JUSTIFICATION FOR SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP

The desirability of society membership is traceable to the Godly advice of Jethro to Moses his son in law as he administered the huge population of the Israelites in the wilderness.

"MOREOVER THOU SHALL PROVIDE OUT ALL THE PEOPLE ABLE MEN, SUCH AS FEAR GOD, MEN OF TRUTH, HATING COVETOUSNESS AND PLACE SUCH OVER THEM, TO BE RULERS OF THOUSANDS AND RULERS OF HUNDREDS, RULERS OF FIFTIES AND RULERS OF TENS" EXOD. 18:21.

Beloved to the glory of God AVMCC is a fairly large congregation and as the Israel of God today Gal. 6:16 we must follow the Bible standard as expatiated fully in Exodus 18:17-27 for the following reasons:

- 1. It is good to be in society vs. 17.
- 2. The blessings of joining a society far outweighs the burden if any.
- 3. The burden if any is light because it is of Christ and not of man Matt. 11:28-30.
- 4. The Priests will not wear out in attending to large congregation as it is not possible to know everybody vs 18.
- 5. The people will not wear out as their matter receive the attention of sectional leaders with a referral of major matters to appropriate quarters vs 18.
- 6. It is a Godly counsel to be a member of a society vs 19.
- 7. It is an avenue to learn more of the ordinances of God and His laws vs 20.
- 8. It affords the opportunities of knowing the way of God better as seminars retreats, visitations, fellowships, fasting praying are arranged vs 20.
- 9. It points us to the work which we have to do vs 20.
- 10.It enables the Priest to focus more on Prayer and the word of God which of course is their major assignment Acts 6:4.
- 11.It allows the church to maximize the potentials of spiritual gifts and explore talents of members using also their professional expertise to enhance the standard of the Church vs 21.
- 12.It allows for matters to receive urgent and timely attention vs 22.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 12TH JANUARY, 2020

THEME: FULFILLING ALL RIGHTEOUSNESS READINGS: ISAIAH 42:1-9; ACTS 10:34-38a; MATTHEW 3:13-17

A. INTRODUCTION

Greeting one another for seeing the New Year is still in order, especially for those we are just seeing in 2020. God's grace and mercy brought us this far. Fleetingly, eleven days have gone! We praise God for the blessing of the second Sunday. We have started telling ourselves that the walk this year is a walk of faith, nothing less. The only way to build capacity, enlarge coast, expand your business, attain greater heights, tread uncharted path, break new grounds, hear God, love God, grow spiritually, receive spiritual gifts and get God seriously involved is by FAITH. We all need to quickly key into this powerful flow. It is an amazing theme. The season is Epiphany; the manifestation of Jesus to the Gentiles. Today is the first Sunday in the Season. Plainly speaking, it is about the revelation of Jesus. To a child of God, there are always fresh revelations if we seek him consistently. "Thou shall find me when thou have diligently sought me" To the heathen, it is eureka, a turning point, translation from darkness to light.

B. JESUS WAS BAPTIZED TO FULFIL ALL RIGHTEOUSNESS

- 1. Out of awe and respect, John the Baptist was not going to baptize Jesus Christ who came to Jordan for that purpose. If it was that needless, Jesus wouldn't be there. John had said ahead of Jesus that there is one coming after him who had been before him, he is not worthy to untie his sandal lace. That was coming from a place of deep, sincere and humble devotion. Seven (7) things he said about Jesus in Matthew 3:11-12; (i) He is mightier than him, (ii) He is not worthy to bear his shoes, (iii) He will baptize with Holy Spirit, (iv) He will baptize with fire, (v) He will thoroughly purge his floor, (vi)He will gather his wheat into the garner, (vii) He will burn chaff with unquenchable fire.
- 2. Truly, Jesus did not need to be baptized. John exclaimed in Matt 3:14 "I need to be baptized by you and you are coming to me?! Baptism of John was baptism unto repentance. Jesus needed no repentance. Thus, except for the fact that Jesus' baptism reflected a willingness to obey the Father, there is little relationship between the Lord's baptism and that required of all people today (Mk. 16:16). In the balance, it is important to set forth five reasons for the baptism of Jesus by John.

- It was to identify with John's ministry and approve of water baptism
- It was to publicly identify Jesus as the Son of God at the beginning of his ministry.
 The voice of commendation by God underscores this.
- It was to quickly present the oneness and unity of purpose of the Triune God. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit were present.
- It was a commencement token of the total dedication of Christ in carrying out Heaven's plan.
- It was a visual precursor to the Savior's ultimate death, burial, and resurrection.

C. FULFILLING ALL RIGHTEOUSNESS IS PLEASING THE FATHER Matthew 3:17

Generally speaking, fulfilling all righteousness is satisfying the requirements for accessing or achieving something. It means doing the needful.

.....And suddenly, a voice came from heaven saying, "This is my beloved son, in whom I am well pleased". This was the aftermath of Jesus' baptism. Just after pleasing the Father, there was an acclamation. Simply put, fulfilling all righteousness means doing what is required to please God. It includes humbly conforming to the will of the Father; covenanting with the Father to obey His commandments, following the examples set by Jesus Christ.

