- 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 4TH OCTOBER, 2020 THEME: THE TRICKS OF SATAN READINGS: PSALM 145:14-21; NEHEMIAH 6:1-16; 1 PETER 4:7-11; MATTHEW 25:14-30.

A. INTRODUCTION

Happy Sunday to all of us and thank you for all you do for the spread of the Gospel and in ensuring this House of Prayer remains a shelter and a place of refuge. Regardless of what is going on out there in the world, the Word of God is enough comfort for us. As we daily take in the Word of God, we get fortified and wade off the attacks the Devil and the world brings. Today's meditation is on the tricks of Satan. When we talk of tricks, Satan is full of them. Magicians are men of tricks. Right in your eyes, a magician is pulling off white birds from an empty bowler hat. Stunning and applause but not real. Tricks are activities or manipulations aimed at deceiving someone. So, a good word exchange in this context is deception. Satan deceives. Deception is an act or statement which misleads, hides the truth, or promotes a belief, concept, or idea that is not true. Satan used deception to pull man from grace to grass. Unfortunately, till tomorrow, men and women are still falling into this trap. Let us look at a few tricks of the Devil.

B. How Satan Operates?

- 1. **Satan is the author of all deceptions**: In Genesis 3, he used the serpent to deceive Eve. The apostle John reminds us that the last days will be characterized by deception; 1John 2:18-19. Satan as the author of deception seeks to seduce, snare, and subdue every human being in order to steal, kill, and destroy John 10:10.
- 2. Satan plants inordinate desires: The Devil drag Christians into evil by flaunting things that appeal to the flesh. When we cannot tame our desires, we fall into sin. James 1:13-15. Lot's wife was enthralled by the pull of the city she left behind and looked back (Genesis 19:26). Demas, a missionary helper to Paul the Apostle, was growing in his faith and service, but was so enthralled by worldly attractions that he abandoned Paul and his ministry in order to fully enjoy the world and its pleasures (II Timothy 4:10).

- 3. Satan accuses Christians before God: Revelation 12:10 says, "I heard a loud voice in heaven saying, 'Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God." Satan's defeat is sure. But his accusations haven't ceased. It is the same with us as it was with Job. Satan says to God about us, they don't really love you; they love your benefits. "Stretch out your hand and touch all that [they have], and [they] will curse you to your face" (Job 1:11). Their faith isn't real. Satan accuses us before God, as he did to Job.
- 4. Satan accuses God before Man: He used that trick for Eve. In paraphrase, "if he loves you indeed, he will make you know what he knows. He will make you be like him" Gen 3:5. He can tell you like he spoke through Job's wife in Job 2:9. Do you still hold on to your integrity? Curse this God and die. He was accusing God for Job's dilemma. Some of us wonder how certain things can be happening to us when we call ourselves God's children.
- 5. Satan afflicts: Satan causes some sicknesses and diseases. He manipulates the sick to visit his agents to increase their ordeals. In Luke 13:16, Jesus healed a woman once who was bent over and could not straighten herself and. When some criticized him for doing that on the Sabbath, he said, "Ought not this woman, a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan bound for eighteen years be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath day?" Jesus confirmed that the affliction came from the Devil (Acts 10:38). Thank God she met Jesus. Satan can afflict for a whole lifetime!
- 6. **Satan chokes up faith:** Satan plucks the word of God out of people's hearts and chokes faith. Jesus told the parable of the four soils in Mark 4:1–9. In it, the seed of the word of God is sown, and some falls on the path and birds quickly take it away. He explains in verse 15, "Satan immediately comes and takes away the word which was sown in them." Satan snatches the word because he hates faith which the word produces (Romans 10:17).Paul expresses his concern for the faith of the Thessalonians like this: "I sent to learn about your faith, for fear that somehow the tempter had tempted you and our labor would be in vain" (1 Thessalonians 3:5). Paul knew that Satan's design is to choke off the faith of people who have heard the word of God
- 7. Satan brews contention& strife: Satan is the father of contention. He delights in seeing Christians get into irreconcilable fights. When there is contention in your home or workplace, immediately stop whatever you are doing and seek to make peace. It doesn't matter who started it. When you see strife and sustained conflict defying resolution, don't wait too long, the devil is at work. The fruit of the Spirit love, joy, peace, forbearance......is not being produced there (Galatians 5:22-23). You are to be at peace with all men Romans 12:18
- 8. Satan clogs the wheel of Evangelism: Paul tells of how his missionary plans were frustrated in 1 Thessalonians 2:17–18: "We endeavored the more eagerly, and with great desire, to see you face to face; because we wanted to come to you... but Satan hindered us." He hates evangelism and discipleship and he will throw every obstacle to kill the zeal for evangelism. In many Churches today, evangelism is zero. People give a thousand and one reasons for not doing Evangelism. Millions of Naira are spent on things distant to salvation of souls.

