5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 3RD NOVEMBER, 2019 THEME: AVOIDING SELF GLORIFICATION READINGS: GENESIS 11:1-9, PSALM 11; EPHESIANS 3:20-4:1-6, JOHN 11:17-27.

What is self glorification? It is a feeling or expression of one's own superiority, and it appears we all are guilty of it when we want to talk about ourselves a lot; when we tend to take our opinions more glorious than the opinions of others; when we think our stories are more interesting and more engaging than others; when we think we know and understand more than others; when we think we have earned the right to be heard; when we do not reference our weakness; when we do not talk about our failures; when we do not confess our sin or think we are not as sinful as others. The Pharisees lived so much of self glorification life as they paraded their glory before the watching eyes. Self glorification is thinking you have arrived and seeing less of need for rescuing grace.

Self glorification indicators include being Boastful: Jeremiah 9:23-24, says "Thus says the LORD: Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I am the LORD, exercising loving-kindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the Lord. The wise only boast in the Lord's Strength. It has been noticed in the lives of many leaders in history that the devil's plan had always been to pull them down by creating access for them to dishonor God. Romans 1:21, 'For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened'. Romans.1:22-23 says, "Claiming to be wise, they became fools, and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things." Have you asked yourself these questions: who takes my best worship, gift, time, talent, treasure and attention? If it is a being other than God, the creator of heaven and earth, then you are giving His glory away to another. And His glory He will not share with another.

"And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross." (Philipians2:8) Every man that claims to be Christ like should constantly be dressed with humility both outside and inside of the church. The opposite of humility is pride. Pride is nothing but a personal ride to self-destruction.

Herod, pumped up by his power and position, failed to recognize God. He was also a major agent attempting to terminate the Body of Christ. The same Herod ordered the killing of James, the brother of John, and attempted to claim the life of Peter, but God moved on behalf of Peter. Whatever it is that is taking away the glory of God through you, ask for the move of God's divine intervention for your deliverance. "So on a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat on his throne and gave an oration to them. And the people kept shouting, "The voice of a god and not of a man!" Then immediately an angel of the Lord struck him, because he did not give glory to God. And he was eaten by worms and died." (Acts 12:21-23).

Nebuchadnezzar was humiliated when he arrogated glory to himself. Daniel 4:30, "...Is not this great Babylon that I have built for a royal dwelling by my mighty power and for the honor of my majesty?" Self-glorification must be avoided at all cost.

Nebuchadnezzar moved from grace to grass for seven years. After he came back to his senses, he testified in Daniel 4:37, "...And those who walk in pride He is able to pull down." Avoid self-glorification!

God is able to remove all the physical accomplishments of the self-exalted person. Anyone who glories in himself will receive his true reward in the form of condemnation, debasement, degradation, and humiliation. It takes conscious effort under Grace of God to avoid self-glory. Strict dependence of the Grace of God eliminates for us the possibility of any boasting. To avoid self-glorification, therefore, let us ask for grace of God, while we continue to study the Scripture, pray regularly and be sensitive to the Holy Spirit.