D. HOW CAN I PLEASE THE FATHER? HOW CAN WE FULFILL ALL RIGHTEOUSNESS?

Let me share some six ways we can be pleasing to God.

- **1. Offer yourself as a living sacrifice**. Romans 12:1-2. God loves total surrender. God loves purity. This is how to please him. By yielding to him in sacrifice. Holding our vessels, our bodies to him in holiness.
- 2. Praise God Always: Psalm 119:1-9. Praise is the appropriate response to God. He is worthy of all our praise. We teach our children to be thankful not for our own sake but for theirs. We are pleased when they are thankful. God teaches us to praise him because it is the right response to him, and because it is good for us. Thanksgiving is an appropriate response to human generosity. Continual praise is the appropriate response to God's generosity. The psalmist repeats over and over again that we should 'praise the Lord' v1. Praise him all day long: 'from the rising of the sun to the place where it sets' v2. Praise him throughout your life, 'now and tomorrow and always'.

BIBLE TEACHING:

DISCOVER YOUR GOD GIVEN GIFTS - PART 1

A. There are three categories of *GIFTS* identifiable in the Bible but more often than not they are misconstrued and muddled together.

It is expedient that **DON & KATIE FORTUNE** be acknowledged as we intend to do an exposition of the handbook which the Lord enabled them to write in same regard. In the Church of God today just like any other field of human endeavour we need to understand the individual process that comes with each person's gifting.

B. THE THREE CATEGORIES

- 1. The Manifestation Gifts 1Cor. 12:1-11
- 2. The Ministry Gifts Eph. 4:11
- 3. The Motivational Gifts Romans 12:6-8

OUR FOCUS: THE MOTIVATIONAL GIFTS

They shape our personalities. They are the motivating force for our lives

OUR TEXT: ROMANS 12:6-8

C. WHAT IS IN THIS TEACHING FOR US

- To convince us that every one of us has a gift 1 Peter 4:10, Romans 12:6-8.
- To enable us obey the commandment of God and His Expectation to use our gifts to benefit others. (GRACE GIFTS JUST LIKE OTHERS)
- To appreciate the fact that God built into us our gifts when He formed us - Ps. 139:13-16
- 4. To assist parents to enable children maximize their gifts as observable from childhood.
- 5. To remind us that we must never neglect our gifts 1 Tim. 4:14
- To instill in us the consciousness that our gift colours all that we see
- To bring to light why we behave, think and act the ways we do at FAMILY, CHURCH, SOCIETY levels
- To assist us all to appreciate others rather than condemn them thereby enhancing our relationship and fellowship since we are WIRED differently.
- To sensitize on the fact that our gift is only one perspective of the whole
- 10. To stir in us the consciousness that each gift is of equal value thereby enabling us to eschew envy, jealousy, strife, etc.
- 11. To assist us in the choice of appropriate ministry or work to do in the body of Christ.
- 12. To enable us become less critical of others while appreciating that we all have our *IDIOSYNCRASIES* i.e. an unusual way in which a particular person behaves or thinks. A peculiarity of constitution or temperament. An individualizing character or quality.
- D. There are 7 in all. Nobody has all except JESUS. We have our area of *PROFICIENCIES* individually.
- E. PROPHECY: (NEED FOR CLARIFICATION) PROPHECY in Greek is Propheteia which according to Strong's Exhaustive Concordance means AN INSPIRED SPEAKER. It has a root word meaning "TO SHOW OR MAKE KNOWN ONE'S THOUGHTS, TO SPEAK, SAY OR AFFIRM"

Prophecy in the New Testament is not necessarily about predictions but about *THE INSPIRED DELIVERY OF WARNING, EXHORTATION, INSTRUCTION, JUDGING* and making manifests the secrets of the heart. This gift has to do with sensitivity to perceiving the will of God and then proclaiming it.

F. WHAT ARE THE CHARACTRISTICS OF A PERCEIVER (THE GIFT OF PROPHECY)

THE GIFT OF PERCEPTION CHARACTERISTICS

- 1. Quickly and accurately identifies good and evil and hate evil.
- Sees everything as either black or white; no gray or indefinite areas.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION FOR 2020

THIS YEAR 2020 THE NAME OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST SHALL BE GLORIFIED THROUGH ME AND IN ME FOR THE LORD SHALL INCREASE MY FAITH AND FORTIFY ME WITH GRACE TO MAXIMISE MY DAILY LOADS OF DIVINE BENEFITS.

BY FAITH IN THE LORD MY GOD, I SHALL BE ESTABLISHED FOR GOOD AND MY LIFE SHALL REMAIN ENVIABLE. MY LIFE SHALL ATTRACT DIVINE FAVOUR AND SHALL BECOME MEANINGFUL. THE DOORS OF GOODNESS AND MERCY SHALL NEVER BE SHUT AGAINST ME. EVERY ADVERSARY OF MY PROGRESS SHALL BECOME MY STEPPING STONE TO HIGHER GROUNDS.

