1. Chatting and receiving calls during Church Service.
2. Running out to pick calls with your phone ringing out so loud. This is SACRILEGIOUS.
3. Refusing to obey the directives of the Church Stewards indicates disobedience in the house of God.
4. Folding your hands when your Pastor is teaching or preaching. You are telling him that what he is saying is not worthwhile.
5. Habitual lateness to Church service is a SPIRITUAL FLIGHT that has take off time.
6. Staring at fellow parishioners and making them uncomfortable.
7. Dozing or sleeping in Church during sermon or in the course of the Service –Acts 20:9.
8. Sitting down inactive during Prayer or Praise session especially when other parishioners are standing without any evidence of health challenge.
9. Looking at the clock on the wall and your wristwatch and then at the Pastor’s face insinuating that he should round off.
10. Borrowing things like phone chargers, pen etc. and leaving the Church with the said items. Remember Exodus 20:15, 17

**THEME: FAITH IN ACTION**

**READINGS: PSALM 65:1-7, DANIEL 6:10-23; HEBREWS 11:1-2, 8-16; MARK 2:1-12.**

#### INTRODUCTION

Faith has always been the mark of a disciple of Jesus, the early disciples were known as BELIEVERS for Jesus said "Everything is possible for him who believes" (Mark 9: 23)

Faith means total dependence on God. When Adam sinned he stepped out of God-dependence into independence (which is unbelief) this is the reason God has placed such a high priority on faith.

Faith is the way we come back into relationship with God (God-dependence) this dependence is called **FAITH**. Faith advances you beyond your five senses (hearing, seeing, smelling, tasting, touching)

Faith releases you from limited capabilities. By faith you move from inability to His-ability. This is the walk of faith to which all of us are called- where "nothing is impossible" (Matt 17:20)

#### FURTHER DEFINITIONS OF FAITH

It is the belief in or confident attitude towards God, faith is obedient action in response to what God has said. True faith is expressed in;

1. Obedience
2. Action in response to hearing God's word (voice)

Now, faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see (Heb 11:1) faith means having trust, assurance or confidence in another person or their word. Having faith in God involves an exchange of self trust for trust in God. We stop trusting in ourselves and trust Him; we abandon reliance on our limited source of knowledge and start receiving from His unlimited source.

### Two Kinds of Knowledge.

Please read 1Cor 2:47 and see also verses 8-16

1. All knowledge that comes to natural man comes through his five senses- hearing, seeing, smelling, tasting, touching. This is limited knowledge, described as man's wisdom
2. Revelation knowledge; this knowledge is not based on the five senses nor on natural reasoning but on an alternative source-the TRUTH of the word of God. It is received through man's spirit and it is described as God's wisdom.

### The Basis of Faith

The basis of having faith in God is in three important realities:

1. **The nature of God:** when God made His promise to Abraham, since there was no one greater for Him to swear by, He swore by Himself (Heb 6:13)
  - a. He cannot change (Mal 3:6)
  - b. He cannot fail (Job 42:2 ; 1 Chr 28:20)
  - c. He cannot lie (Num 23:19 ; Titus 1:2)
2. **The redemptive work of the Son of God**  
"Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith (Heb 12:2) Christ has become the source of our faith in God, the fact that His death and resurrection provides a solid ground for our belief.
3. **The word of God**  
"Heaven and earth will pass away but my word will never pass away" (Matt 24:35; Isa 40:8)  
His word stays true forever. Faith comes when God brings a specific word directly to us in our circumstances. Spoken on this way, the word of God comes alive to us, releasing our faith.

### HOW FAITH WORKS

The principle of faith (Rom 3:27) is to operate in our lives continually, no matter the circumstance (2Cor 5:7; James 1:5&6) for faith to operate in our situation, we must obey the word of God that has been spoken in our situation for faith is active and not passive. Most of God's promises are conditional; He will do His part only if we do our part. "Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead" (Jas 2:17)
