# WHY SAINTS NEED TO BE EQUIPPED OR TRAINED AS A DISCIPLE OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

### It is Biblical- Jesus commanded it

In Matthew 28:18-20, we are commanded to make disciples. Jesus said "go into the world and make disciples". He didn't say "go into the world and make fellowship groups," or "go into the world and make Christian clubs." He said "go into the world and make disciples'.

### Jesus did it- Jesus modeled it.

While Christ ministered for three years to masses of people, He primarily spent his time with twelve men into whom He poured His whole life. He took them everywhere with Him, taught them, trained them, and invested His life into them. Jesus ushered in a spiritual kingdom that has lasted more than two thousand years because he invested his life in twelve men.

**Far-Reaching Benefits** *-Disciples grow when we invest in others.* When a teacher prepares a lesson, he/she grows more than those in the class. When a disciple ministers to someone in need, shares his/her testimony, not only are needs met but the disciple grows in grace and knowledge of GOD.

What will you look like after you are trained?

- Biblical disciples walk by faith
  They are developing their relationships with God by digging into
  the Scriptures, developing a prayer life and consistent quiet times
  with God. Biblical disciples deal with issues of sin and holiness
  in their lives. They have a sensitivity to turn from sin when they
  see it in their lives. They are learning how to worship, and how to
  endure trials. They are developing a walk with the Lord.
- Biblical disciples communicate their faith
  Biblical disciples are developing a heart for what is on God's
  heart, and one of the things on God's heart is people who do not
  know Him. Biblical disciples have a heart for the lost, a growing
  compassion for people who do not know Jesus to know Him.
  They want to know how to relate to non-Christians, share a
  personal testimony in a way that non-Christians can understand;
  and learn how to answer the tough questions posed during those
  encounters.
- Biblical disciples multiply their faith
  They can take the things that God has taught them and pass them
  on to someone else. For instance, if they lead someone to Christ,
  do they know what to do besides invite them or take them to
  church? Biblical disciples can learn how to study the Word of
  God in depth and apply the Scriptures, so they themselves can
  build a new believer in the faith by walking through Scripture
  with them. They can also learn how to follow-up with a new
  believer, lead a Bible study, and act as an accountability partner.

# 65. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2019

THEME: IMITATION OF CHRIST READINGS: EXODUS 20:1-10; PSALM 119:57-64 EPHESIANS 5:1-10; MATTHEW 19:16-26

"Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God"

Introduction: Alexander the Great once had a soldier in his army whose name was also Alexander, but when the battle was raging, this General's namesake (a young soldier) cried out in fear. Alexander the Great said to his soldier name-sake, "How can you bear the name of Alexander, my name? Drop your cowardice, or drop your name!" No one should bear Christ's name without imitating Him. Anyone who does not imitate Christ should stop being a Christian!.

To imitate - means to: (a.) To follow or endeavor to follow as a model or example, (b.) To mimic or impersonate, (c.) To make a copy of something; or to reproduce something closely. Apostle Paul wanted Ephesians Christians to follow Jesus Christ as the perfect Model /example and to reproduce themselves closely becoming like Jesus. To imitate Christ is weightier than just mimicking or impersonating Him. Paul in Ephesians 5 commands his followers to be like God. In the world of fashion, there are a few who originate the styles and everyone else follows them. These "new" styles have been seen before; they're just reworked from generations before. All modern society is mimicking someone. But the greatest influence in the history of planet Earth and the most original - is the Lord Jesus Christ. If you want to copy someone, the best choice is Jesus! When Jesus exhibited the character of God, His life struck people as being the most spectacular thing they had ever seen.

### Why God's Children Should be like/Imitate Christ

- a. Because of our New Nature: Most of the time, children are like their parents. Also, the genetic disposition of the parent is usually reproduced in their offspring and; not only do children normally look like their parents, but they usually act like them too. So, through our new nature in Christ, we must be like Him in our lifestyles, imitating Him in words and deeds, having inherited His nature after our Salvation and Adoption. Since we are God's children, just as children imitate their parents, so also, we are to imitate Christ.
- b. Because of our Love for God: If we love God, that love will compel us to imitate Him; if love won't, then no other force will induce us to be like Him. It has been observed that married persons, even if they begin with great dissimilarity, gradually become much alike. Likeness is the natural product of love, and so if we truly love God, we will grow more and more like Him. Our love for others must be of the same kind with Jesus- a kind of love that goes beyond affection to self-sacrificing love. Are you becoming like Jesus in your daily living? Can you be described as a loving person? Are you ready to sacrifice something good for the sake of others because you genuinely love them? If not, you have not been imitating Christ well.!

c. Because we Must not Misrepresent Christ: You can't copy a document without carefully writing down each word. If you have to copy a book, then you must read each line attentively and reproduce them exactly! Think how carefully an artist must look at a landscape in order to represent it on a cardboard or frame. He/ She must paint every blade of grass, every tree, the details of the mountains and streams accurately. If a sculptor is producing a replica of an ancient statue, he must keep his eyes open and follow every line and mark. So it is when we are reproducing the image of God in our lives for others to see, that image must be accurate so others can see what God is like in us. Am I a good replication and imitation of God's image?

