5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 16TH JUNE, 2019

THEME: GOD THE FATHER, SON AND HOLY SPIRIT **PROVERBS 8:22-29; PSALM 29; READINGS: EPHESIANS 1:3-14; JOHN 14:8-17**

Trinity was introduced by Tertullian, one of the early Church fathers, to define the teaching concerning the Godhead which simply means- threefold or three in one and today in Anglican world, we observe Trinity Sunday, a way to remembering and honoring the Holy Trinity, our triune God consisting of three Persons- Father, Son and Holy Spirit- three, and yet one God. Though the word Trinity is not used in the Scriptures, the words three and one are used and a great consideration of these words reveals that the God of the Bible is triune in nature and being.

It is well to note that no human being out of wisdom can define God by word and no finite mind of man can explain the mystery of the Godhead. The Scriptures never attempt to explain the mystery, they simply declare it (Act.17:29; Rm.1:19,20; Col.2:2,9; 1Tim.3:16).

Elohim- The Eternal Godhead

We can only know God through revelation. If God does not reveal Himself to us, it is impossible for us to know God for our self. We can never find out God with all our searching, it is God Himself that can take the initiative-Job 11:7; Mat.11:25-27, and this is in His word- the Bible ("the secret things belong to the Lord our God; but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law-Deut.29:29)

The Scriptures speak of two kinds of unity or onenessabsolute unity and compound unity. This is seen in the use of two Hebrew and two Greek words translated by the word "one". The two words are:

- "Yachead" absolute unity, a mathematical i. or numerical number one. It is used about twelve times (Gen.22:2,12; Judg.11:34; Ps.22:20; Jer.6:26; Zech.12:10, etc) but never used to describe God. The word is significant because Jesus, Son of God, only hope of salvation is the only one way to God (Jhn.14:1,6)
- "Echad" speaks of a compound or collective ii. unity which comprises more than *one* personone people, one nation or crowd (Gen.2:24; Ezr.3:1; 1Chro,12:38). This word of a compound unity concerning the one God is used hundreds of times in the Old Testament.

- iii. The two Greek words which carry the same thought as the two Hebrew word above are "heis" and "mono". Whenever the Scripture speaks that God is one, it is not mathematical or number one God but of a compound unity- the unity of more than one Person, it speaks of plurality of divine person in one God. This unity is a compound unity- "Elohim" a uni-plural word implying plurality of divine persons which is revealed as tri-unity- the union of three in one "The Lord our God is one (echad) Lord" (Deut.6:4); "In that day, there shall be one (Echad) Lord, and His Name one (Echad)." (Zech.14:9)
- iv. The New Testament reveals there are three which are spoken as one- the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit (Mat.3:16,17; 28:19; Jhn.14:6-17, 17:21-23; 1Jhn.5:7,8). The very fact that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are linked together in baptismal command shows that there is coexistence, co-equality, co-eternal of being in nature, power and attributes.

The revelation of the Trinity is a revelation of a living truth. From Genesis to Revelation, whether by type or symbol, pattern or created things, shadows or theophanic revelation or manifestation or clear declaration, Scripture shows that GOD is always revealed as One in Three and Three in One, that is, Godhead.

The True God and eternal life.

Our religion- Christianity is founded upon Trinity, manifestation of the three divine Persons, engaged in the great work of man's redemption begun, continued and ended by the three Persons in their relations of Father- Creator, Son-Redeemer and Holy Spirit- Sanctifier or God the Father who loves us, God the Son our Savior who redeemed us and God the Holy Spirit our Helper who sustains us. Trinity means through Christ, we have access by one Spirit unto the Father with great honor and privilege as sons of God.

The revelation of Trinity shows and confirms-

- i. That in our world of effort and failure, we need the varied help of God.
- ii. That the Eternal Father, of whom we are the children; the Eternal Son, who brings back to us our lost sonship; the Eternal Spirit, by whom we and all things live, are severally close to us.
- iii. That God, in His trinity of Persons is near to us with a trinity of blessing.
- That by the formulated Athanasian Creed in the 5th century, The UNITY IN TRINITY, and the TRINITY IN UNITY is to be worshipped.
- v. That the Eternal Power and Godhead is a trinity (Rm.1:20; Mat.28:19).
