5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH OCTOBER, 2019 *THEME: ACHIEVING GODLY TARGETS* READINGS: 1 PETER 4:7-11:10; MATTHEW 25:14-30 A. INTRODUCTION

Targets, Goals, Visions, Objectives and Aspirations can all mean just the same thing for the purpose of this meditation. They are set with expectation of achievement. In the Business world, failure to achieve set goals; be it sales target, profit target or productivity target or financial target would be subjected to review for recovery strategy ad firmer execution. The focus of this theme is not goal setting but how to achieve set ones. It is given that the goal or target is a God-given one. For instance, God assigned Moses to go bring the Israelites out of Egypt. Did he achieve that? So, the big question is; **why do we often fail to achieve set goals?** If we flip the reasons, we'll have principles to embrace in achieving our goals.

B. 9 REASONS CHRISTIANS FAIL TO ACHIEVE SET TARGETS/GOALS/VISION

The reasons are not farfetched. They are contained in the Gospel we read today. It's even more instructive to read from verse one and enjoy the story of the ten virgins. The foolish five tells us how not to do it. The servant with one talent tells us how not to do it as well. We can equally refer to the reasons stated as vision killers.

- Lack of Knowledge, Understanding& Wisdom: Mtt 25:2. Five of the virgins were wise and five foolish. James 1:5 says if we lack wisdom we should ask God who gives liberally. God does not withhold wisdom. Some of us set goals but we don't seek to gather information that can help us achieve it. Faith propels us to action. We must constantly tow the path of wisdom. Prv. 4:7 says "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding" Attend conferences, seminars, Bible Study; ask questions; seek counsel; study the Bible; add knowledge to knowledge. Failing to understand the rule is precursor to failing to stand in the game.
- 2. Ignoring the Holy Spirit: Mtt. 25:3. Without the Holy Spirit, our God-given goals would be difficult to achieve. The Holy Spirit is here to help us. The foolish sisters did not take enough oil with them. We can take the oil as a symbol for the Holy Spirit. They burn-out. They couldn't cope. Darkness took over. We can't do anything meaningful without being guided by the Holy Spirit. If it's a God-given goal, you need the Spirit of God all the way. The Holy Spirit would teach us all things. The five foolish virgins would have been sustained if they had oil. Eph 4:30 says the Holy Spirit is our seal till the day of redemption.
- 3. **Inattention to Details**: When the Bible says 'Take Heed', it means don't underestimate the situation. Don't undermine the little leaven that can affect the whole dough. The foolish virgins failed to pay attention to details. They would had noticed that the oil wouldn't take them far. Yet, they ignored. There are lots of us who don't bother about the details the Holy Spirit reveal to us. Achieving financial targets would require paying attention to fine details and as much as possible eliminate leaks and wastes; avoid unnecessary spending. Inattention to detail cost Moses a lot.

- 4. Carelessness: Ephesians 5:15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise. They were casual with the project. They were flippant in the waiting. You can't have a goal of Spiritual Concentration and be busy with 'Big Brother Naija' where obscene things are aired. Christians must be circumspect. The enemy who planted tares when men slept in Matthew 13:25-30 is still much around. He doesn't want any godly vision achieved.
- Distraction: Nehemiah in Nehemiah 6:1-14, refused 5. to be distracted by Sanballat, Tobiah and the rest of the enemies. In that chapter alone, they attempted four times to trick him off the assignment. His answer each time is too sweet to ignore. Verse 3 says "I sent messengers to them saying, I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down; why should the work cease, whilst I leave it and come down to you?"The servant with one talent was distracted by his illperception of his master Matthew 25:24-25. Instead of facing the target set for him, he busied himself with his considered flaws of his employer. He was negative. He did not see anything good in his master and on that premise, he refused to pursue the task given to him. Many of us get distracted by ungodly traditions that take our focus away from the goal. Samson was distracted by Delilah Judges 16:1&4. Solomon was distracted by strange women and followed their gods 1Kings 11:1-13. Lot's wife was distracted by her possession in Sodom and Gomorrah Gen 19:26.
- 6. Fear: In Numbers chapter 13, twelve spies were sent to see the land of Canaan which God would give to Israel. Only two came with positive report. In verse 31, the ten men gave an evil report that dampened the spirit of the team (Num 14:1). They said as much as seeing from the eye of the giants that they were like grasshoppers. Caleb and Joshua saw differently (Num 14:6-9). Fear cripples zeal and drive. Many fail to achieve their goals because of fear of failing, fear of uncertainty, fear of people, fear of competition, fear of the unknown. Our walk with God is only by faith. Without faith, we cannot not walk and work with God.
- 7. Lack of Focus or Irresolute Focus. Don't just be busy. Be focused. For the servant with one talent, the reason for giving him one talent was to maximize profit for his master. He failed to focus on that. For the virgins, the primary reason for waiting was to receive the bridegroom when he comes for the marriage. That singular reason should drive everything they do in preparation. They must not miss the appearance of the bridegroom. Focus guides activities. Focus channels energy appropriately. A clear vision is required of all Christians. We must know that we can't serve two masters. We can't serve God and mammon (Matthew 6:24). Gaze must be fixed on Jesus (Heb 12:2)
- 8. Complacency: Some form of pre-mature satisfaction can terminate a godly mission. Some people arrive too early. They celebrate without the trophy. Complacency breeds procrastination, lethargy and snuffs out drive to continue. Complacency is the extinguisher of a smoldering passion. It is not over until it is over.
- 9. Sinfulness: Sin siphons passion to pursue the goal. The adversary, the devil would capitalize on this to abort the mission. Your light can't be off. Your guard can't be off. Satan is a legalist. He prowls about like a

C. CONCLUSION

Achieving godly targets has to do 100% with our relationship with the giver of the goal or target. "When we walk with the Lord in the light of His Word; what a glory he sheds on her path; when we do his goodwill; he abides us with us still; and with all who will trust and obey. The five wise virgins kept hope alive by keeping their lamp aglow. They obeyed. They paid attention to the details of the bridegroom's coming. They focused. They allowed no distraction. They did not ignore the Holy Spirit. They had sufficient oil. At the end, they achieved. We can achieve too. How do we move from here? Prayerfully assess the task given to you like Nehemiah did in Nehemiah 2:13. Then, objectively avoid the pitfalls discussed. Flip them to walk with the principles. **Shalom**
