THEME: CHRIST'S AMBASSADORS

**READINGS: 1 CORINTHIANS 5:14-6.2;
JOHN 17:20-26.**

A. INTRODUCTION

An ambassador is an authorized representative of a sovereign Acts 11:26. He speaks not in his own name but on behalf of the ruler whose deputy he is, and his whole duty and responsibility is to interpret that ruler's mind faithfully to those to whom he is sent 1 Corinthians 15:1-4. Other substitutable words are representative, promoter, proponent, advocate, supporter or protagonist. The word Christian in the context of our theme fully depicts or substitute for the phrase 'Christ Ambassador'. A Christian is someone who has the mind of Christ, behaves like Christ and represents Christ here on earth. So, Christians are Christ Ambassadors. We'll all agree that there are good and bad Ambassadors.

Some Nigerians Misrepresenting The Ideals Of The Nation:

Just last week, the United States Government released names of 80 Nigerians suspected to have been involved in well-coordinated fraud. They narrated the strategies adopted by the alleged fraudsters in swindling innocent citizens. Those are bad Ambassadors. They don't have to be diplomats. It goes without saying that the image of the Country, portrayed in bad light will have consequences on our interactions at both diplomatic and interpersonal levels.

B. THE IDEAL AMBASSADOR OF CHRIST

It is assumed that a person chosen as an Ambassador is a living, verbal, and visible image of the sending Country/Ruler. An Ambassador must satisfactorily or considerably represent the sender. Unfortunately, that is not always the case. In our clime, people lobby to be Ambassadors without understanding its import. So, they don't represent. Sadly, they misrepresent.

Paul used the imagery of an "Ambassador" in connection with his evangelistic work. "Pray for me, he wrote from prison, that utterance may be given me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains; that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak" (Eph. 6:18-20). He wrote also that God "gave us the ministry of reconciliation...So we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We beseech you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God" (2 Corinthians 5:18-20). Paul called himself an Ambassador because he knew that when he proclaimed the gospel and urged sinners to receive the reconciliation effected at Calvary,

he was declaring Christ's message to the world. The figure of Ambassadorship highlights the authority Paul had, as representing the Lord, **as long as he remained faithful to the terms of his commission.**

C. THE COMMISSION

1. Preaching: Mark 16:15-16. And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. Great signs will follow as they preach.
2. Discipling: Matthew 28: 19 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit"
3. Salt of the World: Matthew 5:13 "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.
4. Light of the World: Matthew 5:14-16 "Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid; neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven"

From our text, the ideal Christ's Ambassador can be seen in the light of the following;

1. He is appreciative of God's love: He knows the importance of God's love. "*For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead*": 2Cor 5:14
2. Saved: He understands what salvation means and has the moral ground to talk about it. "*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new*" 2Cor 5:17
3. He values Christ's mission to the world: "*To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation*" 2Cor 5:19
4. He understands the urgency: "*Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God*" 2Cor 5:20
5. He understands the Grace of God: "*To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation*" 2Cor 5:19. "*For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him*" 2 Cor 5:21
6. He understand the partnership: "*We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain*" 2Cor 6:1
7. He does not discredit God's Name: "*Giving no offence in anything, that the ministry be not blamed*" 2Cor 6:3.

Just before retiring, the man who had shown such hospitality, knelt and prayed aloud. In his petition he referred to the stranger by name and asked the Lord to bless him. Upon awakening the next morning, he told his guest it was his habit to read the Bible and commune with God at the beginning of each day, and he asked if he would like to join him. The Holy Spirit had been speaking to the heart of this salesman, and when his host tactfully confronted him with the claims of Christ, he gladly received the Savior.

As the two were ready to part, they exchanged business cards. The new believer was amazed to read, "William Jennings Bryan, Secretary of State." William Jennings Bryan was the 41st United States Secretary of State (March 5, 1913 – June 9, 1915).
