5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 1ST MARCH, 2020

THEME: GOING BEYOND TOKENISM IN FASTING

READINGS: JAMES 1:2-12, MATTHEW 4:1-11; PSALM 119:1-8.

It's four days into Lent; Ashe Wednesday was on the 26th February, 2020 and the Forty days journey terminated on Saturday (11-04-2020) before Easter. You are welcome on board. Lent is traditionally a 40day fasting period (Sunday are excluded) modeled after Christ fasting in the wilderness before he began his public ministry. Basically our meditation for this week is titles, Going Beyond Tokenism in Fasting". A discourse on Fasting is very apt on the first Sunday in Lent.

A discourse on fasting is very apt on the first Sunday in Lent, because it helps to prepare our minds for the season. The season is a period for penitence, a time we all examine our sinful nature and return to God. It is not a season for asking God mundane things – It is a time to look inward and be ready to make commitment to change in any area wherein we have not submitted to the LORDSHIP of Jesus Christ. Lent is a sacrificial season, which reminds us about the Redemptive work of Jesus Christ, His death on the Cross and ultimately His Resurrection from the death.

The two key words in our topic for today are "Tokenism" and "Fasting". Collins dictionary definition of tokenism says, "if you refer to an action as tokenism, you disapprove of it because you think it is just done for effect. In order to show a particular intention or to impress a particular type of person or the practice of making only a token effort or doing no more than minimum in order to comply with a law. Cambridge dictionary defined tokenism as action that are the results of pretending to give advantage to those groups in the society who are often treated unfairly, in order to give the appearance of fairness – Cambridge synonym simply says to be unfairness and favouring someone unfairly.

What we have in the definition is that the Lenten Season or fasting is trivialized, that is, to make less important or when something is just done with less effort or with an intention to impress people. When the focus shift from pleasing God to impressing man.

Lent is not just an expression of our feeling; not a testing ground for the true grit of our will power neither is it a "spiritual" rationale for losing some kilos of weight thereby making the practice of fasting into a means to accomplish our own ends. Prophet Isaiah put it thus: "In fact in the day of your fast, you find pleasure, and exploit all your labourers. Indeed you fast for strife and debate, And to strike with the fist of wickedness (Ish. 58:3b,4). We must go beyond Tokenism in fasting. The focus is on God not man, on spiritual discipline not egoism, self-interest or aggrandisement.

Fasting during Lent is much more that abstaining from food, you can also deny yourself of pleasure and luxury during this season. It is a period of laying yourself bare before God seeking help for your deliverance from known and unknown sins. None of us can hide from God, it might be possible to keep your dirty and secret sins from men but not from your maker, and if you don't seek help from God to help you deal with the sins one by one, the sin will soon disgrace you and finally destroy you because of your non-challant behaviour towards sin. Confess your weakness and sinfulness and pray for divine grace (to live above sins) and pardon. In the ancient Jewish tradition according to Marjorie Thompson in his book "Soul Feast", fasting has two primary purposes.

The first was to express personal or national repentance for sin, fasting was a form of humble supplication before God in the face of imminent destruction or calamity (See Joel 2; Jonah 3, Esther 4).

Beloved, this season is a call to sober reflection, Soul searching and completely surrendering to the word of God.

The second purpose why Jews fast was to prepare inwardly for receiving the necessary strength and grace to complete mission of faithful service in God's name. Primary examples are the forty day wilderness fast of Moses, Elijah and Jesus (Exod. 24;

34; 1Kg 19, Matt 4). The fasting prepares each one to become a personal bearer of God's saving acts to the people. If you don't want a spiritual exercise in futility you must take the season seriously.

Today's gospel according to Matthew Chapter 4:1-11 gives us a clue into the purpose and benefit of fasting. Russian orthodox theologian, Alexander Schmamann reminds us that we must prepare spiritually before fasting. A fast of spiritual purpose must be centred on God and can be so only if we ask God's help. Since people's problem and challenges span from physical, spiritual and psychological, it is advisable that deliberate efforts are put into the preparation.

Fasting depletes your normal energy reserves, it is important to reduce your normal activity while fasting. No wonder, Jesus was led into the wilderness after He had fasted 40 days and 40 nights to be tempted by the Devil.

Notice that while He was still fasting, the Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness to be tempted. The purpose of the fasting exercise was meant to prepare Jesus for the ministry. He was enabled, strengthened to confront Satan and to overcome through the word. This presupposes that Jesus loved and studied the Word of God. He tackled Satan using the Word, "It is written". Fasting helps to deal with the temptation of the flesh, the temptation of the spirit, and the temptation of the world. Fasting helps our spiritual antenna and concentration so much so that the flesh is subdued and the spirit is exalted. Fasting humbles and is capable of stirring spiritual hunger and thirst. We read that Jesus after He had fasted, He was hungry, and on the Cross He cried, "I am thirsty" (Matt 19:28).

This year's Lenten season can be the best ever if you pay attention to details, if you refuse to go the way of others, but remain focused on God. God is willing to bless everyone of His Children, and ready to take us to the next spiritual level, but in quietness and sobriety, not in wanton behaviour and noise. Take time to pray and meditate on God's presence and your fasting will be beyond Tokenism.