- Satan get Churches busy with activities borrowed from the world. Nobody is asking, how many souls do we plan to win through this Program? Christians need to be deliberate about winning souls, not left to chance. How will soul wining not be a major report given week after week? Church numerical growth is gradually being left to biological route. Do not be deceived, Satan knows what he is doing? Do we as Christians know what we are doing?
- 9. Satan Confuses: Satan confused Eve. In a moment, she didn't know who was true between God and the Serpent. Don't allow this to happen to you. God is not an author of confusion. What Satan is saying may appear appealing, it will never be comforting. It may be appealing, but is it peaceable? Christians all over the world are confused over doctrinal issues, dressing issues, offering issues, expressions of the Holy Spirit, etc, allowing unhealthy strife to fuel proliferation of Church denominations, not necessarily the spread of the Gospel. We should not be confused when we claim to have the Holy Spirit who guides us into all truth.
- 10. Satan undermines the consequences of sin: He told Eve, "you will not surely die". (Genesis 3:4). God had previously warned both Adam and Eve that if they disobeyed Him, they would die. "...If you eat of its fruit you will surely die" (Genesis 2:17). This lie is always framed in the same way. He tells us in that there will be no consequences for our choices. However, we know from our experiences in the physical world that this is a lie. One of such lies is if you sin a Born Again, God does not count it. Every action has a reaction. Every choice we make sets things into motion that will affect us in one way or another. Sin brings death for the wages of sin is death.
- 11. **Satan Isolates to Terminate:** For Eve, Satan looked for a time Eve was not with her husband to strike. There is strength in unity. This was one of the agitations that gave rise to demanding the reopening of the Church. A number of Christians are sustained by messages and fellowship they are exposed to. Once that feed is cut, they are exposed to Satan's attacks. That was why Jesus left 99 sheep and ran after one lost one. One straying sheep can easily be preyed on. In II Samuel 11:1-5, Satan isolated David to mess him up.

D. How to Overcome Deception

- 1. Repent of Your Sin: Identify the specific way are you being deceitful? Then, pray a prayer of confession 1John 1:9. Don't live a lie
- 2. Resist the Devil James 4:7. Say 'No'. each time you do that, you gain strength.
- 3. Seek, Speak and Embrace the Truth continually: That's the Word of God. That's Jesus.
- 4. Adopt a Correct View of God: God is the Truth Num 23:19; Ezek 13:8. To view Him in any other way will only serve to justify the devil.
- 5. Build up your defense: Satan will make it as easy and as appealing for you to deceive others as possible. Put on the "belt of truth" (Ephesians 6:14) to help you discern true from false and remain committed to truth telling.
- Don't' isolate yourself from Church/Fellowship: Heb 10:25; Eccl 4:9-12. Church is fully open. Return to Church. Don't give Satan a foothold.

E. Conclusion:

Expect victory. We have been made new persons in Christ Jesus. We have been regenerated. The Spirit of Truth lives in us. We can live honestly to continually expose the lies of the devil. Let us continue to seek the help of the Holy Spirit to eliminate deceit. As long as we are cooperating with Him, we cannot lose! Praise God!
