# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 16<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY, 2020

THEME: CHRIST OUR HEALER
READINGS: 11 KINGS 5:1-14, PSALM 77:1-15,
JAMES 5:13-16A, MARK 2:1-12

Christ Our Healer is the thematic focus of our thought for this week. That Jesus Christ has the power to heal has become more or less a universal truth, even among many that do not subscribe to the Christian faith that followed His earthly ministry. Indeed, healing is one of the multiple-fold ministerial essence of Jesus Christ that had been foretold through Prophet Isaiah (61:1-3), the extract of which was read by Jesus in the synagogue at the beginning of his earthly ministry in Nazareth. (Luke 4:18). The power and willingness of Christ to heal was fully demonstrated during his earthly ministry by delivering and healing the physically and spiritually sick people that came to him. Even in our contemporary time, this same power is being demonstrated through the Church.

Some three weeks ago, our theme was Jesus' Willingness to Heal, and sometime, we talk about His Power to Heal; and one wonders what differentiate all this from today's theme, Christ Our Healer. Without obfuscating the discourse with semantics, let us just note the possessive pronoun "our" in today's theme as the driver of our thought. What this means is that the healing power of Christ is ours to enjoy and maximise, hence the focus on how we can personalize the provision and benefit maximally from it.

- 1. Have Christ the Healer as your Father and Lord: In the region of Tyre and Sidon, Jesus said to a Syro-Phoenician (gentile) woman who came pleading with him to heal her demonpossessed daughter, "Let the children be filled first, for it is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." (Mark 7:27). The point to note here is that Christ is "our" healer only when we have him as our Father and Lord God because healing belongs to his children.
- 2. Deploy your (desperate) faith: That you simply believe in Christ and his power to heal may at times not be enough to experience his healing power. Your helpless situation and hindering circumstances may sometime require you to be desperate in your effort to put your faith to work. This is one of the learning points in today's Gospel reading from Mark 2:1-12. The paralytic man and his friends deployed a faith that could not be overcome by barrier. Yes, the crowd blocked the

Yes, the crowd blocked the way to Jesus' presence; friends of the paralytic (possibly by his insistence) did the unusual by punching open the roof from where he was dropped right in front of Jesus. Their desperate faith was noticed by Jesus (v.5) and the result we all know. He was healed of sin and disease.

- 3. Dispose yourself to Jesus for healing: In the case of the paralytic man, he was brought for healing from his paralytic condition, but Jesus pronounced forgiveness and the man was healed. This shows a strong correlation between sin and ailment/diseases, although not in all cases of affliction. Ref. John 9:1-3. Sin is certainly a reproach, and the Bible doesn't have any record of sickness or affliction occurring before the fall of man in the Garden of Eden. Even if our afflictions are sin-induced, our absolute faith in Jesus' power and willingness to forgive disposes us to healing from both our sins and their attendant afflictions.
- 4. Keep a faith-valued company: The company of friends you keep has a lot to do with your inward spiritual health because the Bible says "Evil company corrupts good habits." (1 Cor. 15:33, NKJV). Imagine what could have happened to the paralytic man in the absence of friends that shared his faith discouragement, gossip, 'mouth-shooting', abandonment etc. When it comes to inward blindness and sickness of heart and mind, company of bad unbelieving friends will only exacerbate our already bad situations. For healing of the mind and heart through the word of God and daily communion (walk) with God, we need godly company of friends. The Bible says in Prov. 27:17 "As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend."
- 5. Call for the elders of the Church: The Bible in James 5:14 enjoins the sick among us to do this. The word 'elders' here has nothing to do with age or status, it is a direct reference to the Presbyters of the Church. By reason of their calling and Apostolic succession, Christ's healing power has been transmitted to them, such that when they lay hands on the sick, they shall recover (Mark 16:18). Peter and Paul were not Jesus Christ, but they exercised Christ's healing power that was transmitted on them. We deny ourselves the benefit of spiritual healing when we hide from our presbyters (priests) for whatever reasons. They have the right to call for prayers of the Church with or without mentioning of names, depending on the leadings they have, because the prayer of faith heals the sick (v.15)
- 6. Be direct in your prayer request: may be for reason of covert doubt, many Christians find it difficult to be direct in their request for healing. Hypertension and diabetes, for instance, are said to be incurable; their patients put up with regime of daily ingestion of medications, in spite of which some still die of complications from the ailments. If medications fail, why then should those afflicted with these ailments be afraid to ask God for total healing. Who says that divine healing is meant for minor ailments like pains and headaches? This seems to be the problem with the lame

This is simply the essence of having prayer partners, a practice that has been eroded by doubts, suspicion and of course breach of confidence and trust among believers of our clime. But that does not negate the Scripture, intercessory prayers work wonders for our healing. Those who know Jesus as their healer should realize that He delights in the corporate prayers of the Church which exists to perpetuate his glory till He returns.

### **Conclusion:**

The healing power and ministry of Christ Our Healer has no bounds or limits. It covers the whole spectrum of sicknesses, diseases and Afflictions – physical ailment, spiritual affliction, psychological disorder, sin consequences, demonic attacks and afflictions, social stigma and shame etc. It does not matter how long it has been or how complex it is, it also doesn't matter how many times your effort at finding solutions to it has failed, what you simply need to do is to renew your faith in Christ as not just a healer but your personal (my) healer. Trust him to do it and wait to see him do it. Whatever your challenge or affliction, remember you are not the first person to be so challenged or afflicted. Remember this always:

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses." (Matt 8:16-17, NKJV).
