#### 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

**SUNDAY, 12<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 2019** 

THEME: TRUSTING GOD IN EVERY SITUATION READINGS: 1 KINGS 17:17-24; PSALM 49; 1 CORINTHIANS 15:1-11; JOHN 11:17-27

Introduction: Difficult situations abound in life existence. The two Scriptural texts for our thought this week (The Old Testament Reading and the Gospel) discussed similar scenarios and show and gave us examples of how to keep on trusting God in every situation especially during turbulent ones. It is humanly easy to trust in the Lord when good things happen but it becomes humanly difficult (if not impossible and even foolish according to the reasoning of man) to still maintain ones' trust in God during difficulties.

In the Old Testament Reading, the story of Prophet Elijah and a widow from a Gentile territory called Zarephath happened when God punished Israel with drought and famine for its idolatrous acts under the reign of King Ahab. Zarephath was relying on Israel for food supply and when Israel experienced famine, it was also in calamity. It is this place where God asked Elijah to go after hiding in Cherith for several months. In obedience, Elijah went, found the woman and stayed with her. The widow lost her son and was grieving in pain to the extent that she nearly blasphemed God in Elijah. Elijah however, understood how she felt and that is why he cried out to God because he trusted in Him. God was mindful of the widow's grieving heart as He put the child back to life after Elijah prayed and pleaded to Him. Would a God who does not really care do that? He could have just let the child dead, for He did not even need to prove Himself to the widow or to Elijah. But God still raised the child from the dead!

Today's Gospel relates the interview between Jesus and Martha after her brother Lazarus died. In her character, when Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went out to meet him, while her sister Mary stayed in the house. The sisters and their deceased brother must have been a prominent family, since many of the Jews had come to console them over their loss. As Martha and Jesus talk, Jesus makes a tremendous statement about being the resurrection and the life. Then He asks Martha "Do you believe this?" To Jesus, it was not how Martha felt

that was important, but what she believed. Jesus wanted this grieving woman to come to a higher level of trust in who He is. He knew that faith in God and trust in Him is a major component for us in dealing with our grief and with other major trials. God wants us to face life's overwhelming trials with overcoming faith and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ. After the Lord tells Martha that her brother will rise again, she replies, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." She missed the drift of Jesus' promise to raise Lazarus that very day. Thank God that Jesus still raised Lazarus up from the dead.

- A. From today's texts; we see that God really stands with people in their distress and does not abandon them to death. So, it is clear what we must do: We must trust God in times of uncertainty and distress because He watches over us and He cares for us.
- B. We must continue living our lives trusting on God's provisions. The Gentile widow who was left with a little flour and oil was about to give up on life. She was someone who did not worship God, yet God still knew what she needed, and He sent her help through prophet Elijah. He knew what she needed. He knew that the Jewish sisters needed the life of Lazarus back. God knows what you need too! Just trust Him, He is watching over you and He will provide all your needs.
- C. We MUST continue to trust in God's promises. God shows that He cares for us through His promise of eternal life. The life where there are no more calamities, no more grief, no more sorrows, no more distress. He promised this life to all who will believe in Him and His promise is true. Hold on to all His promises of blessings, healing, protection, provision, help, etc. He cares for you.
- D. We must continue living our lives in prayer, trusting that God hears us. Remember how Elijah cried out to God to bring the child back to life? And How Jesus called forth Lazarus from the dead! It is also a reminder for us that when we feel hurt, we can talk to God and He will listen. He encourages all of us to tell Him whatever we are feeling. He wants us to converse with Him. It is often hard to know how to pray in a trial because we don't know God's sovereign will. It may be His will to heal miraculously or it may be His will to be glorified as we trust Him during and after our loss. But we can and should pray in line with Eph. 3:20.
- E. Trust God during trials when there is no human remedy. The setting for the miracle of Lazarus (John 11:17-20) presents us with an overwhelming situation: Lazarus was dead and had been in the tomb four days. His body was beginning to decompose, as Martha pointed out to the Lord when He ordered that the stone be removed (11:39). There were no human solutions for this situation. The sisters had been on track when they had sent word to Jesus that Lazarus was sick. But when He delayed coming for two days, Lazarus had died. So now things were beyond all human hope. We all know that God is the author and giver of life and that He alone has the power to raise the dead physically.

#### 14. MINISTRIES & FELLOWSHIPS

#### A. Children's Ministry

Parents are requested to send their children to the Sunday School with Bibles, Note Books & Biros. Please instruct your children to remain in the Sunday School and not wander about looking for things to buy. Children are better and safer in the Sunday School. Release your children for learning and safe keep there.

In the Bible and in human history, resurrections from the dead are rare, but Lazarus' version was enacted. Trust God when all hope is lost. He gives hope!

- F. We must trust that God is in control of all our circumstances. Martha and Mary both said to Jesus (11:21, 32), "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." They obviously had faith and trust in Jesus' ability to heal their brother, if only He had been there. But mixed with that faith is some unbelief. But most of us replay in our minds: "If only I had not done what I did, the accident would not have happened!" "If only the timing had been different, the tragedy would not have happened!" If He's the Lord, then He is in control of all our circumstances. Surely, He wasn't asleep or distracted when our tragedy happened! The Bible repeatedly affirms that God is in control of all things, including tragedies (Job 42:2; Ps. 103:19; 115:3; Isa. 46:10; Eph. 1:11; Psalm 135:6). In other words, from relatively minor processes of nature to major, nation-changing events, God is in control. God is in control of all our circumstances, even when we can't make sense out of them. As we have seen, Jesus was in control of Lazarus' death. He deliberately remained two days longer where He was, resulting in Lazarus' death, so that this miracle would display God's and His own glory and so that His followers would grow in their faith (John11:4, 15). So even though we often don't understand the reason for our trials, we can know that the Lord wants us to trust Him and to gain a bigger view of His glory.
- G. We must trust God to be able to personally apply His truth in the present. As we have seen, Martha should be commended for believing God's promises regarding eternity. But Jesus meant for her to apply that promise to the present situation. He wanted her to believe that He could and would raise Lazarus that very day. General faith for the future is easier than specific faith for the present trial. It's easier to believe that someday God will work all our trials together for good than it is to believe that He is presently working on our trial for good.
- H. Our Trust MUST center in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus revealed God's glory both by showing His power in calling Lazarus from the tomb and also by His words to Martha (John 11:25-26): "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" This is the fifth of Jesus' "I am" statements in John. It is clearly a claim to deity; no one other than God in human flesh could say what Jesus says here. He says that He is the resurrection and the life. Those qualities are part and parcel of His being. Jesus means that those who believe in Him will never die spiritually. They receive eternal life from Jesus. This eternal life begins the instant we believe in Jesus and is not interrupted by physical death. Rather, death ushers us into the presence of the Lord, where we will await the resurrection of our bodies when Christ returns. Martha already had believed in Jesus as the Christ, the Son of God (as she goes on to affirm in 11:27). But Jesus challenges her in her time of grief to believe specifically in Him as the resurrection and life (11:26). Trust that overcomes life's trials must have specific doctrinal content about the person and work of Jesus Christ. It's not enough to have a vague, general faith in Christ. You need to know Him as He is revealed in all of God's Word. That kind of faith will sustain you in a time of trial.

Brothers and sisters, there are times when we just do not understand what is happening. Natural calamities and deaths are unavoidable. We may lose a lot of things. And it will always be a hurtful experience. Today, I am not telling you to stop hurting. But I just want to remind all of us here that despite all the distress and uncertainty... take heart, trust God and always remember, God is watching over you and He cares for you more than you could ever imagine. Just trust in Him. Only Trust Him.
