

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 17TH NOVEMBER, 2019

THEME: THE GREAT DAY OF THE LORD

READINGS: Zeph. 1:14-18; 1 Thess. 5:1-11;

Matt 13:24-32.

Now, brothers, about times and dates we do not need to write to you, for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While people are saying, "Peace and safety," destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. But you, brothers, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief. You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. 1 Thess. 5:1-6NIV

Looking at the world today, everything in it tends to assure us that the world continues forever. As one government succeeds another, one is tempted to say 'so shall it be forever'. But, there is a fact coming from the Maker of the world (God) that one day, the world shall surely come to an end. And just as a farmer harvests his crops and burns the weed at the harvest season so shall the world be harvested by God. While those who are obedient to Him would reign with Him, the disobedient shall have their eternal damnation in hell. This shall be marked with Christ's return to the world to take the elect home.

It is worthy of note that the phrase 'The Great Day of The Lord' significantly represents the coming of Jesus which is the final harvest. In the New Testament's 260 chapters, Christ's return is mentioned no less than 318 times. Statistically, one

verse for every 25 pages of the Bible refers to the return of Jesus Christ in some way, shape, or form. Make no mistake about it: Jesus Christ will come back again, and God has given us specific instructions for what we are to do while we wait.

First, we are to be watching for Him. "Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching" (Luke 12:37 NKJV). We shouldn't get caught up in the things that dominate the minds and hearts of nonbelievers, such as what we will eat, drink, and wear. Instead, we should be consumed with our pursuit of the kingdom of God. We should seek, above all, the rule and reign of Jesus Christ in our lives.

Second, we should be ready to go. Let me ask you this: If Christ came back today; would you be ready to go with Him? If Christ came back at that moment, would a place where you're about to go or a thing you're about to do cause you to be ashamed or embarrassed in any way? If so, then you need to change what you're doing. If you are not living in a way that is pleasing to Him right now, then His return will come as a great shock and surprise to you.

Third, we should want to become more like Jesus Christ each day. According to 2 Peter 3:11-14, "You ought to live holy and godly lives. . . . So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, make every effort to be found spotless, blameless, and at peace with Him" (NIV). If you have a real sense of His imminent return, then it will impact the way you live and will cause you to purify yourself, even as He is pure (1 John 3:3).

Fourth, we should anxiously await His return. Have you ever been looking forward to seeing someone? You wait for the sound of that person's car in the driveway. You pull the door open before your friend can even knock. That's what it means to "anxiously await" someone's arrival. If anything would cause us hesitancy in saying, "Even so, come, Lord Jesus!" (Revelation 22:20 NKJV), then we need to carefully examine our lives.

Finally, we should be working (Luke 12:43). While watching is the evidence of faith, working is the evidence of faith in action. Watching for the Lord's return will help us prepare our own lives, but working will assure that we will take others with us.

BIBLE TEACHING OUTLINE

TOPIC: DO NOT COMPROMISE

TEXT: EXOD. 3:3, 7:16, 8:25-28, 10:11, 24-27

A. DEFINITION OF TERM

Compromise is a way of reaching agreement in which each person or group gives up something that was wanted in order to end an argument or dispute. Compromise is also a change that makes something worse and that is not done for a good reason. Compromise is a concession to something derogatory or prejudicial.

B. INTRODUCTION:

Compromise is a common word in politics and in settling of a labour dispute. The word does not appear in the Bible but it has become a common word in our evangelical vocabulary today. A call to the understanding of what compromise entails is a call to beware of compromise.

A compromise of God's will and Godly principle is disastrous, this is one of the aims of this teaching with a view to enable us learn from the scripture. Compromise is a sacrifice of principles, as Christians this must not be seen or heard among us.

Compromise involves the partial surrendering of one's position in concession to another party. In our case as Christians the parties are *ENEMY*, *SATAN* and *HIS COHORTS*.

C. BIBLICAL EXAMPLES OF COMPROMISE AND THE ATTENDANT DANGER

- God told Joshua to destroy the inhabitants of Canaan Joshua 9:24. The Gibeonites tricked Joshua and got a compromise they became his servant.
- 2. God told Saul to totally destroy the Amalekites 1 Sam. 15:3.

 Saul compromised and saved Agag and some animals. His kingdom was take away
- 3. THE PHARAOH, MOSES, ISRAEL COMPROMISE OFFER
- A. <u>FIRST COMPROMISE</u>: Exodus 8:25 Sacrifice in the land (God's directives were that Israel be separated by a journey of three day from Egypt Exod. 5:3, Exod. 7:16.
- B. <u>SECOND COMPROMISE</u>: Exodus 8:2- Go not very far.
- C. THIRD COMPROMISE: Exodus 10:8-11, Let only the men go
- D. <u>FOURTH COMPROMISE</u>: Exodus 10:24-27 Let the people go but not the cattle.

NB: Moses rejected all the compromises offered by Pharaoh because it represented *INCOMPLETE OBEDICENCE*. It means compromise.

Compromise is to stop us from getting to our destination and fulfilling our destiny. It amounts to settling for average when excellence is God's plan for us.