### Things that help us to imitate Christ

It seems impossible to be like Christ, but it is possible. We imitate Him through:

- a. The presence of God's Nature in us: God has already done the greater work of making us His children by sending the second Adam (Jesus Christ) to die for us and to give us a new original nature. So, imitating Him with that implanted nature is much easier. We are "born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God" (John 1:13). We are "partakers of the divine nature" (2 Pet. 1:4). And by this new birth we are renewed in His image (Col. 3:10). Are you sure of the new Birth? If not, it will be difficult and impossible to imitate Christ. If we let Christ-within-us occupy the throne of our lives and subdue the fallen and inherited old nature, then clean lives and right feelings will result. We must water that nature with our prayers and watchfulness!
- b. The availability and Assistance of the Holy Spirit: Paul said, "Likewise the Spirit also helps [us] in our weaknesses" Rom. 8:26. The Holy Spirit was given because we are too weak in ourselves to obey God (Rom. 8:3). Jesus said that the Holy Spirit will "guide you into all truth" (John 16:13). We need a Guide to go before each of us and lead us like a shepherd leads sheep - to green pastures and still waters. We don't know the way ourselves. The Holy Spirit also is the distributor of the Grace of God in Christ. Jesus said, "He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you." (John 16:14 AMP). The Holy Spirit gives us encouragement and support at key moments. He convicts us when we are making bad choices. He shows us how we ought to act and reminds us of what Jesus said. Thank God for the Holy Spirit! Do you have the Holy Spirit? Are you sure of His presence in your lives? If not, invite Him today as the Lord within you so that you can imitate Christ easily without human struggle!
- c. The availability of His Word as our Aid: The Word of God (The Bible) also greatly aids us to imitate Christ. It's so wonderful when we have a plan, when things are mapped out for us when we know what we are supposed to do. That's where God's Word comes in. The Scriptures lays out a clear blueprint for us; it is a true compass of how to shape our lives! In it we can see the life of Jesus our example and can search to answer the pertinent questions. "What would Jesus do in this situation?". You cannot possibly imitate someone unless you can fix your eyes upon them and know something about them. That is the beauty of the Word. It reveals a living example of how to be a child of God so that we are capable of imitating our Lord with pleasure!
- d. Our Priviledge to commune with God: As Christians, we have the surpassing privilege to commune with God Himself. When we get into the presence of God, it is like hitting the reset button on your computer; it reverts to the original programming (factory setting), and all the superfluous additions are erased. When we can get into our secret closet and are shut in alone with God, His divine nature overshadows ours. His nature resets the Christ image within us to its original clarity, purity, and strength. In God's presence, we become one with His nature and are transformed again to the original image of Christ. Some people think this only happens once, when we're born again. But Paul knew that we need this resetting regularly when he

said that "the inward man is renewed day by day" 2 Cor. 4:16. Let us hear the voice of God calling us to the secret place (as He did to Moses) in Exodus 25:22. Jesus said to the 12 disciples, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest" (Mark 6:31). We need that quiet place with Jesus! It will bring a spiritual 'rest' to us. When last have you truly tarried in the presence of God?

Conclusion: Back in the 1500s, people didn't have a Bible they could read. The Catholic Church controlled the translating of Scripture and only offered it in Latin. But when Martin Luther rebelled against the abuses of the Church of his day, he worked hard to make a translation available in German (the language of his people). The daughter of Luther's printer was cleaning in her dad's shop and she picked up a piece of paper off the floor. It reads, "For God so loved that He gave..." and that was all. The rest of the verse was not printed yet, but what she saw excited her. The thought that God would give her anything moved her. Her mother noticed a change in her and asked her why she seemed so happy. The girl pulled a crumpled piece of paper out of her pocket and showed it to her mother. The mother read it and asked, "What did He give?". The girl said, "I don't know but if God loved us enough to give us anything we should not be afraid of Him." What she read on that scrap of paper changed how she looked at God! What people read in our lives can change how others look at our God as well. One man has wisely said that "We may be the only Bible anyone ever reads." But that will be true ONLY if we learn to imitate the God we say we love.

>Think of some areas you need to be more like Jesus and what can you do to change such.

>If someone here has never been "born-anew from Heaven," surrender to Jesus to wash your sins away and to become the Lord of your life. This will be the beginning of your quest to imitate God.
