# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 22<sup>ND</sup> DECEMBER, 2019

THEME: Submission: Key to Divine Favour READINGS: Text: Romans 1:1-7; Luke 1:26-38a One of the most embarrassing things for any woman is to have a bastard as a son. And one of the most painful things for any man is to find his intending wife impregnated by someone else. These were also detestable in Bible time as it is today.

Reading the account of how Mary was found pregnant at a time she was pledged to be married to Joseph in Luke 1:26-38, one cannot but ask how Mary was able to survive the shame. One cannot also forget that feeling of being betrayed from Joseph to Mary. Since there was no antecedent of anyone being pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit, Joseph had every right to feel cheated. But then, something amazing is found in this story and that is the fact that both of them submitted themselves as willing vessels to be used by God even when they did not understand what was actually going on.

From the collect above, we are made to know that God chose Mary to be the Mother of Jesus Christ our Lord. Mary found herself in this position, accepted the perfect will of God which indeed brought the salvation to mankind. Looking at the life of Mary, one great lesson we all learn is the power of submission. When one submits to God, he or she puts himself or herself under the atmosphere of favour.

### What does it mean to submit to God?

The biblical concept of submission is to place oneself under the authority of another. When we submit to God, we give our lives to His authority and control. In what ways can we submit ourselves to God?

1. By giving our lives to Christ. We begin submission to God by believing in Jesus as God's Son who rose from the dead to give us eternal life. Romans 10:9 states, "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

- 2. Obedience to His word. Just as a child seeks to obey his or her parent to show love and respect, we are called to submit to God through loving obedience to His commands. John 15:14
- 3. Eagerness to learn more about God. Psalm 1 offers the example of a godly person whose life is submitted to God: "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night" (Psalm 1:1-2). Those who love God submit to Him through a life that seeks to better know Him each day. This is done by reading and meditating in God's word.
- 4. Our disposition to others. For example, Ephesians 5:21 speaks of, "submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ." Whether a husband and wife or how we treat other people, our goal is to show Christ's love. In Matthew 25:40, Jesus even taught that how we treat the least of these is how we treat Him: "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers. did me." vou it to
- 5. Sharing the Gospel message. For example, when the woman at the well was changed by Jesus, she immediately left her water jar, ran to the village, and told others, "Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?" (John 4:29). Her submission to Jesus included sharing Him with others.

All areas of our lives are to be submitted to God and placed under His authority if really we want God's favour. When we come to Jesus for salvation, obey Him, learn about Him, treat others with love, and share Christ with others, we are showing our submission to the Lord through our actions in ways that honour God and change the lives of others.

Honestly, when we submit to God, we position ourselves for God's favour and this favour can bring a lot of blessings upon us. Divine favour has the capacity to:

- 1. Produce supernatural promotion and increase (Gen 39:21)
- 2. Bring restoration of everything the enemy has stolen (Exo. 3:21).
- 3. Bring honour in the midst of adversaries (Exo. 11:3).
- 4. Produce increased assets (Deut. 33:23).
