1. Chatting and receiving calls during Church Service.
2. Running out to pick calls with your phone ringing out so loud. This is **SACRILEGIOUS**.
3. Refusing to obey the directives of the Church Stewards indicates disobedience in the house of God.
4. Folding your hands when your Pastor is teaching or preaching. You are telling him that what he is saying is not worthwhile.
5. Habitual lateness to Church service is a **SPIRITUAL FLIGHT** that has take off time.
6. Staring at fellow parishioners and making them uncomfortable.
7. Dozing or sleeping in Church during sermon or in the course of the Service -Acts 20:9.
8. Sitting down inactive during Prayer or Praise session especially when other parishioners are standing without any evidence of health challenge.
9. Looking at the clock on the wall and your wristwatch and then at the Pastor's face insinuating that he should round off.
10. Borrowing things like phone chargers, pen etc. and leaving the Church with the said items. Remember Exodus 20:15, 17.
11. Leaving the Church before the end of Service.
12. Gathering outside the Church to discuss while Service is going on. You're not honouring God whom you come to Worship.
13. Buying yourself a seat in Church and ensuring no one sits there even when you are not in church.
14. Leaving the Church without dropping your offering.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 15TH NOVEMBER, 2020

THEME: THE GREAT DAY OF THE LORD READING: PSALM 76, ZEPHANIAH 1:14-18; 1 THESS. 5:1-11; MATTHEW 13:24-32.

As we begin to draw near the Advent Sunday, our themes for preceding Sundays shall begin to prepare our minds for the Lord's return, not as a baby in the manger that we celebrate at Christmas, but as Judge. One of such preparatory topics is the one for today - The Great Day of the Lord.

It appears germane to start this discourse with a popular chorus: Will you be ready when the Lord shall come? 2x

I will be ready 3x
When the Lord shall come
I will be ready 3x
When the Lord shall come

The Day of the Lord or The Great Day of the Lord was in the Old Testament time called the Day of Yahweh among the Israelites. It was a popular belief in Israel during the time of Prophet Amos that God would come to destroy the pagan nations and save Israel - Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! to what end is it for you? The day of the LORD is darkness, and not light. -Amos 5:18. If we read down the lines, we would see how God through the prophet shunned the congregational worship of Israel because of idolatry and injustice, He described their songs as noise.

Take away from Me the noise of your songs, For I will not hear the melody of your stringed instruments. 24 But let justice run down like water, And righteousness like a mighty stream. vv. 23-24.

Other Old Testament prophets such as Zephaniah and Joel in particular shared this thought in their prophetic works.

That day is a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness - Zephaniah 1:15.. And I will bring distress upon men, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD: and their blood shall be poured out as dust, and their flesh as the dung. - Zephaniah 1:17. Verses 8-9 present idolatry, violence and deceit as reasons for God's anger against Judah.

Prophet Joel witnessed the physical invasion of Jerusalem with grasshoppers that threatened their existence. He did not take it as a freak of nature, as you and I are naturally disposed to

doing. He saw it as a warning from God and based on it to predict the coming of the day of the Lord as a great military invasion, similar to an invasion of grasshoppers (find time to read Joel 2:1-17 for details). Of course, the Babylonian army came and invaded the land and destroyed the temple and the walls of Jerusalem.

Common to all these prophecies was a latent hope anchored on repentance. So, the Day of the Lord from the Old Testament perspective, as per the prophecies, can be summarized to mean two things.

1. A day of God's anger and judgment against sinners
 2. A day of restoration and joy for repentant sinners.
- Zeph.3:16-17 tells us that much –

In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

The New Testament sees the Day of the Lord as the day of the LORD's Return, in which He will do two things:

1. Judge the living and the dead
2. Establish His endless kingdom with the Saints.

Our creeds remind of this fact every time we gather.

So, we can add that it is equally a day of judgment and of salvation. Paul tells us in 1 Cor.5:5 that a repentant sinner's soul may be saved in the day of the Lord. 1 Thess.5:2 and 2 Pet.3:10 tell us that the day of the Lord shall come like thief in the night.

Jesus gave us a very comprehensive handout on this subject matter in Matt.24, but let us just take only 4 verses of it for our concluding meditation and lesson:

"But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only. But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. (Matt 24:36-39)

What is the learning point from both the Old and New Testaments' perspectives of the Great Day of the Lord? - BE PREPARED AND DON'T BE CAUGHT UNAWARE.

2 Pet.3:10-11 throws a challenge; but the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness?

The main reason our faith gets weakened is because of the delay in the LORD's coming. Of course, the Bible warns in 2 Peter 3:3-4 that scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things
