THEME: THE WORD OF GOD

READINGS: ISAIAH 11:1-10; PSALM 119:105-112; 11 TIMOTHY 3:14-4:1-5; JOHN 36B-END

THE WORD OF GOD/THE HOLY SCRIPTURE

Miriam Webster Dictionary defines Scripture as the books of either the Old Testament or the New Testament or both (often used in plural): The Bible.

The adjective "holy" that qualifies it depicts its divine origin, source and perfection in goodness and righteousness. When we talk about the Holy Scripture, therefore, we are in essence talking about the Holy Bible or the Word of God in its general usage.

In this thoughtful discourse, the three- Scripture, Word, Bible shall be used interchangeably. It is a common knowledge that the Word of God is the most powerful force and weapon in heaven and earth. It is the beginning of all creation and without it nothing was made. The book Genesis gives us the account of creation through the spoken word- 'and God said...'. Our focus in this discourse however shall be on the place of the Holy Scripture in our daily Christian living. The idea is to refresh ourselves about the usefulness of the Holy Scripture or the Word of God in drawing strength and all that is required for life survival from God through the instrumentality of His Word.

BENEFITS OF THE WORD OF GOD

i. The Word of God as *lamp and light* (**Ps.119:105**) provides illumination to us as we journey through the dark paths of life with their valleys, mountains, hills, crooked paths and changing scenes that make navigation through life an arduous task. It helps us to run our race successfully to the end.

- i. Because tomorrow is unknown, we all need *divine guidance* through the unknown paths of life. **Isa.30:21** says "And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left". The Word of God serves as our guide through life.
- ii. When we find ourselves at the verge of decision, as we often do, the Holy Scriptures provide us with standard *gauge of judgment* We find in it sufficient admonitions and instructions for life skills right judgment. It provides us with behavioral standards that help us to choose the path that pleases God.
- iii. The Holy Scripture is the *inexhaustible reservoir* of excelling wisdom and knowledge. Ps.119:98-100 says "Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me. I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditations. I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts."
- iv. As humans, there are times we run out of strength and, like an exhausted deer, long refreshing of our perched souls is needed. At such time, the Word of God comes ready as *fountain of living water* for the needed refreshing. Ps.119:107 bears testimony that the Word of God revives (refreshes, preserves) the soul.
- v. Apostles Paul makes us to know in his second pastoral Epistle to Timothy that study and knowledge of the Word of God *gives divine approval* (2 Timothy 2:15) The simple logic here is that we please God by doing His will; and the primary source of knowledge of God's will is the Holy Scripture.
- vi. The Word of God is *believer's antidote to temptation and sin*. The Psalmist captures this essence when he wrote "Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You." **Ps.119:11**.
