# 2. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2020

THEME: A CHOSEN PEOPLE, A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD

READINGS: PSALM 95:1-7; 1 SAMUEL 7:4-16; 1 PETER 2:1-10; JOHN 115:1-5.

From the Old to the New Testament times, God has always used both priests and lay (ordinary) members of the church to do His work. While Aaron and his sons and their descendants were charged with the responsibility of the priesthood, all the other Levites who were not descended directly from Aaron were to serve as priestly assistants, taking care of the tabernacle and the Temple and performing other menial duties (Num.8:6). During David's reign, the Levites were divided into four classes:

- i. Assistants to priests in the work of the sanctuary,
- ii. Judges and Scribes,
- iii. Gate keepers and
- iv. Musicians (1 Chron. 24-25).

The New Testament teaching however recognizes **the priesthood of all believers** (1 Pet.2:9) which does not abolish the Aaronic order of priesthood but rather compliments it by placing the **work of reconciliation** firmly in the hands of **ALL** Christians (see also 2 Cor.5:18-21).

The focus of our thought for this week is on the **Priesthood** of ALL believers as a chosen people of God. Apostle Peter wrote in chapter 1 vv.9-10 of his first General Epistle - But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy. (NKJV).

It is given and taken that the primary work of a priest (one ordained after Aaronic order) is to preach the good news of salvation through Jesus Christ to everyone. He is involved, as shepherd in members' spiritual nurturing through counselling, teaching and leading of worship. It is therefore required of a person that has been called into such high office to be well equipped so he will not speak and/or perform as a novice in his sacerdotal duties. Besides he has as his primary responsibility the duty of representing Christ and His Church and live a godly life that bears witness to Him wherever he may be.

Having said this much, this write-up shall concern itself more with the need to disabuse the mind of those who may still believe that the work of God, albeit preaching of the Gospel, is the work of priests and their involvement in whatever way is only meant to assist the priests in doing what is essentially their job. This notion leads to apathy and lack of commitment, hence their withdrawal from Church assignments at the slightest excuse. Attempt will also be made to shed light on how the laity, having gained understanding of their priestly status, may be involved in the work of reconciliation in an acceptable way.

Article 80 of the Catechism of the Church of Nigeria (Anglican Communion), BCP (N), 1996, Pg. 787, identifies the ministers of the church as Lay Persons (Laity), Bishops, Priests and Deacons. Lay persons are non-clergy members of the church. Article 81 defines the ministry of the laity thus; "The ministry of the lay persons is to represent Christ and his Church, to bear witness to him wherever they may be; and according to the gifts given them, to carry on Christ's work of reconciliation in the world; and to take their place in the life, worship, and governance of the Church".

From the above, we can isolate four areas of lay persons' involvement which tally with Peter's definition of their roles as members of the Royal Priesthood;

- i. To represent Christ and His Church
- ii. To bear witness to Him everywhere they find themselves
- iii. To use their God-given gifts for Christ's work of reconciliation in the world, and

iv. To take their place in the life, worship and governance of the Church.

Of utmost importance are the first two roles which have to do with us all, as believers, living up to our calling unto holy living as a special people of God to proclaim (show forth) the praises of Him who called us out of darkness into His marvelous light, as emphasized by Peter. We must pause at this juncture to ask ourselves individually how are we faring in our effort to represent Christ well in our life journey? What kind of impact are we having on our environments? Is our lifestyle compatible with the Gospel we are called to preach and proclaim? These are just a few of the so many questions to ask.

It would now not matter whether our inner judgment of ourselves measure up to biblical standard of fruitfulness that meet with God's expectations or fall below it; what would matter is recognizing that we have in Christ a sure source of the help and wherewithal to bear much fruit and thus live up to divine expectations. This is the import of today's Gospel reading from John 15:1-5.

The take-home lesson here is that the earnest expectation of all creation (our individual world, our sphere of operations and influence) is waiting for you and me to manifest the Christ-like characters that prove us to be Christ's own, especially as His chosen people, a royal priesthood.
