. His blood was shed for us.

THE PROVISION OF HIS BLOOD

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. Here the redemption of man is attributed to the blood of Christ; and this blood is stated to be shed in a sacrificial way, precisely as the blood of bulls, goats: and calves was shed under the law. This is a divine provision to redeem the souls of men. The blood of Jesus is the greatest provision for man's sins.-**Romans 5:8**
