5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6TH OCTOBER, 2019

THEME: TRUST AND OBEY

READINGS: Psalm 63; Deut.6:3-9; 1 John 4:18-5:5; Matt.22:34-40

Trusting and Obeying God are two indispensable content of a successful walk with God. The trust and obedience we are talking about here are not circumstantial or seasonal, but all-season and all-weather. Trust can be generic in a way - trust God to see you tomorrow, trust God to wake up tomorrow, trust God to have food to eat tomorrow - all these can be generic because almost everybody has this kind of trust that does not make so much demand of our faith and God remains ever faithful in performing all this for the good and the bad, the poor and the rich, for Christians and atheists alike.

But what happens in unpleasant situations vouchsafed by life vicissitudes, when riches suddenly vanish, when health for no fault of one begins to fail with symptoms of imminent sunset at mid-day, when the world seems to be collapsing on oneself? Before you say "Yes, I will trust Him", take a pause and ask Job what it takes because he is undoubtedly the most cited reference in the subject of unconditional trust in God. The words of his rugged faith still resonate in the ears with tingling effect as of the fingers of a mother pulling hard the ears of her wavering child; "Hold your peace with me, and let me speak, then let come on me what may! Why do I take my flesh in my teeth, and put my life in my hands? Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him" (Job 13:13-15a; NKJV).

Trust in God induces obedience without questioning; obedience that is anchored on the faith that God will remain ever faithful to His word and do what He says He will do. People who have unwavering confidence in God's faithfulness to bring His words to performance have absolutely no reason to doubt Him.

Guess you are familiar with the trendy MTN advert, not too long ago, of a boy on roof top that jumped down at the instruction of his father with the hope of leaping into his hands. In the advert, the father disappointed him, showing the vanity and futility of trusting in man. And that is exactly where God is different. When he asks you to do something, even a risky thing like jumping from the roof top of your life into His stretched loving arms, all He expects is obedience. **Obedience makes you to act according to His instruction, and the result is happiness**. And this is the crux of this week's homily – Trust and Obey.

Today's Epistle and Gospel readings, 1 John 4:18 - 5:5 and Matt.22:34-40 respectively, bother on love for God and fellow humans. One then wonders what the correlation is between love and the theme - Trust and Obey. One thing so certain however is that the planners of the lectionary made no mistake. Let's look at it this way, Jesus said in John 14:23 - If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. There is an experience of intimacy and an "at-homeness" with Jesus and the Father that comes only through obedience.

That is, "For those who love me so much that keeping my word is not the works of the law, but the overflow of their affections for me." And how could we not move into such a heart with the fullness of the at-homeness that you long for? Do you know what? The person that loves God and His word, to keep it, holds fast, treasure it in obedience, that person will not be quenching the Spirit; that person will not be grieving the Spirit, but will know the fullness and sweetness of fellowship with the Father and with the Son. If you're watching pornography every week, do not expect this experience. You won't have it. If you're harsh with your wife, you won't have it. If you doubledeal your husband, you won't have it; if you are a husband/wife snatcher, you won't have it.

Trusting and obeying God is possible for only those who acknowledge and submit to His sovereignty. It is God's sovereignty that constantly reminds us about the place of His grace in our lives. Whoever we are, whatever we have, it is all by grace. God wants it so, and so it is. In the same vein, He allows challenges in unexpected quarters so that man may constantly remember that the Most High rules in the affairs of men and distributes all manners of gifts to men as He wants. And, no man can query Him.

Apostle Paul certainly had an enviable close relationship with God. Theirs was an intimate relationship characterized by dialogue. Yet, God in full exercise of His sovereign power allowed an affliction in the life of Paul. According to Paul, it was meant to prevent him from possible spiritual arrogance.

To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. (2 Cor. 12:7-9, NIV).

Just look at that! God's power is made perfect in weakness. When you are weak, God's strength is manifestly seen. When you desire and don't have the simple thing your neighbour seems to be complaining of having too much of, you cannot but see that thing as a gift from God.

One night at a Dwight L. Moody evangelistic meeting in Brockton, Massachusetts, a young man stood up to testify about his confidence of salvation. He said, "I am not quite sure," meaning that he wasn't really certain that God would save him from his sins — and then he continued, "But I'm going to trust, and I'm going to obey" –

meaning that he planned to trust God for his salvation and to do what he could to obey God's will. Daniel Towner was the song leader for that meeting. He was so impressed by the young man's testimony that he wrote down those words and stuck them in his pocket. Later, he wrote a friend, John Sammis. In his letter, he told about the young man's testimony and included the young man's words: "I am not quite sure, but I'm going to trust, and I'm going to obey." Sammis quickly transformed those words into a hymn chorus: "Trust and obey, For there's no other way To be happy in Jesus, But to trust and obey." Soon he had five stanzas to go with the chorus, and he sent them to Towner, who composed the tune that we still sing today.

This story shows how precious in the sight of God is our simple act of trust and obedience.
