F. 15 BAD HABITS TO AVOID IN CHURCH:

1 Timothy 3:15; 2 Thessalonians 3:7; 1 Thessalonians 2:10

1. Chatting and receiving calls during Church Service.
2. Running out to pick calls with your phone ringing out so loud. This is **SACRILEGIOUS**.
3. Refusing to obey the directives of the Church Stewards indicates disobedience in the house of God.
4. Folding your hands when your Pastor is teaching or preaching. You are telling him that what he is saying is not worthwhile.
5. Habitual lateness to Church service is a **SPIRITUAL FLIGHT** that has take off time.
6. Staring at fellow parishioners and making them uncomfortable.
7. Dozing or sleeping in Church during sermon or in the course of the Service -Acts 20:9.
8. Sitting down inactive during Prayer or Praise session especially when other parishioners are standing without any evidence of health challenge.
9. Looking at the clock on the wall and your wristwatch and then at the Pastor's face insinuating that he should round off.
10. Borrowing things like phone chargers, pen etc. and leaving the Church with the said items. Remember Exodus 20:15, 17
11. Leaving the Church before the end of Service.

**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 10TH NOVEMBER, 2019**

THEME: OCCUPY TILL HE RETURNS

**READINGS: JOSHUA 6:22-25, PSALM 112;
11 CORINTHIANS 5:6-15, LUKE 19:11-27.**

A. INTRODUCTION: The reason Jesus gave this parable is in Verse 11 of Luke Chapter 19. The people wanted the kingdom of God that Jesus kept talking about to appear immediately. It sounded too good and sweet to ignore. Who wouldn't want that? They were assuming that very shortly their Master would be sitting upon his throne in Jerusalem. We can recall that they were arguing about who was going to have what position in the new government (Mark 10:35-37, Luke 9:46); who would sit on the Lord's right and left. However, they missed the point. Jesus had to straighten out their wrong conclusions. He used a parable to teach them what they really needed to be focused on. **There was work to be done.** He spoke of a nobleman who was going away to receive his kingdom. He left his servants with a charge over a portion of his wealth while he was away. These ten servants were to faithfully take what he had given them and use it profitably until he returned. The nobleman of the parable ultimately represents the Lord Jesus and the servants are His disciples, we, the Christians. As he left for Heaven, he gave us the command; 'OCCUPY TILL I COME' Luke 19:13

B. THE RESOURCES V13a.

He gave each of his ten servants a pound. While emphasis is not on the amount, it is on what they must do with it. Jesus gave us Salvation, His Name, His Spirit, the Truth and Gifts.

C. THE RESPONSIBILITY V13b.

They were given very simple instructions. "OCCUPY TILL I COME" What does this word "OCCUPY" mean? It neither means "take up space" nor passiveness. It means to be busy, to carry on business by trading and profiting. He is telling us to TAKE CARE OF THE KINGDOM'S BUSINESS" KEEP BUSY UNTIL I RETURN. TURN MEN TO RIGHTEOUSNESS AND SUSTAIN IT.

D. THE BUSINESS Acts 10:38

The reason Jesus came was to save the world. For God so loved the world that He gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life. The Business is simply saving the world. Every child of God is recruited to join Jesus in saving the world. 2Cor 5:19-20 says he has committed unto us word of reconciliation as we are ambassadors for Christ.
