5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 18TH OCTOBER, 2020

THEME: THE NATURE OF TRUE OBEDIENCE READINGS: PSALM 125, EXODUS 20:1-20; ROMANS 8:12-17; MATTHEW 21:28-32

INTRODUCTION

Obedience is not a popular word today, not just in word but in action. Scripture makes it very clear that obedience is necessary and crucially important part of our lives as Christians. The nature of true obedience lies in our readiness to let go of our comfort in order to please God. Of a truth, obedience to God is not a matter of convenience but a matter of commitment. It is not how pleasant it is to our desire but how submissive we are to God.

The Parable of the Two Sons as written in Matthew 21:28-32 is a story is of a man with two sons who told them to go work in the vineyard. The first son refused, but later obeyed and went. The second son initially expressed obedience, but actually disobeyed and refused to work in the vineyard. The son who ultimately did the will of his father was the first son. Jesus then likens the first son to tax collectors and prostitutes—the outcasts of Jewish society—because they believed John the Baptist and accepted "the way of righteousness" (v. 32), in spite of their initial disobedience to the Law. While the second son is likened to those religious leaders who only had the law but never obeyed.

This story teaches us that obedience goes beyond confession. It entails working out the confession made. It shows obedience is what brings a man into doing God's will. When God's children obey their Heavenly Father, He is glorified. Jesus told us that the plan is for others to "see our good deeds and glorify our Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:16). The primary concern in Christian living is doing the will of God. This was Jesus' purpose. "My food... is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work" (John 4:34). "I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me" (John 5:30 RSV). Jesus' victory at the Cross was based on his obedience. He said, "I do exactly what my Father has commanded me" (John 14:31). Before the crucifixion he prayed three times to his Father, "Not as I will, but as you will" (Matthew 26:39).

Paul tells us that Jesus "humbled himself and became obedient to death - even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place" (Philippians 2:8-9). Hebrews says that Jesus "learned obedience from what he suffered, and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him" (Hebrews 5:8-9). It was by his obedience that he was able to become the source of eternal salvation for those who obey him.

The whole "New Covenant" (or "New Testament") is based on Jesus' perfect obedience to his Father. Therefore, if we are to be imitators of Jesus, if we are to do the things he was doing, should we not seek to do the will of God in everything? That is exactly what Scripture says. Jesus taught us to pray, "Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10).