BY MY FAITH IN GOD, MY ARRIVAL THIS YEAR AT ALL PLACES SHALL BREAK BARRIERS, MY MIRACLES SHALL BREAK PROTOCOLS AND MY TESTIMONIES SHALL LAST FOREVER. BY FAITH IN GOD I SHALL GROW AND OUTGROW EVERY HISTORICAL AND ANCESTRAL PATTERN OF SHAME TO ATTAIN AN UNPRECEDENTED HEIGHT OF FAME TO THE GLORY OF GOD BY FAITH IN GOD, THIS YEAR AND ALWAYS, MY LIFE SHALL SHINE LIKE THE SUN BY DAY AND BECOME BRIGHT LIKE THE MOON AT NIGHT. AS THE GLORY OF THE SUN, MOON AND STAR CANNOT BE COVERED, NO MAN SHALL BE ABLE TO COVER MY GLORY. MY GLORY SHALL DEFILE EVERY SATANIC GANG UP AND WHEREVER THE SUN RUNS ITS COURSE MY GLORY SHALL SHINE FORTH AND INCREASE. BY FAITH IN GOD, MY LIFE SHALL FULFILL THE PURPOSE OF ITS EXISTENCE AND I SHALL NUMBERED AMONG THE WASTED GENERATION. ALL MY MOCKERS SHALL BECOME MY WORKERS, ANOTHER PERSON'S MISFORTTUNE SHALL NEVER BECOME MY INHERITANCE.

BY MY FAITH IN GOD THIS YEAR 2020, EVERY LOW OR MIGHTY MOUNTAIN OF HINDERANCE AND LIMITATION BEFORE ME IN EVERY SPHERE OF HUMAN ENDEAVOUR SHALL MOVE AND GIVE WAY, GOD SHALL CALM EVERY TROUBLED SEA BEFORE ME, GOD SHALL BRING FOUNTAIN OUT OF THE DESERT FOR ME AND BY FAITH I SHALL BE VICTORIOUS. I SHALL NEVER WALK NAKED, I SHALL NOT SUFFER SATANIC WOUND OR INJURY, I SHALL PREVAIL OVER EVERY GANG UP AND SET UP OF THE EVIL ONES. BY FAITH IN GOD AND THE COVERING OF THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST EVEN AS I DAILY CLAIM HIS GIFT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS I SHALL BE MORE THAN A CONQUEROR IN THE MIGHTY NAME OF JESUS CHRIST. AMEN.

- **3. Live in the light.** Ephesians 5:8-14. As Christians, we are called to be a community whose conduct shines as a beacon to others, illuminating the way that God intended life to be lived. Paul wrote that you are 'light in the Lord' (v.8). Therefore, you should live as 'children of light' (v.8). Light produces good fruit: goodness (generosity towards others), righteousness (doing right in relation to God and humanity) and truth. These are ways you can please the Lord (v.10). Light exposes evil. The best way to get rid of evil is to drag it into the light. Evil thrives in the darkness, but the moment it's brought into the light, its power diminishes.
- **4. Make the most of every opportunity**. Ephesians 5:15-17. Time is our most valuable possession. You can get more money but you cannot get more time. Paul wrote, 'Be very careful, then, how you live not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil' (vv.15–16). Do not fritter away your life. Life is to be lived as instructed by the Holy Spirit. That's how to make the most of it. Ask God per time to lead you.
- **5. Be filled with the Spirit**. Ephesians 5:18–20. Paul contrasts the escapism of substance abuse (getting 'drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery') with being 'filled' (v.18) with the Holy Spirit: 'Drink the Spirit of God, huge draughts of him'. In these verses, he uses 'filled' in the present continuous tense, urging us to go on and on being filled with the Spirit. Being filled with the Spirit leads to singing 'psalms, hymns and spiritual songs' (v.19)'. It leads us to worship the Lord Jesus in our hearts and to give thanks to God the very opposite of grumbling and complaining. It is characteristic of the Spirit-filled community to be grateful to God for all things, in all places and at all times. Without God's Spirit, it is difficult to please God.
- **6. Submitting to one another in love and respect.** Ephesians 5:21–33. Mutual respect is the key to a happy and cordial human existence and interaction; be it marriage or friendship or business partnership. The key words in verses 21–33 are 'respect', 'love' and 'submit'. The overall heading for this section is that 'out of respect for Christ', we are to 'submit to one another' (v.21). The word used for submission is different from the word used for 'obey' (6:1). Submission is voluntarily yielding in love. It is a beautiful characteristic and it is clear from the overall heading, 'submit to one another' (v.21), that Paul expects mutual submission. When we do this, we please God.

E. CONCLUSION

The list is not exhaustive. If we are going to be pleasing to God, we must note that loving him with whole of being is the key. Afterwards, it becomes easier to love others. If we obey this golden law of love, we'll be fulfilling all righteousness. Let's go and do the needful in the strength of the Holy Spirit.
