5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK** **SUNDAY, 4TH AUGUST, 2019**

THEME: LIVING UNDER THE NEW COVENANT

READINGS: PSALM 119:49-64; EZEKIEL 36:24-28; GALATIANS 5:16-26; LUKE 6:27-38

The theme of our meditation today is Living Under the New Covenant. A covenant is a relationship initiated by God to which a body of people responds in faith. The two most prominent Covenants that guide the Christian faith are the Old Covenant and the New Covenant. The Old Covenant is the one given by God to the Israelites in which He promised that they would be His people to bring all the nations of the world to him. In this Covenant, God required the chosen people to be faithful; to do justice, to love mercy and to walk humbly with their Him. The Old Covenant, as the name goes, is to be found in the books which we call the old Testament. The rules guiding this commandment are shown most clearly in the Ten Commandments.

The New Covenant, on the other hand, is the new relationship with God given by Jesus Christ the Messiah to the apostles; and, through them, to all who believe in Him. Christ the Messiah in this Covenant promised to bring us (believers) into the Kingdom of God and give us life in all its fullness, but however commands us to believe in Him and keep His commandments. The most essential principles guiding the New Covenant are the Summary of the Law and the New Commandment as taught and given to us by Jesus Christ.

The summary of the Law teaches that we should love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind and with all our strength; and also love our neighbours as ourselves. More like a corollary to the Summary of the Law is The New Commandment which teaches us to love one another as Christ loved us. The mediator of the New Covenant between man and God is Jesus Christ and Christians' beliefs about Christ is found in the Scriptures and summed up in the Creeds.

From the Summary of the Law and the New Commandment, one can reasonably say that living under the New Covenant means living in love for God and mankind. And today's Collect says that much - Almighty God, who sent your Holy Spirit to be the life and light of your Church open our hearts to the riches of His grace that we may bring forth the fruit of the Spirit in love and joy and peace; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Principles for Living a Life of Love: We love God because He first loved us. God's action of manifesting His love to us through His Son demonstrates the truth that love must be exercised. Since God acted in love toward us, believers must act likewise by showing godly love to others through the following means among others:

- a. Practical Love (1 John 3:11, 16-18; 4:7-21; Ephesians 5:2; 1Corinthians 13; John 15:17) God's love to us is the greatest love possible. We should, in turn, show our love for others by our words and actions.
- b. Giving (2 Corinthians 9:6-8; Proverbs 3:9-10; Luke 6:38) We should give cheerfully to God the first part of all we earn. We should also give to others unselfishly.
- c. Evangelism and Mission (Psalm 126:5-6; Matthew 28:18-20; Romans 1:16-17; 2 Corinthians 5:11-21) We should be busy telling others about the love of God and His plan of salvation. We should share in the work of foreign missionaries by our giving and prayers.
- d. Communication (Ephesians 4:22-29; Colossians 4:6; James 3:2-13; Isaiah 50.4) We should have control of our tongues so that we will not say things displeasing to God. We should encourage others and be kind and helpful in what we say.
- e. Friendliness (Proverbs 18:24; 17:17; Psalm 119:63) We should be friendly to others, and we should be loyal to those who love and serve God. Now, if the failure of the Old Covenant law to deliver salvation necessitated the New Covenant with its higher demand, then we certainly need the help of the Holy Spirit to enable us do the will of God. And the only way to achieving this is for believers to walk in the Spirit as we are admonished in today's Epistle reading in Gal.5:16. Paul tells us in the same chapter that if we are led by the Spirit, we are not under the law. This means that we have a Guide in the Holy Spirit that comes to indwell us upon our acceptance of Jesus into our life. We can say conclusively again that to live under the New Covenant is to walk in the Spirit.

- ii. Living under the New Covenant means walking in the Spirit
- iii. Living under the New Covenant means loving the unlovable.

May God grant us the grace and enablement of the Holy Spirit to live as children of Covenant to His praise and glory. Amen.
