**READINGS: PROVERBS 22:1-6; 1
THESSALONIANS 4:1-8; MARK
10:13-16; PSALM 128**

GOD UNCHANGING LOVE

“Divine Love is Sure, Eternal and in no way dependent upon our worthiness or good behavior”.

This is a statement of fact because God’s love is not conditional, it is absolute. God’s love does not change.

In Romans 5:6-10, Paul the apostle clearly stated how unworthy man was, and yet God’s love remained constant. Let’s take note from the passage: (1), Christ died for us when we had no spiritual strength to serve God; we were religious but ungodly (2), Christ died for us while we were still in our sin (sinners).

His love towards us remained unchanging, the limitless, unfailing love of God is difficult for man to grasp; the scripture says, for God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, that whoever believers in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.” (3). The third and final point is that Christ died for us even when we were His enemies, yet He loved us.

Friend, do you believe in the loving nature of God? Do you accept that God is love? The nature of God moves Him to love His creatures, to communicate Himself to them and to find pleasure in their response to Him. It is amazingly that God seeks your attention through the graciousness of His love. I appeal to you to give Him audience. Do not delay, call on Him to deliver and help you now, and you shall have peace.

In Hosea 11:1,2, "Israel was a filthy and depraved child whose way and life was full of apostasy, yet God showed her His love. God called Israel and love her unconditionally and said: when Israel was a child, I loved him and out of Egypt I called my son. As they called them, so they went from them. They sacrificed to the Baals, and burned incense to carried images." Despite Israel's iniquity, God still kept His unchanging love. Israel had no affinity with God, she was just a candidate of preferment despite her depraved state. In Deuteronomy 7:7-8, the Word of God says, "The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all people; but because the LORD LOVES you. And because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh King of Egypt." Beloved, God's love is rational and relational. First by rational it means, God's love involves feeling and emotion. We need to respond to His feeling and emotion towards us. His love for us never causes Him to violate His righteousness. It is not selfish and imperfect – such love that makes one do evil. But true love of God always seeks the highest good for

its object. His love can never violate His character. It is always under the control of His perfection. For that very reason it took Calvary to save men from their sins. Why not give God a chance in your life. Cry aloud to Him, “**O LORD PLEASE HELP ME, LET YOUR LOVE AND MERCY LOCATE ME TODAY**”

Second, God's love is relational. It operates under a covenant relationship. Deuteronomy chapter 7:9 says, “Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keeps His commandment.”

How can you enjoy this love? Simply by keeping His commandment. When you keep God's commandment, you give credence to His Word, and responding to His love from your heart. Jesus said, “If you love me keep my commandment.”

On a final note, when your heart is equally knitted together with God, the love of God will dwell richly in you, and you shall not be afraid of evil, persecution or any impending danger. Apostle Paul said, who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, “for your sake we are killed all day long: we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.” Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us” (Romans 8:35-37).
