- 5. He obeyed the Word of God Gen. 7:5
- 6. He was in the ARK, a type of the Church today, a place of *REFUGE*.
- 7. He enjoyed the presence of God
- 8. His family enjoyed same exception because Noah took responsibility for the welfare of his family *Gen. 7:7*
- 9. He feared God Heb. 11:7
- 10. He was responsible and responsive to his God given vision and assignment
- Noah's escape was not accidental, He prepared for it -Heb. 11:7

# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 15<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2019

THEME: Prepare for His Coming
READINGS: Mathew 24:42 (Watch therefore, for you know not what hour your Lord does come); Rev. 22:7, 12, 20;
John 119-28; 1 Cor. 4:1-5.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

From all indications, the news of the coming of Christ is in the air. We can see it all around us. The trees, the mountains, the valleys, the waters, the atmosphere, the governance, the rush, the haste, the spate of events, tell us about His coming. It is obvious as both Christian and non-Christian are curious as to what the dawn of advent means. Everywhere, people are asking: is the end at hand? Are these the last days? There is no doubt about the fact that the coming of Christ is in the air.

### 2. SIGNS OF HIS RETURN

- Signs and events that will first take place before His return are well written in the Scriptures
- There will be false sense of security 1Thess.5:1-2
- There will be religious apostasy 1Tim.4:1; Mathew 24:5; 2Thess.2:9-10
- Evil will increase in the land. Rev.12
- Globalization: Dan.12:4. Technology will almost make man forget God
- There will be world-wide preaching of the Gospel. Matt 24:14
- There will be rumour of wars; the rise of Antichrists (enemies of the Gospel), Mathew 24. 4ff
- Mockers will say "where is the promise of His coming' 2Peter 3:3-4

# 3. PRACTICAL WAYS TO PREPARE FOR CHRIST'S RETURN.

- i. Stop asking "When"
- The New Testament Speaks some Three hundred times about the return of Christ, but

- nowhere in the O.T or N.T does God indicate exactly 'when' Christ will return.
- No one knows about the day or hour, not even the Angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father (Mark 13:32)
- Many respected prophets and scholars had in the times past predicted the coming of Christ, which never came to pass. Harold Camping in 1992, after 30years of study on the matter, concluded that Rapture would take place in 1998. Marilyn J. Agee's prediction said 1994 was the year, and September 6, the Day. These predictions can bring credibility problems to Christianity and the Gospel. Therefore, let us stop guessing, but be preparing for His return.

## ii. We are to prepare our heart

- Between Mathew chapters 24 and 25, a number of parables were told by Jesus Christ to inform us on how to prepare for the coming of Christ.
- We are to prayerfully study the parable of the fig tree Matt. (24:32-36), saying that you have to be fruitful as a Christian.
- We are to study the days of Noah: (Matt.24:37-44), that just as it happened then so shall it be when Christ shall return.
- We are to look at the parable of the faithful and unfaithful servant (Matt 24:45ff), calling us unto faithfulness in the assignments God gave to us
- The parable of the ten virgins (Matt. 25:1-13), telling us to be holy, ever ready, wise and not be foolish.
- The parable of the Talents (Matt. 25:14-30), telling us about accountability and productivity.
- All these parables tell us how to live. Remember these parables came immediately after the discussion of the second coming.

# iii. From the parable of the ten virgin alone, we are able to learn:

- To be prepared for a long delay, having extra oil, a deep faith
- To keep watch constantly, because He will come when least expected (Mark 13:35-37)
- To be ready now, being aware that, spiritually, there is a point of no return. We read that the door was shut against the foolish ones.
- To watch expectantly with joyful heart. Every child of God must be full of joy. 1Thess 4:16.

### BIBLE TEACHING OUTLINE

TOPIC: PREPARE FOR HIS COMING:

FLEE FROM THE WRATH TO COME

TEXT: MATTHEW 3:7

### INTRODUCTION

As the year is coming to an end, it would amount to a serious disservice if we do not talk about the Second Coming of the Lord and the need not only to prepare for it but to be ever ready. Though this is coming towards the end of the year by the reason of Church Calendar and arrangement of theme in line with ADVENT, it is extremely important that we all understand the fact that the Second Coming of the Lord may not necessarily be in November or December. It could be January, March of July. He is coming like a thief unexpectedly on a day that exclusively know to God and God alone

We are looking at this subject matter which unarguably is the most crucial and outstanding event in kingdom agenda and calendar under the sub-theme.

## FLEE FROM THE WRATH TO COME - MATTHEW 3:7

This was a warning passed to the Pharisees, Sadducees and the powers that be in the days of John the Baptist when they came to him. We all know Jesus Christ as Lord, Saviour, merciful, gracious, loving, caring etc, but we must also never loose sight of the fact that HE IS A CONSUMING FIRE - Heb. 12:29 and that it is a fearful thing to fall into His hand - Heb. 10:31. His first coming was in LOVE His Second Coming will be to JUDGE the world. He is coming in His wrath to judge those who fail to accept Him as Lord and Saviour.

### A. WHAT IS WRATH

This is **EXTREME ANGER**, A strong vengeful anger or indignation, A retributory punishment for an offense or a crime. Wrath is divine chastisement.

### B. GOD'S ANTECEDENTS IN RELATION TO WRATH

- 1. The flood in the days of Noah
- 2. The case of Sodom and Gomorrah
- 3. The plagues in Egypt
- C. CAUSES OF DIVINE WRATH -Colossians 3:1-17, NB vs. 5-6 Disobedience, SIN i.e. Simple instruction neglected

### D. CATEGORIES OF WRATH

- 1. Past wrath of God 2. Ongoing wrath; contemporary
- 3. The coming wrath

### E. THE PAST AND THE FUTURE WRATH:

It is not a mere coincidence that the book of Revelation has a record of serious and striking correlation by way of similarity between the wrath of God upon Egypt and the coming wrath as documented in the book of Revelation.

With the exception of the third plague in Egypt which was of *LICE* all other plagues will be re-enacted in the future. God is not a sadist but it won't cause Him anything to do again what He had done before in same regard. Interestingly He warns ahead of time before acting thus the need to pay attention to this issue. It is expected that as Christians we shall take time to search the scripture more about this subject matter taking a clue from the noble Christians in Berean by searching the Bible for confirmation - *Acts* 17:10-11.
